

One mosque occupied by the RPA in a coffee plantation GR 1671 was visited by our team. The team was denied entry into the area by the RPA. Human Rights are being informed. Investigations are continuing.

GHANBAT handed over two of their local workers employed by BROWN & ROOTS, MDIZEYE JEAN BAPTISTE and BYIRINGIRO PROSPERE, to the KIBUNGO Prosecutor for being reported by three unknown witnesses from BUTARE about two months ago for allegedly involved in the genocide. The handing over was done in the presence of Human Rights and ICRC representatives. According to the Prosecutor the two victims would be kept in the KIBUNGO prison before later being transferred to BUTARE Prefecture for necessary identification and prosecution.

3. (a) One team patrolled route RILIMA 2561, GASHORA 2655, RUTETE 2242, NGENDA 0644 and BRIDGE 0972. The team also monitored activities in the NGENDA and GASHORA IDPs Transit Camps. Situation was calm.

(b) One team patrolled route KIBUNGO 6061, BIRENGA 5958, KANSANA 5461, GASHANDA 5159, NKANGA 4755, SAKE 4453, GASAVE 4257, RUBONA 3758, RWAMIBARI 3664, RUKBELI 3562 and GASHORA 2655. The team also patrolled the MUGESERA 4764 Commune and ZAZA 4759 areas. At BARE 5448, 65 IDPs who had arrived on 24 Apr 95 from TANZANIA, were still staying at the market area awaiting transportation to their various secteurs. At GAHARA Secteur 5442, the team was informed that a lot of the locals have been arrested by the local militia with the support of the RPA. Almost all males from the age of 15years who had arrived from KIBEHO Camp had been arrested. Issue has been reported to the Human Rights team.

(c) One team monitored activities in the ASPEK and NYAKIRAMBI Transit Camps where the IDPs and the old case loads returnees from TANZANIA were held respectively. The team also patrolled route RUSUMO 7549, RWANTERU 7948, NYABARAMA 8553, KANKUBWA 8860, NYARUTUNGA 8461, RUGARAMA 7463, RUSENYI 6862, RUKIRA 6658 and KIBUNGO. At NYABITARE 8754, forty(40) locals armed with bows, spears and matchets were seen patrolling along the road. They claimed that they were being harrassed by bandits from TANZANIA. The aim of their patrols was to prevent cattle stealing which was rampant in the area. At GHANBATT location in RUKIRA 6658, one Miss JOSEPHINE NIRERE aged 34years, reported that the husband MR. ASTABAZI ANASTASE aged 41 years was arrested by an RPA soldier at the KIBUNGO market on 26 Apr 95. The reason for the arrest and the whereabouts of the husband were unknown. The couple live in GAFUNZO 679636. Human Rights to investigate arrest.

(d) One team patrolled route KIBUNGO 6061, KIGARAMA 6270, KABARONDO 6278, RWINKWAVU 6782, GISHANDA 7076, RUBUMBA 7571,

KIREHE 7569, RUSEKE 8063, RUGAAMA 7462, RUKIRA 6658 and KIBUNGO. The area was generally calm.

4. (a) At the ASPEK Transit Camp, 36 returnees from ZAIRE, 27 from TANZANIA and 306 IDPs from BUTARE arrived yesterday 26 Apr 95. Today, 27 Apr 95, 157 IDPs arrived from KIGALI. 318 IDPs were transported to SAKE 4354. General situation in the camp was calm.

(b) At the NYAKIRAMBI Transit Camp, 97 oldcase loads left for KANKABWA, RWANTERU and KIREHE on their own. The camp was normal.

(c) At the NGENDA 0644 Transit Camp, 800 IDPs arrived from KIGALI Transit Camp. 160 suspects were still detained pending investigations. 1000 IDPs left for their homes on their own. Situation in the camp was reported cal.



Investigation was conducted in conjunction with Human Rights team, RUKIRA Bourgemestre, Judicial Investigator of KIBUNGO Prefecture and RPA LO. Investigations revealed the fol:
(i) Arrested persons were accused of alleged sending of money to former government forces (RGF) in ZAIRE.
(ii) EMMANUEL GASUBIDO was alleged to have died as a result of beatings he received when he resisted arrest by the RPA. However, the Bourgemestre indicated further investigations into the cause of the death.
(iii) Locals interviewed claimed that NSENGIYUMSA MORDEKANYE has not been sent by the local Hutus in BWERANKA to seek protection from GHANBATT in RUKIRA.
(iv) Bourgemestre promised to send the 10 persons who sought protection in GHANBATT Platoon location in GITUKU 703637 to their homes in BWERANKA. However, the ten persons have requested UNAMIR to send them to RUHENGARI where they originally lived before the war.
(f) Detailed report will be submitted separately on completion of further investigations into the cause of the
