THE SRSG GAVE A PRESS CONFERENCE TODAY ON HIS RECENT GENEVA MISSION AND ON HIS VISITS TO BRUSSELS, BONN AND LONDON. HE ALSO MET WITH DR. CLARENCE, HUMAN RIGHTS FIELD COORDINATOR WITH WHOM HE DISCUSSED THE PROCEDURES FOR HANDING TO GOVERNMENT AUTHORITIES PEOPLE WHO HAVE SOUGHT UNAMIR PROTECTION. THE SRSG MET WITH NGO REPRESENTATIVES, MANY OF WHOM ARE NEW IN THE AREA, AND PROVIDED THEM WITH AN OVERVIEW ON THE POLITICAL AND HUMANITARIAN SITUATION IN RWANDA. HE ALSO DISCUSSED OPERATIONAL ASPECTS OF OPERATION RONDAVAL WITH THE FORCE COMMANDER. THE SRSG DEPARTED FOR NAIROBI IN THE AFTERNOON FOR CONSULTATION WITH THE DIPLOMATIC COMMUNITY ACCREDITED TO KENYA. HE WILL RETURN TO HEADQUARTERS ON SATURDAY 19 NOVEMBER 1994.

- A. THE SRSG MET THE COMMISSION OF EXPERTS FOR THE INVESTIGATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS IN RWANDA. HE INFORMED THEM OF DISCUSSIONS REGARDING THE INTERNATIONAL TRIBUNAL FOR RWANDA, AND CONVEYED HIS IMPRESSIONS FROM HIS RECENT VISIT TO REFUGEE CAMPS IN NGARA.
- B. IN A SUBSEQUENT MEETING WITH THE PRIME MINISTER OF RWANDA, MR. TWAGIRAMUNGU, THE SRSG DISCUSSED THE RETURN OF REFUGEES, EMERGENCY AID AND THE INTERNATIONAL TRIBUNAL.
- C. HE ALSO HELD A MEETING WITH THE MINISTER OF JUSTICE, MR. KACYURU, FOR PURPOSES OF DISCUSSING THE INTERNATIONAL TRIBUNAL AND THE FORTHCOMING VISIT OF THE UNDER-SECRETARY GENERAL FOR LEGAL AFFAIRS, MR. HANS CORELL.
- D. A MEETING WAS HELD BETWEEN THE SRSG AND THE AMBASSADOR OF GERMANY TO RWANDA, H.E. MR. HUMMEL, TO DISCUSS THE SRSG'S PROPOSED VISIT TO GERMANY.
- E. THE SRSG ENDED HIS DAY BY MEETING MR. CLARANCE, CHIEF OF OPERATIONS FOR HUMAN RIGHTS, TO DISCUSS HUMAN RIGHTS ISSUES IN RWANDA.
