A. AMBASSADOR ALBRIGHT, US AMBASSADOR TO UNITED NATIONS, DURING HER VISIT MET H.E. PRESIDENT BIZIMUNGU AND H.E. VICE-PRESIDENT MAJOR GENERAL PAUL KAGAME. Ms ALBRIGHT ANNOUNCED THAT HER COUNTRY HAD OFFERED \$ 1 MILLION IN ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE HUMAN RIGHTS FIELD OPERATIONS IN RWANDA AND HAS STRESSED THAT THE UNITED STATES REMAINED A FRIEND AND ALLY OF RWANDA IN ITS QUEST FOR PEACE, JUSTICE AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

B. H.E. GENERAL AMADOU TOUMANI TOURE, FORMER PRESIDENT OF MALI, ARRIVED ON 21 JAN 95 IN RWANDA WHERE HE WILL STAY UNTIL TUESDAY 23 JAN MORNING. GENERAL TOURE IS, ALONG WITH ARCHBISHOP DESMOND TUTU, PRESIDENT CARTER AND PRESIDENT NYERERE, ONE OF THE FACILITATOR OF THE PROCESS WHICH WAS SET IN MOTION AT THE CAIRO CONFERENCE OF HEAD OF STATES. HE IS CURRENTLY VISITING ALL STATES IN THE SUB-REGION TO ENSURE THAT CONTINUITY IS GIVEN TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RESOLUTIONS ADOPTED AT THE CAIRO CONFERENCE. THIS INITIATIVE MUST BE SEEN IN THE PERSPECTIVE OF A POSSIBLE WIDER REGIONAL CONSULTATION TO BE HELD IN THE FUTURE. DURING HIS VISIT, GENERAL TOURE HAS HAD MEETINGS WITH GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AS WELL AS REPRESENTATIVES FROM UNAMIR AND UNHCR. GENERAL TOURE WILL MEET ON 23 JAN WITH H.E. PRESIDENT BIZIMUNGU AND H.E. VICE-PRESIDENT MAJOR GENERAL PAUL KAGAME, PRIOR TO HIS DEPARTURE FOR BURUNDI TO FURTHER HIS CONSULTATIONS.

A. IN SECTOR 5 GISENYI, FOUR PERSONS WERE REPORTED TO BE KILLED AT MUKO SECTOR GR 5828 IN NYAKINAMA COMMUNE GR 5827 BY UNIDENTIFIED ARMED MEN ON 19 JAN 96. INVESTIGATION IN PROGRESS.

B. A TRADER OF MUKINGO SECTOR GR 2618 IN RWERERE COMMUNE GR 2722 WAS KILLED BY TWO FRGF ELEMENTS ON 16 JAN 96 AT ABOUT 2200HRS. SOME PROPERTY OF THE DECEASED WERE STOLEN AND THE OPERATION SAW ACCIDENTAL KILLING OF ONE OF THE FRGF ELEMENTS BY HIS OWN COLLEAGUE. THE DEAD FRGF ELEMENT HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED BY THE LOCALS.

A. IN SECTOR 2 (GITARAMA), AN RPA SOLDIER WHO WAS ARRESTED IN KIGALI FOR A MURDER IN THE COMMUNE, WAS REPORTEDLY SHOT DEAD ON 19 JAN 96 WHEN HE ATTEMPTED TO RUN AWAY.

B. IN SECTOR 3 (BUTARE), ON 19 JAN 96 ABOUT 1000 HRS, A GENDARMERIE STOPPED UNAMIR 1141 AND DEMANDED THAT THE CAR AND THE KEY BE HANDED OVER TO HIM. HE CLAIMED THE VEH WAS WANTED IN CONNECTION WITH AN ACCIDENT WHICH OCCURRED IN SEP 95. ON 20 JAN 96, THE OPS OFFR AND TWO MILOBS WENT TO SEE LT THEOS OF THE RPA WHO PROMISED TO LOOK INTO THE CASE AND STOP THE SEIZURE OF THE VEH.

C. IN SECTOR 5 (GISENYI), IN GAKARAR SECTOR GR 3921 OF KARAGO COMMUNE, LOCALS REPORTED THAT THREE PERSONS WERE ARRESTED BY RPA ON 19 JAN 96. REASONS FOR THE ARREST IS NOT KNOWN. HR INFORMED. IN THE SAME SECTOR, THE MSF CLINIC AT KABATWA SECTOR GR 3227 WHICH HAD BEEN CLOSED EARLIER, RE-OPENED ON 18 JAN 96.







IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY HAS AMENDED ARTICLE 12 OF THE RWANDAN CONSTITUTION SO AS TO INCORPORATE IN IT CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE INTERNATIONAL COVENANT ON CIVIL AND POLITICAL RIGHTS WHICH, TAKING INTO CONSIDERATIONS THE EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES RWANDA HAS GONE THROUGH, WOULD ALLOW TO ADOPT LEGISLATION ON CRIMINAL PROCEDURES WHICH WILL RETROACTIVELY REGULARISE THE ARREST OF THOSE SUSPECTED OF CRIMES RELATED TO GENOCIDE AND TO TRY THESE SUSPECTS FOR GENOCIDE, ALTHOUGH THE RWANDAN CRIMINAL CODE DOES NOT CONTEMPLATE SUCH CRIMES.

NO PROPERTY OR MONEY WAS STOLEN FROM THOSE KILLED. MOTIVE BEHIND THE KILLINGS, IDENTITY OF THE KILLERS AND WEAPONS USED IS NOT KNOWN. HR INFORMED. IN THE SAME SECTOR, UNHCR SOURCES AT CYANGUGU AND BUKAVU HAVE REPORTED THE SPORADIC SHELLING OF THE SOUTHERN TIP OF IJWI ISLAND ON 04 JAN 96 FROM 2230 HRS TO 2330 HRS. DETAILS OF CASUALTIES, DAMAGE TO PROPERTY AND WEAPONS USED ARE NOT KNOWN.

B. MILOBS SECTOR 5B (GISENYI) WERE INFORMED BY THE RPA LO ABOUT TWO BOMB EXPLOSIONS IN GOMA IN WHICH, ONE PERSON WAS KILLED AND TWO OTHERS SERIOUSLY INJURED. THE EXPLOSIONS REPORTEDLY OCCURRED IN EARLY HOURS OF 05 JAN 96. IN THE SAME SECTOR, MILOB PATROL TO RAMBA COMMUNE (GR 4983) LEARNED ABOUT THE PRESENCE OF INFILTRATORS IN SOUS SECTOR (GR 4983) FROM THE LOCALS. THE LOCALS LIVING CLOSE TO THE FOREST COMPLAINED OF INCREASED STEALING OF THEIR CATTLE.


