Note to the Secretary-General

Re: Alfalfa Dinner, Washington, Saturday, 30 January 1988

The plane is a Cessna Citation, tail # 300WK. It is located at Hangar G, at the far end of the airport. Telephone number for the Hangar (Wayfarer Ketch) is 914-949-4424.

4:30PM Arrive Washington National (Butler Aviation), where you will be met and taken to the Madison Hotel (202-862-1600), where rooms have been reserved for you. You will have the opportunity to freshen up and change into Black Tie.

Sunday, January 31st:
