FOLLOWING FOR INFORMATION FROM PACKHAM (CIV-975) : QUOTE

BADIBAKE MODESTE DOYEN D'AGE OF LULUA PROVINCIAL COUNCILLORS WAS ARRESTED TUESDAY
MORNING BUT SHORTLY AFTERWARDS RELEASED BY UNATIONS
ON GROUNDS THAT NO LEGAL CAUSE FOR ARREST HAD BEEN SHOWN. PROVINCIAL COUNCILLORS
MET THIS AFTERNOON. UNATIONS TROOPS NOT ON DUTY ARE BEING CONFINED TO BARRACKS AND
EYE HAVE ADVISED CIVILIAN STAFF TO AVOID PUBLIC MEETING PLACES FOR TIME BEING AS A
MEASURE OF PRUDENCE. MINISTER OF INTERIOR OF MUKENGE GOVERNMENT HAS PROHIBITED ALL
POLITICAL COMMUNIQUEES OR DEMONSTRATIONS AND MEETING OF MORE THAN 4 PERSONS IN LULU
PENDING ELECTION OF PROVINCIAL PRESIDENT. UNQUOTE.

FOR INFORMATION, FOLLOWING FROM MATHU (ELLEO 1190): QUOTE DURING DISCUSSION WITH CONSULS THIS MORNING (11 SEPT) THEY TOOK OPPORTUNITY TO INFORM ME THAT TSHOMBE HAS SENT THEM TWO LETTERS: 1. ASKING THEM TO GIVE GENERAL GUARANTEES THAT THE PLAN WILL BE IMPLEMENTED IN FAIR MANNER AND ANOTHER OUTLINING THE ARRANGEMENTS MADE BETWEEN UN AND THE CONGOLESE REGARDING NEUTRALITY OF KAMINA BASE. THE POINT IS THAT KATANGESE FEEL THAT OUR INCORPORATING ANC IN OUR TROOPS IN KAMINA IS A VIOLATION OF THESE ARRANGEMENTS. THE CONSULS, AT LEAST TWO OF THEM, SEEMED TO SUPPORT THE VIEW THAT WE SHOULD NOT HAVE INTRODUCED ANC IN OUR RANKS. THEY ALSO SUGGESTED THAT THE INTERNATIONAL CONSTITUTION EXPERTS NOW WORKING IN LEO SHOULD TAKE A VISIT TO E'VILLE IF NOT ALL OF THEM AT LEAST ONE OR TWO.

THE OTHER POINT THEY RAISED WAS THAT THE HUMANITARIAN FLIGHTS OVER KATANGA SUCH AS THOSE OF RED CROSS AND MISSIONARIES SHOULD BE AUTHORIZED EN MASSE. WE CONTINUING TO CONTROL THEM TO ASCERTAIN THAT THEY DO NOT TRANSPORT WAR MATERIAL. THEY REALIZED THAT WE HAD NO POWERS IN THESE MATTERS AND THAT OUR ROLE WOULD ONLY BE THAT OF PERSUASION OF CENTRAL GOVT IN LEO TO ACT IF THEY WERE CONVINCED THAT WE WERE RIGHT. UNQUOTE

HAVE REPLIED AS FOLLOWS: (EV-1017): QUOTE YOUR ELLEO 1190. HOPE YOU MADE IT CLEAR THAT WE HAVE OFFERED FIRST TO KIMBA DIRECTLY AND THEN TO SENN OF RED CROSS TO MAKE UN PLANES AVAILABLE FOR HUMANITARIAN FLIGHTS. THESE OFFERS HAD THE BACKING AND APPROVAL OF CENTRAL GOVT AND ALSO THAT OUR INSPECTION OFFERED NO PROTECTION TO THE PLANES. THE POSITION YOU TOOK IS ABSOLUTELY CORRECT AND EYE AM PASSING ON YOUR INFORMATION TO NEWYORK. UNQUOTE

FOR INFORMATION, FOLLOWING FROM MATHU (ELLEO 1189): QUOTE EYE HAD DISCUSSION THIS MORNING (11 SEPT) WITH THE THREE CONSULS OF BELGIUM, BRITAIN AND UNITED STATES ABOUT THE PLAN CONTAINING THE PROGRAMME. THEY SUGGESTED IT WOULD IMPROVE THE PROGRAMME IF QUOTE A. SWEARING OF THE OATH OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE PRESIDENT UNQUOTE COMES AT THE END AS POINT CCC AND POINT BBB QUOTE MILITARY COMMISSION UNQUOTE BECOMES POINT AAA AND PRESENT POINT CCC QUOTE IMPLEMENTATION UNQUOTE BECOMES POINT BBB. PARA. THEY SUGGESTED ALSO THAT AT THE END OF AAA 1 WE ADDED THE WORDS QUOTE IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MILITARY COMMISSION UNQUOTE.

THE NEXT SUGGESTION IS ON PARA 4 OF PRESENT BBB ON PAGE 3. THEY WOULD LIKE THE POWER GIVEN TO ONUC IN THE SECOND SENTENCE BE LIMITED TO THE UNITED NATIONS MEMBERS OF THE MILITARY COMMISSION WITH UNDERSTANDING THAT THE UN TROOPS WOULD HAVE FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT IF AND WHEN REQUIRED. IF YOU AGREE WITH THESE SUGGESTIONS THEY MAY BE EFFECTED BY PERSONAL EXPLANATION. UNQUO

HAVE REPLIED AS FOLLOWS (EV-1016): QUOTE REUR ELLEO 1189. THE ADJUSTMENTS SUGGESTED BY THE CONSULS WOULD BEST BE LEFT TO THE COMMISSIONS AND EYE FEAR AN ATTEMPT TO EXPLAIN HAD OPENED THE DOOR TO ENDLESS DISCUSSIONS, BUT THE POINTS COULD BE TAKEN INTO CONSIDERATION IN EXECUTION. UNQUOTE

1. FOLLOWING FROM PACKHAM (CIV970) : QUOTE

BCK DIRECTOR LATTEUR HAS INFORMED ME THAT WORK ON LUBILASH BRIDGE IS NOW COMPLETED. (IT HAS APPARENTLY BEEN PROPOSED THAT SOME PROTECTION SHOULD BE PROVIDED IN RIVER TO BREAK FORCE OF WATER BUT THIS WOULD APPEAR TO BE A SUPPLEMENTARY WORK AND IT IS NOT CLEAR WHETHER OR NOT IT IS TO BE UNDERTAKEN). LATTEUR ADVISES HOWEVER THAT BCK DIRECTOR FROM KAMINA INFORMED HIM THAT RAILS COULD NOT REPEAT NOT YET BE LAID. REASONS FOR THIS ARE NOT CLEAR. IT WOULD RELIEVE TRANSPORT SITUATION HERE CONSIDERABLY IF AGREEMENT COULD BE REACHED IN ELI FOR AT LEAST A LIMITED AMOUNT OF TRAFFIC. MOST URGENT NEED OF BCK HERE IS FOR REPAIRED LOCOMOTIVES OF WHICH BETWEEN 3 AND 6 ARE SAID TO BE AVAILABLE AT KAMINA. LATTEUR ADVISES NO SERIOUS DIFFICULTIES WITH EITHER SOUTH KASAI GENDARMERIE OR KANIOKAS. UNQUOTE.

2. I HAVE TAKEN UP MATTER WITH BELGIAN AMBASSADOR AND WILL TRANSMIT ANY FURTHER INFORMATION WE CAN GATHER ON THIS SUBJECT.
