With reference to the recent contacts between your Mission and our office, I wish to confirm that the Secretary-General will arrive in Rome on Friday 2 April at 09.05 hrs. on flight AZ 611 from New York. He will leave Rome on Wednesday 8 April at 15.50 hrs. on flight AI 123 for Geneva.

I should be most grateful if you could kindly transmit this information to your Government. May I also take this opportunity to express the Secretary-General's sincere appreciation for your kind assistance with regard to his private stay in Italy the following weekend.
