SAME FOUND THE SITUATION NORMAL, THOUGH IT RECEIVED INFORMATION ABOUT 2 PERSONS SAID TO BE ARRESTED BY RPA RECENTLY IN CONNECTION WITH PREVIOUS WAR KILLINGS. MORE DETAILS WILL BE FORWARDED WHEN OBTAINED.


