4A. ACTING SECTOR COMD WENT TO RUHANGO (7752) KIGOMA (7750) AND FOUND LOCALS ARE CULTIVATING THEIR FIELDS.

B. ONE TEAM FROM GITARAMA WENT TO ROUTE RECCE FOR OPERATION HOMEWARD AT MASANGO AND REPORTED THAT FROM GALENCHE (6150) TO MASANGO (6254) MUKINIG (7161) ROUTE IS GOOD. ANOTHER TEAM WENT TO ESCORT HR TEAM TO KIGALI AT 1500 HR.

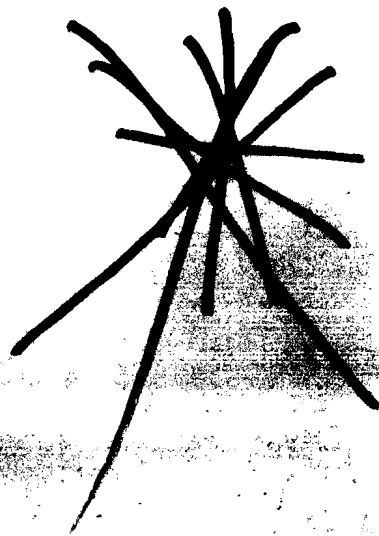
