1. Situation remains generally calm despite shoot-outs yesterday between Army and Hutus radicals in province of Kayenza. Political situation also remains quite though we are still assessing impact of agreement signed late yesterday by party leaders on power sharing of provincial administration and diplomatic missions. In that agreement opposition obtained administration (Governors and heads of communes) of capital city Bujumbura plus six provinces: Bujumbura rural, Bururi, Kayenza, Muramvya, Muyinga and Rutana. It also got 48 communes. Majority obtained nine provinces: Bubanza, Cibitoke, Cankuzo, Gitega, Karuzi, Kirindo, Makamba, Ngozi and Ruyigi plus 78 communes.
2. Concerning diplomatic missions and consulates, opposition obtained: Beijing, Brussels, Cairo, Dar es-Salaam, Nairobi, New York, Pretoria, Stockholm and Bukavu, Zaire (consulate). Majority kept Addis Ababa, Bonn, Geneva, Kampala, Kinshasa, Moscow, Ottawa, Paris, Riyadh, Roma, Tokyo, Washington and Kigoma, Tanzania (consulate). As indicated in SITREP 050/94 we are very concerned of impact on PRODEBU basis of this power sharing, especially on manner by which ambassadors and provincial governors have been removed. Most of them - formerly provincial employees, are very close to their political and ethnic basis which will resent their dismissal. Therefore and while we are not totally convinced by the way this agreement is implemented, we asked interim President and majority leaders to fully explain it to their followers. We requested opposition leaders to moderate their appetite and to show restraint so that not to embarrass majority leaders. Prominent members of civil society were also requested their assistance to help explain the agreement.
3. Negotiations should resume tomorrow on programme and organization of future Government. Discussions will not be easy. Therefore, we spent most of today making contacts with various political leaders and military officers, asking them not to forget the main objective of the whole exercise: election of a new President. A new target date should be determined as the extension of interim period, if not used positively, could lead to instability. All sides made promises that a President should be in place before end of July.

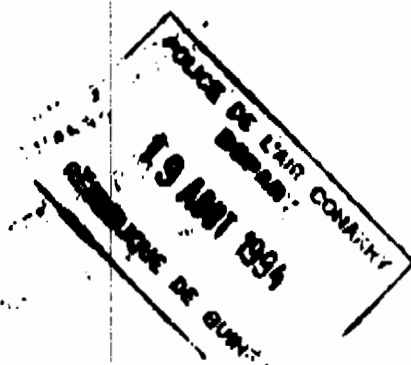
