
(3) OTHER: On 29 Aug 95. at about 2000 h the chief judge of BUTARE was murdered in SHYANDA (GR 7718) commune. A team accompanied by a civpol was sent to investigate the incident. A detailed investigation report is being forwarded separately.

- A. SECTOR HQ: Coordinated and monitored activities of Teams.  
B. TEAMS:

(1) EM-3. Team visited RUNINYA (GR 6012) communes and reported sitisation to be calm. Bourguemasters informed that on 29 Aug 95. a total of 89 refugees (4 from BURUNDI, 83 from ZAOIRE and 2 from KIBONGO) returned to the commune and by 30 Aug 95 all hed been settled in various sectors. The returnees are being welcomed by the locals.

(2) EM-4. Team visited NYAKIZU (GR 5694) commune and reported that on 28 Aug 95. a total of 208 refugees had returned to the commune and are being settled in the sectors. Situation remains generally calm.

(1) EM-1. Team visited RUHASHYA (GR 7026) and NYABISINBU (GR 7138) communes and reported situsation to be calm. Bourguemasters informed that 77 and 92 refugees from ZAIRE had returned to their communes respectively.

(2) EM-2. Team visited MUGUSA (GR 8425) commune and reported that on 28 Aug 95. a tolat of 113 refugees (93 from ZAIRE and 20 from BURUNDI) had returned to the commune. Situation remains generally calm.

(3) EM-3. Team visited MARABA (GR 6321) commune and way station, BUTARE. A total of 119 refugees (116 from ZAIRE and 3 from BURUNDI) have returned on 28 Aug 95. to the commune and situation is calm.

(4) EM-4. Team visited KIBAYI (GR 8490) commune and reported that on 28 Aug 95. a total of 126 refugees returned from BURUNDI. No major influx is expected from ZAIRE.

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

A. Team visited ESPANYA secondary high school at NYABISINDU. School needs assistance of 200 beds and mattresses, furniture items and stationaries.

B. Team visiting MARABA commune found that large qty of Maize donated by WFP was kept undistributed in commune HQ. On inquiry it was told that WFP has instructed not to distributed until the receipt of Beans and Cooking oil. Locals are agitated as they feel it is likely to go bad due to rain.



A. GEN: THE SITUATION REMAINED GENERALLY CALM THROUGH OUT THE SECTOR.

B. BORDERS: THE TWO BORDER POSTS OF KANYARU-HAUTE AND KANYARU-BAS REMAINED OPEN WITH NORMAL TRAFFIC FLOW BETWEEN RWANDA AND BURUNDI.

(3) OTHER: THERE WAS A CASE OF ATTEMPTED THEFT BY TWO ARMED MEN AT WFP HOUSE AT 2130 H ON 28 AUG 95. THE INMATES OF THE HOUSE WERE ABLE TO CALL HELP ON TELE FROM HR OFFICE WHICH INTURN ALERTED THE MILOBS AND MILPOL. THE MILOBS AND MILPOL TEAMS WERE AT THE SITE OF INCIDENT WITHIN 5 MINUTES AND THE MISCREANTS FLED THE SEEN WITHOUT ANY DAMAGE.
