S E C R E T REFEL 184 GARDINER, KHIARY FROM GUSSING.

HERE REPORT COVERING PERIOD 7-13 MAY INCLUSIVE.

TRAINS LEFT ELI FOR KAMINA ON 8 AND 12 MAY CARRYING 864 AND 1456 OR TOTALLY 2320 REFUGEES BELONGING TO LULUE TRIBE. FROM KAMINA THE FIRST ECHELON OF 864 REFUGEES HAVE BEEN TRANSPORTED TO LULUABOURG BY ONUC AIRPLANES. TRANSPORT OF SECOND ECHELON OF 1456 REFUGEES FROM KAMINA TO LULUABOURG WILL COMMENCE MONDAY 14 MAY. FROM LULUABOURG REFUGEES WILL BE TRANSPORTED TO THEIR VILLAGES OF ORIGIN BY ONUC. TRANSPORTS HAVE SO FAR WORKED WELL AND WITHOUT INCIDENTS, ALTHOUGH LAST TRANSPORT DELAYED BY ENGINE TROUBLE. EACH TRAIN GUARDED BY 200 INDIAN SOLDIERS AND 4 GENDARMERIE OFFICERS. THIRD AND FORTH TRANSPORTS SCHEDULED FOR 16 AND 19 MAY. ACCORDING OUR ESTIMATES REPATRIATION OF LULUAS WOULD THEN BE COMPLETED AND POSSIBLY PART OF SOME SMALLER TRIBES WHICH COULD ALSO BE SENT TO LULUABOURG. WE WILL NEED A FIFTH AND POSSIBLY A SIXTH TRANSPORT TO REPATRIATE ABOUT 500 BATETELAS, ABOUT 1000 BAKWA LUNTUS AND SMALL NUMBERS OF BALINDJI, BWANKOSHI AND KANYOKA TRIBES ALL TO LULUABOURG. YOU HAVE SUGGESTED WE SHOULD THEN CONTINUE WITH BALUBAKAT. MY FEELING IS THAT IF ANY TRIBE SHOULD BE KEPT HERE AT LEAST FOR THE TIME BEING IT IS THE BALUBAKAT. STILL THEY ARE HERE IN THEIR OWN PROVINCE. I THEREFORE PROPOSE NEXT STEP WOULD BE

*REPATRIATION OF BALUBAS FROM KASAI TO BACKWANGA TO FOLLOW AS SOON AS RECEPTION CENTER IS READY. IF BALUBAS FROM KASAI ARE TRANSPORTED TO BAKWANGA AND NOT LULUABOURG THE THOUSANDS OF BALUBAS WHO ARE AGAINST KALONJI WILL PROBABLY STAY HERE. IF THEY ARE TRANSPORTED TO LULUABOURG THEY MIGHT FORM A NEW CAMP THERE. I STILL FEEL AIR TRANSPORT FROM ELI WOULD BE GREAT ADVANTAGE AND FACILITATE AND SPEED UP OPERATION CONSIDERABLY. TRANSPORT BY TRAIN TO LUBUASH RIVER THEN BY BARGE ACROSS THE RIVER AND THEREAFTER A NEW TRAIN AND TRUCKS SEEMS VERY COMPLICATED AND TIME CONSUMING. PROJECT FAMILY REUNION HAS PROVIDED SOLUTION FOR 188 REFUGEES DURING REPORTING PERIOD AND TOTALLY 1141 REFUGEES SINCE BEGINNING OF PROJECT. THERE HAS BEEN AN INFLUX OF NEW REFUGEES INTO THE CAMP FROM COMMUNES AND APPARENTLY ALSO FROM KOLWEZI AND JADOTVILLE WHICH CAN ONLY BE ESTIMATED. BCK INFORMED US THEY LOST SOME 300 WORKERS AND UNION MINIERE SOME 200 WORKERS WHICH ARE SAID TO HAVE LEFT THEIR JOBS AND THEIR HOUSES. PART OF THEM HAVE CERTAINLY SUCCEEDED TO ENTER REFUGEE CAMP. GREAT EFFORTS BEING MADE BY MILITARY FORCES TO PREVENT FURTHER INFLUX. TRANSPORT OFFICER HAS ARRIVED.

NEXT STEP WOULD BE REPATRIATION OF LARGE GROUP BALUBAS FROM SOUTH KASAI TO BAKWANGA. AS STRESSED IN MY REPORTS NO. 111 AND 150 STRONG RECEPTION TEAM NEEDED IN BAKWANGA HEADED BY A TOP MAN. HAD MEETING WITH MUNONGO THIS AFTERNOOD TO DISCUSS

RETURN OF REFUGEES TO COMMUNES. PRESENT FROM OUR SIDE WERE
ALSO CHAND, NORONHA, GUSSING, VAN SOEREN, REMIZA AND BACK.
KATANGESE GROUP INCLUDED MOKE, KIEMBE, POLICE CHIEF, BOURGEMESTRES
OF VARIOUS AFRICAN COMMUNES AND OTHER OFFICIALS. MUNONGO
OPENED MEETING BY EXPRESSING SATISFACTION AT MEASURES TAKEN
BY UN TO DISOLVE CAMP AND SAID KATANGESE GOVERNMENT HAD
GIVEN ASSURANCES THAT REFUGEES WISHING TO GO BACK TO

THERE WOULD NOT BE SINGLE POLITICAL PRISONER IN KATANGA. HE REJECTED OTHER 2 MEASURES SAYING THEY HAD ENOUGH FOOD TO ASSIST REFUGEES AND THAT JOINT PATROLS WOULD CREATE UNNECESSARY ALARM IN COMMUNES. FURTHERMORE THEY WOULD ESTABLISH WELFARE CENTRES TO HELP IN RESETTLEMENT OF REFUGEES IN COMMUNES. HIS POSITION SEEMS TO BE THAT THE REFUGEES SHOULD EITHER GO BACK TO COMMUNES ON STRENGTH OF GUARANTEES GIVEN BY KATANGESE AUTHORITIES OR ELSE BE EVACUATED TO THEIR PLACES OF ORIGIN.
