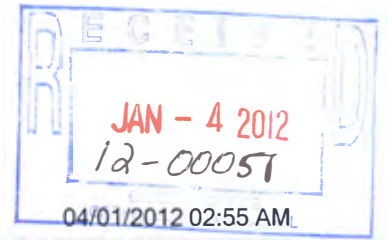

I wish you and your family a happy 2012.

I have seen yesterday's announcement of the upcoming departure of the ED of the WFP to the World Economic Forum.

Even though I understand some of the context, I must - in my capacity as Global Ambassador Against Hunger for the UN WFP - say that it is a loss for the organization.

At the same time I have spoken to a number of private sector partners of WFP, who all confirmed that they will continue to do what is best for the beneficiaries of WFP, the hungry people of the world.

I do think it would be good that the eventual successor to the ED position will early on spend time with the private sector partners to reconfirm the partnerships.

As per January 1, 2012 I have now started in my new capacity as President of the World Business Council for Sustainable Development in Geneva (WBCSD). I have much appreciated to receive your letter of congratulation.

The reason for this email is to ask you for a brief meeting.

I would like to give you a short report of my recent period as full time ambassador to the WFP, and at the same time introduce WBCSD to you.

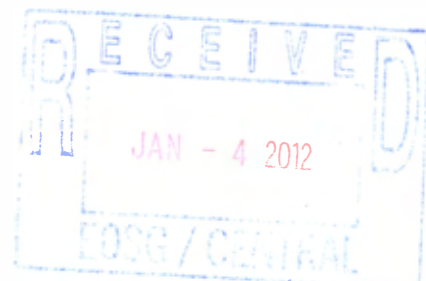
In particular our plans for the upcoming RIO+20 meeting could be interesting to share with you.
