Biographical Note

Brigadier General Abbebe Tefeni, who has just been appointed Commander of the United Nations forces, Katanga Area, was born in Asmara in Octobre 1918.

In 1934, he joined the Guenet Military College at Holeta, the first Military Institution established in the country. He was commissioned towards the end of 1935 by His Majesty Emperor Haile Selassie the 1st. Since then, General Abbebe has held various important offices in his country's military and civil services.

General Abbebe took an active part in the Ethiopian-Italian Campaign of 1936 as a Captain commanding regular troops. During the enemy occupation he continued resistance in guerilla fighting for a period of more than two years.

Towards the end of 1938, he was captured, and suffered under the enemy as a prisoner. However, he managed to escape and joined His Imperial Majesty Haile Selassie at Khartoum in the Sudan, and took part in the War of Liberation.

The General also studied law for four years, for which he received a Diploma. He has served on many Military Missions abroad.

He is now serving under the United Nations as the Katanga Area Commander as well as Commander of the 4th Ethiopian Brigade. Until he came to Katanga he was Assistant Chief of Staff of the Armed Forces Manpower division in Ethiopia.






