1. Many thanks for your MIR-2174 of 12 June 1995 regarding UNAMIR's force structure for the revised mandate and the helpful proposals contained therein.

2. We agree with the proposed deployment and structure of the force. However, its composition needs to be adjusted in the light of recent developments. Indeed, Tunisia has advised us of its decision to withdraw its battalion. A copy of the Note Verbale received from the Permanent Mission of Tunisia on 14 June is attached. We also expect the Zambian contingent to be withdrawn, since Zambia has been asked to provide an infantry battalion to UNAVEM III. These aspects are covered in the subsequent paragraphs.

Sectors and troop deployments


3. Infantry contingents

a. Sector 1 - Kigali. The proposal for the Indian battalion is approved. However, it is preferable and easier to redeploy a rifle company from the Ghanaian battalion, instead of bringing a fresh one from India.

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- b. Sector 2 - Kibungo. As proposed, a Ghanaian company group should remain in this sector.
- c. Sector 3 - Gikongoro. A Ghanaian company group should be redeployed in this sector, for the reason mentioned in para. 2 above.
- d. Sector 4 - Gisakura. As proposed, an Ethiopian company group should remain in this sector.
- e. Sector 5 - Nyondo. A Ghanaian company group should also be redeployed in this sector, due to the Tunisian withdrawal.

4. The composition of the force should be flexible, so as to take into consideration possible decisions by contributing countries regarding their participation at the envisaged level. In case of an eventual shortfall after these readjustments, the following countries would be approached: Malawi, Nigeria and Ethiopia.

5. Command and control: We endorse your intention to place sector one under Indian operational control and sectors 2, 3, 4 } Did I say that?
and 5 under Ghanaian operational control.

Support units

6. Medical unit. Presently, we do not have a confirmed replacement for the Australian field hospital. Thirty two countries have been approached but, so far, only India and Slovakia have shown some interest and their formal responses are expected shortly.

7. Movement control unit. Australia, Canada and India have been approached. The final composition of this unit will be determined in light of the reaction of the countries concerned.

8. Finally, it would be helpful, for the further consideration of the downsizing of UNAMIR personnel and equipment, if you could send us your rotation plan at the earliest possible date.
