Disbursement to Goma, Bukavu and Tanzania camps (i.e humanitarian aid outside Rwanda cannot be ascertained as according to UNHCR, Assistance budget is given sectorwise i.e, in terms of food, transport, health etc. etc. in the sub-regional context. Even in this case, the expenditure for the year 1995 is yet to be finally calculated. However UNHCR appeal for assistance to Burundi, Rwandan refugees and returnees in 1996 has been made for a sum of US\$288 million. Actual contribution received is 52 million thereby giving a shortfall of 225 million.
