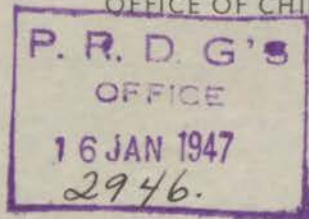



Dear Mr. Erlam:

This will confirm your assignment to the post of Chief UNRRA Liaison Officer in Berlin. As you know, Gen. Vincent E. Meyer who occupied the post of Deputy Chief of Operations and who has been stationed in Berlin for the past year, has now resigned to return to the United States, and I am, therefore, eager that you proceed immediately to Berlin so that there will be no gap in the continuity of the UNRRA program there.

I have discussed with you the nature of your duties and you will realize the importance of your task in view of the impending move of the Arolsen CHQ from Germany to Paris, where UNRRA is establishing a new Headquarters for D. P. Operations in Europe. As the Chief Liaison Officer in Berlin you are a member of the staff of the Chief of Operations, and you are expected, therefore, to report directly to me.

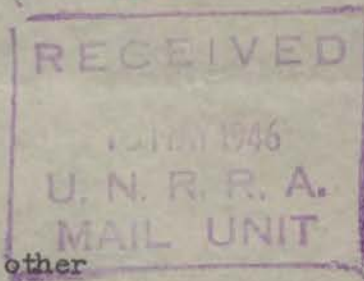

TO : Brigadier General Vincent Meyer

SUBJECT : Responsibilities and functions of
Deputy Chief of Operations, Liaison, Berlin.

1. You will act in all respects as my deputy in Berlin. Your title will be Deputy Chief of Operations Liaison, Berlin.
2. The fulfilment of this appointment demands that you interest yourself in all aspects of U.N.R.R.A.'s task in Germany to the end that :-
 - a. You will keep me constantly apprised of any and all measures in contemplation by the Co-ordinating Committee which may affect, in any way, the Displaced Persons Operation in Germany.
 - b. You will be prepared to negotiate with the heads of Military Missions established in Berlin, any business on behalf of UNRRA deemed necessary by you, by this headquarters or by higher UNRRA authority.
 - c. You will open negotiations on behalf of UNRRA with the Economic Directorate of the Control Staff with a view to making available to UNRRA in Germany, any indigenous supplies that UNRRA may require.
 - d. You will furnish such liaison service to Central Headquarters and to the British, United States and French UNRRA Zones as may appropriately be requested by them.
3. In furtherance of the accomplishment of the foregoing tasks, it is desired that you make the following personal contacts :-
 - a. With each individual member including both principal and alternates of the Co-ordinating Committee.
 - b. With the four commanders of the Berlin Sectors with whom it may be necessary for you to work in connection with local Berlin problems.
 - c. With such of the Political Advisors, such members of the Control Staff and such Consular Officials or other Government Interests Representatives as may be necessary and desirable.
 - d. With the heads of all Military Missions established in Berlin.
 - e. With the Combined Repatriation Executive Sub-section, the Combined Travel Security Board and the Central Tracing Policy Board.
4. As the senior UNRRA official in Berlin, you will supervise the activities of all UNRRA personnel in that area and also those of Voluntary Agencies personnel in all cases in which the work of such

agencies is being carried on in Berlin under the aegis of UNRRA.

5. The initial composition of the liaison group under your direction will consist of the following :-

Deputy Chief of Operations, Liaison
1 Welfare Officer
1 Supply Officer
1 Personal Assistant
1 Secretary
1 Interpreter
1 Driver

6. You will submit a written report to me as of Saturday each week on the progress of your mission to Berlin.
