1. IMPORTANT INCIDENTS.

(A). ARRESTS:

1. 01-06-95 FROM ROSENGESI IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE YOUTH OF AGES BETWEEN 18 TO 30 ARE ARRESTED AT NIGHT BY RPA SOLDIERS AND WHERE THEY ARE TAKEN TO IS NOT KNOWN. THIS IS A SIMILAR CASE IN MANY COMMUNES

COMMENT: THIS NIGHT MIGHT BE A STRATEGY TO DISCOURAGE OR HARRASS. YOUNG MEN WHO MAY BE SYMPATHISERS OF THE FORMER GOVERNMENT.

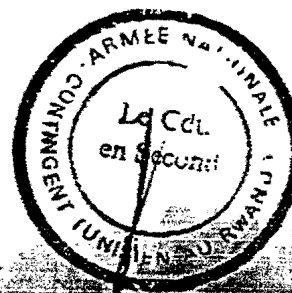

THIS AREA APPEARS TO BE ABSOLUTELY CALM WITH A HIGH DEGREE OF CULTIVATION IN PROGRESS. THE HARVEST IS REPORTED TO BE VERY GOOD.

IT SEEMS THAT THERE IS AN URGENT REQUIREMENT FOR THE WATER TEAM OF THE FORCE ENGRS TO EVALUATE THE SITUATION.
