- a) 7 Nov 95 One doctor and two nurses visited Kibuye Refugee Camp consulting and treating approx. 50 patients.  
Two nurses worked at Kigali Central Hospital recovery room for one day
- b) 8 Nov 95 Five nurses worked at Jesus Alive Orphanage in Gitarama dressing wounds and repeating the treatments previously given for scabies  
One doctor and the pharmacist visited the Gakoni Health Center. They inspected the storage facilities and advised them.  
They also consulted with numerous patients.
- c) 9 Nov 95 Two nurses worked at Kigali Central Hospital assisting in operating procedures as well as working in the recovery room.

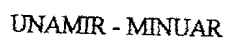

f.	Jeema pure and Natural spring water expiry date 29 May 95	Bacterial growth



2. The Emirates pure spring water and san Benedetto bottled water is considered safe for human consumption but should be tested monthly because the water is either past the expiry dates or does not have one.
3. The Glendale 1 and 4 litre bottled water as well as the Jeema water must not be used until further notice. The water will be tested and if there is still bacteria the water should be discarded.





**MAGERWA COMPOUND**

1. The subject food supplies were inspected by the FHO, MWO Rankin on 08 Nov 95. He was accompanied by Serge Smith, UNAMIR Chief of Freight Control Unit.
2. The food Supplies inspected consisted of.
  - a. UNAMIR Container FSSU 2150143 yard A - approximately 200 cartons of Emirates pure spring water with expiry date May 95.
  - b. Container 27819 - 1 yard A - full of french rations.
  - c. Container 822528 -8 Yard A - full of french rations.
  - d. Yard B warehouse - approximately two full seacontainers of french rations.
  - e. UNAMIR Container JCSU 206367 - 6 yard C - full of Emirates pure spring Water expiry date Aug 95.
  - f. UNAMIR Container 271954 - 2 yard C full of french rations.
  - g. Warehouse yard C - approximately two full seacontainers of expired french rations.
  - h. MAGERWA Container yard C - half full of San Benedetto bottled water with expiry date Nov 95.
3. The bottled water is past the expiry dates and should not be used for human consumption. Most of the french ration packs contained food that was past the expiry date. In container 271954 - 2 in particular most of the cans were rusted, food spoilage was evident and the container was infested with insects, therefore the french rations must not used for human consumption.



6. The french rations should be destroyed as soon as possible. The preferred method would be to burn and the bury them. The bottled must also be discarded.



The cans are rusting and many show signs of bulging lids. The canned mackeral and canned sardines in container 250 -2-0 were inspected and are considered safe for human consumption.

4. Any canned goods showing signs of rusting, bulging lids or badly dented cans must not be consumed.







BROWN AND ROOT KITCHEN**

1. The above facility was inspected on Tuesday 07 Nov 95. The overall cleanliness in the Kitchen has declined from when it was last inspected on 26 Sep 95. The problems noted are listed below:

- a. Grease is starting to build-up on the exhaust vents above the stove.
- b. Food is stored on the floor in the walk-in refrigerator and freezer.
- c. The floors, refrigerators, stoves and food preparation areas require a good cleaning.

2. Recommendations.


- a. A grease build-up on the exhaust vents creates a fire hazard and there is also the potential of food contamination if grease falls on food. The vents must be cleaned and maintained in a good sanitary condition.
- b. Food in walk-in refrigerator and freezer must be stored off the floor on shelves or pallets. This will help prevent food contamination from any dust and dirt on the floor and also allows for better air circulation.

3. A more stringent cleaning programme is required in the kitchen. A schedule of daily and weekly cleaning duties must be posted in the kitchen so that the cleaning staff is made aware of their cleaning duties. Supervisors must ensure that the required cleaning is carried out. The floors, cooking areas, food preparation areas and tables must be cleaned after each meal. The refrigerators and walk-in freezer must be maintained in a high standard of sanitation.

4. The potential for a food-poisoning out-break in any eating establishment is always present, therefore it is very important that the recommendations listed above be actioned as soon as possible.



5. A water sample was collected from the water used for making ice. The water was tested for Coliform bacteria. The result was negative, therefore the water is considered potable and safe for making ice.






