Dear Secretary-General Ban :

As a Member of Parliament of Mongolia, I am writing to express my support for Taiwan's bid for meaningful participation in the activities of the United Nations specialized agencies.

Since 1971, Taiwan was denied participation in the conferences, mechanisms and conventions of the UN and its specialized agencies, thereby creating a major breach in the operations of the UN systems and seriously affecting the welfare of people in Taiwan.

By allowing Taiwan's participation in international cooperation projects of UN specialized agencies, many of their projects would prove to be more effective. It would also be helpful for the two sides of the Taiwan Strait to develop cooperation through working together on issues of mutual concern, thereby reducing misunderstanding and friction gradually. Thus, the possibility of conflict in the Taiwan Strait will be greatly reduced and the stability and prosperity in the Asia-Pacific region as well as the whole world can be further promoted and strengthened.

I respectfully urge you to do whatever you can to support for the inclusion of Taiwan's bid as a supplementary item on the provisional agenda of the 63rd session of the UN General Assembly commencing on September 16, 2008.
