EXPLANATORY NOTE

The archives of the United Nations War Crimes Commission, transferred in May 1949 to the United Nations Archives, include several series of documents of major importance. Most of these, including the minutes and documents of the Commission itself and of its committees, were indexed by the War Crimes Commission. This index, which appeared in six parts, has been consolidated in a single document by the United Nations Archives and published as United Nations Archives Reference Guide No. 11, "Index to Minutes and Documents of the United Nations War Crimes Commission, 1945-1948."

The papers of the Research Office of the War Crimes Commission were not covered by the original index, however, and the United Nations Archives prepared an index to the major publications series of the Research Office, published as United Nations Archives Reference Guide No. 12.

The "War Crimes News Digest" (the first issues of which bear the title "Press News Summary") was published periodically in mimeographed form from 31 October 1945 to 4 March 1948. Of the total of thirty-six issues, the first twenty-four were indexed in three documents by the War Crimes Commission.

The present index, prepared by the United Nations Archives, covers News Digest Nos. XXV (24 February 1947) to XXXVI (4 March 1948).

The Roman figures refer to the serial number of the News Digest; the Arabic to the number of the page.
