PM ADOULA ARRIVED LULU BY TRAIN ON THE 4TH AT 1625 LT
AND WAS MET BY ALL PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS
HEADED BY PRESIDENT LUAKABWANGA, ANC, GENDARMERIE
MYSELF AND COLONEL ADDY. AFTER LONG SPEECHES BY
PRESIDENT LUAKABWANGA AND PM ADOULA WHERE ONUC WAS

BETWEEN ONUC AND LUAKABWANGA SHOULD BE TIGHTENED FOR THIS HE SAID HE WOULD ADVISE LUAKABWANGA DURING THEIR RETURN TRIP TO PORT FRANQUI OF THE NECESSITY OF SUCH AN IMPROVEMENT IN OUR RELATION. HE HAD WORDS OF PRAISE FOR THE UNBIASED ATTITUDE OF ONUC AND OF THE SECURITY MEASURES TAKEN BY US THAT HAVE WITH THE COOPERATION OF THE CONGOLESE FORCES AVOIDED MAJOR DISTURBANCES. ANC COMMANDER MENA AND HIS OFFICERS WERE OBVIOUSLY RELUCTANT TO ACCEPT SUCH AN ORDER. IN THE MEANTIME SITUATION IN TOWN WAS EXTREMELY TENSE AND ALL KINDS OF WILD RUMOURS WERE CIRCULATING. AT 2400 HOURS ADOULA RETURNED TO RAILWAY STATION AND EMBARKED WITH PRESIDENT LUAKABWANGA AND OTHER MINISTERS LIKE ILUNGA TO PORT FRANQUI. BY HIS JEUNESSE. THANKS TO ONUC GHANA PATROL THAT SURROUNDED THE HOUSE PREVENTED FURTHER BEATING AND BRAWL WAS AVOIDED UNTIL LOCAL POLICE CAME ON THE SPOT AND WERE OVER THE SITUATION. TODAY EYE RECEIVED PROGRAMME OF FESTIVITIES ON THE OCCASION OF THE RETURN OF PM ADOULA WHERE ONUC WAS NOT INVITED. THIS PROGRAMME WILL BE POUCHED TO YOU SOONEST. EYE CONTACTED THE CHEF DU PROTOCOLE AND ENQUIRED IF INADVERTANTLY ONUC OFFICIALS WERE OMITTED. HIS REPLY WAS APOLOGETIC AND REQUESTED THAT MYSELF AND COLONEL ADDY BE PART IN ALL THE PROGRAMME. AT 1100 HOURS THIS MORNING PM ADOULA ARRIVED FROM PORT FRANQUI BY TRAIN AND AFTER REVIEWING ANC TROOPS AND GENDARMERIE HE MADE PUBLIC SPEECHES REAFFIRMING HIS FAITH IN THE FUTURE OF THE CONGO AND THAT OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT. THIS TIME BOTH ADOULA AND PRESIDENT LUAKABWANGA MENTIONED ONUC AS HAVING BEEN PART IN THE REUNIFICATION OF THE CONGO. AT ABOUT 1300 HOURS A WINE OF HONOUR WAS OFFERED BY PRESIDENT LUAKABWANGA IN HIS RESIDENCE THAT WAS ATTENDED BY ALL THE AUTHORITIES CIVILIAN AND MILITARY, MYSELF AND COLONEL ADDY. EYE ACKNOWLEDGED THE FACT THAT EYE HAD RECEIVED COPY OF THIS LETTER OF INSTRUCTIONS THAT WAS ADDRESSED TO THE PROVINCIAL AUTHORITIES WHICH WILL BE POUCHED TO YOU. SITUATION IN LULU IS STILL TENSE BUT IMPROVING. OF COURSE THE WORD IS OUT THAT MUTSHIOKO ASSEMBLY HAS BEEN DECLARED ILLEGAL BY THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT AND IF THIS DECLARATION IS NOT SUBSTANTIATED BY ANOTHER DECREE OF THE PRESIDENT KASAVUBU EYE FEAR THAT MUTSHIOKO AND HIS PARTISANS WILL NOT ABIDE AND TROUBLE CAN STILL BE EXPECTED. THEREFORE ONUC VIGILANCE HAS NOT BEEN RELAXED
