SUBJECT: Unesco Fellowships (project 20-08)

1. Within the UNESCO training programme for 1962/63, 10 fellowships have been awarded to Congolese educational administrators for study at the International Bureau of Education in Geneva.
2. The 10 students have now returned from Europe upon completion of their studies. Messrs. Kadima (Bakwanga) and Bukendwa (Bukavu) could not yet be repatriated because of lack of space on Air Congo and ONUC flights and have to wait 14 days for their return home.
3. Under these circumstances, I should be grateful if you would give to Miss S. Bernier, Fellowships Section, an advance of CF. 5,600 covering the subsistence payment for the above fellows at the rate of CF. 200 per day (14 days).
4. This advance will subsequently be cleared against project 39-20-08.

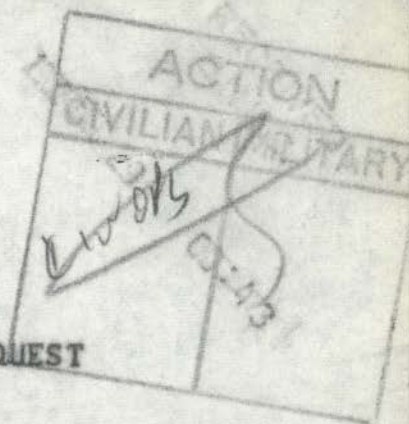
