



Dr. Shyam Singh Shashi's book 'Roma-The Gypsy World', published in 1990 has been rated the highest marks with 5-Star (amazon.com). The book has been well reviewed in Indian and Foreign press. The renowned Roma scholar, Dr. Vania Kochanowsky, Prof. Ian Hancock and other scholars have profusely quoted the book in their research writings. Dr. Shashi's research work on Roma was based on participant and non-participants' observation and a socio-anthropological study of 1000 Roma families, living in various countries.

His four more English books have been rated with the 100% highest marks and 5-Star. These are: 'Tribal Women of India', 'Shepherds of India', 'A Socio-History of Ex-criminal Communities OBCs' and 'Encyclopaedia of Indian Tribes' (10 vols.) if counted 9 volumes, there may be total number of books -14. The book was recently released by Mrs. Kiran Mehra Kerpelman, Director, United Nations Information Centre, India & Bhutan. हमें यह लिखते हुए प्रसन्नता का अनुभव होता है कि प्रो. डा. श्याम सिंह शशि की पांच अंग्रेजी पुस्तकों को विश्व-स्तरीय रेटिंग में अमेजन डॉट कॉम ने शत-प्रतिशत अंक तथा प्रत्येक को 5-स्टार दिए हैं। उनका अंग्रेजी विश्वकोश 'एनसाइक्लोपीडिया ऑफ इंडियन ट्राइब्स' 10 खंडों में है, अतः उनकी संख्या को मिलाकर कुल 14 पुस्तकें होती हैं। 'रोमा-द जिप्सी वर्ल्ड' उनका कालजयी शोध-ग्रंथ है जिसके लिए उन्होंने 75 देशों में नृ-वैज्ञानिक सर्वेक्षण तथा शोधयात्राएं की हैं। किसी लेखक को इस विषय में शायद ही इतनी पुस्तकों को विश्व-स्तरीय रेटिंग-सम्मान मिला हो।

उनकी नई पुस्तक 'नोमेड्स ऑफ इंडिया' (नेशनल बुक ट्रस्ट) नोबेल पुरस्कार विजेता श्री कैलाश सत्यार्थी को समर्पित है। वस्तुतः डा. शशि की लेखन-प्राथमिकता कविता रही है। उनका 'अग्निसागर' महाकाव्य बहुचर्चित रहा है जिसपर 1992-93 में 10 एपीसोड का धारावाहिक टी.वी. पर आया था। हाल ही में प्रकाशित उनका नया वृहत् कविता-संग्रह 'एकला चलो रे!' चर्चा में आया है, जिसकी समीक्षा साहित्य अकादेमी की पत्रिका समकालीन भारतीय साहित्य, मई-जून 2015 में प्रकाशित हुई है। काव्य-प्रेमी पाठकों के लिए इस अंक में दी जा रही है - प्र.सं. तथा संपादक मंडल।

समीक्षा - 'एकला चलो रे' : योगेन्द्रनाथ शर्मा 'अरुण' साहित्य अकादेमी द्वारा प्रकाशित 'समकालीन भारतीय साहित्य', अंक मई-जून 2015

रवीन्द्रनाथ का शब्द-स्तवन

जदि तोर डाक सुने केउ न आसें
तबे एकला चलो रे.....

किशोरावस्था में कच्ची पक्की दृष्टि से पठित ये पक्तियां
दिशा दे रही हैं - मेरे वर्तमान को
कबीरी रहस्य में बाँसुरी की तान को
सत्यं शिवं सुंदरम् के संगीत महान को।
रवींद्र साम-गान को!! (पृ.300)

निश्चय ही यह कविता संपूर्ण विश्व द्वारा गीतांजलि के महान कवि
रवीन्द्रनाथ ठाकुर का शब्द-स्तवन ही तो है।

प्रस्तुत कविता-संग्रह 'एकला चलो रे' का समर्पण भी इस तथ्य की संपुष्टि
कर देता है। कवि श्यामसिंह शशि ने विश्वकवि के चित्र के ऊपर अपनी
'प्रेरणा' बनी पक्तियों 'जदि तोर डाक सुने केउ न आसे तबे एकला चलो रे!' को
को स्थान देकर चित्र के नीचे अपनी श्रद्धा इन शब्दों में गूँथी है :

भारतीय कवियों के प्रेरणा-स्रोत विश्वकवि
रवीन्द्रनाथ ठाकुर की स्मृति को सारस्वत-समर्पण

कविवर शशि ने अपने सुदीर्घ कवि-जीवन में विश्व कवि रवीन्द्रनाथ ठाकुर
की इस 'एकला चलो रे' कविता को पूरी निष्ठा के साथ जिया है। 'रवींद्र
साम-गान को' आत्मसात् करते हुए वह लिखते हैं :

रवींद्र उवाच-एकाकी हूँ
तुम्हारे द्वार आया हूँ, मुझे शक्ति दो!
भक्ति दो!!
अनुशक्ति दो!!!
बलराम हो तुम निर्बल के
दीन-दुखियों के शक्तिमान हो तुम
तुमल कोलाहल में, तुम्हारे सम्मुख हूँ
दो मुझे दिशा दो!
मैं अकेला चल रहा था, अब तुम्हारा साथ है
क्या करूँगा और लेकर नाथ ही जब साथ है! (पृ.298)

इस कविता में लिखे शब्द 'क्या करूँगा और लेकर' कहीं गहरे छू लेते हैं। अगली
पंक्ति 'नाथ ही जब साथ है' के 'नाथ' को सशक्त व्यंजना कवि की रचनाधर्मिता से हमें
परिचित कराती है। एक और कविता 'नौका-विहार' ने पूरे विश्व को गीतांजलि के रूप में
भारतीय दर्शन एवं भारतीय संस्कृति का अमृत देनेवाले विश्व कवि के जीवंत-चिंतन दर्शन
को आत्मसात् कर कवि ने अपनी रचनाओं में गूँथ दिया है :

अंध महासागर पर
यात्रा करते हुए / समुद्री जहाज से
गीतांजलि-स्वर गुंजे थे / मेरे रसिक कानों में -
चलो हम दोनों / करेंगे नौका-विहार
तीसरा नहीं होगा / सागर के आर-पार
स्वदेश लौट आता हूँ / रवींद्र मिल जाते हैं
हुगली के तट पर / प्रभु के साथ-साथ
नौका-विहार में / तुम भी विश्व-यात्री थे
आज भी प्रेरक हो / केवल बाग़ना ही नहीं
भारतीय कवियों के / विश्व के कवियों के!! (पृ.296)

एकला चलो रे में कुल ग्यारह खंडों में कवि की विशिष्ट कविताएँ संकलित हैं, जो
उनके पूर्व काव्य-संकलनों में स्थान पा चुकी हैं अथवा अप्रकाशित हैं। इन कविताओं से

स्पष्ट प्रतीत होता है कि विभिन्न कालखंडों में रची गई कवि शशि की अनेक कविताओं की
भाव-भूमि में 'रवींद्र साम-गान' रहा है।

संग्रह के प्रथम खंड 'सागर-तीरे' की कविताओं में कवि की अदम्य जिजीविषा के
साथ-साथ श्रेष्ठतर जीवन-मूल्यों के प्रति उनकी अडिग-अजेय आस्था के दर्शन भी होते हैं :

मैं कल फिर आऊँगा / उगूँगा बंजर खेत में
किसी आत्महत्या करते किसान के / उजाला बाँटूँगा अधिवारे घरों को
जहाँ आज भी बच्चा लालटेन की रोशनी में
ककहरा याद करता है, धधकूँगा ज्वाला बन
शोषण-अन्याय-ईर्ष्या-द्वेष और पूर्वाग्रहों के विरुद्ध
तपूँगा किसी सुर्व पुत्र की तरह। (पृ.21)

उक्त कविता में व्याप्त अदम्य जिजीविषा पाठक के निराश-हताश हृदय में एक विलक्षण
ज्योति-पुंज भरकर उसे विश्वकवि रवीन्द्रनाथ ठाकुर की 'एकला चलो रे' की गूँज से जोड़
देती है। शशि का काव्य-चिंतन उसके लिए शब्दामृत बन जाता है :

मैं इबता सूरज हूँ / कल का यौवन हूँ
चढ़ते सूरज को प्रणाम करने वाले दोस्त,
मैं निराशा को आशा में बदलता / जन-जन का जीवन हूँ। (पृ.21)

संकलन के दूसरे खंड में कवि शशि के चर्चित काव्य अग्निसागर के अंश दिए गए हैं।
इस काव्य में जीवन देनेवाले 'मनु' के इस 'आत्मदाह' को वाणी दी है, जिसने मानवता के
इस जनक को 'प्रक्षेपों के अग्निसागर' में ढकेलकर झुलसा दिया :

मैंने कब कहा कि नारी या शूद्रों को
अधिकार नहीं श्रुतियों को सुनने मनने का ?
मैंने कब कहा कि जूठन अंत्यज खाएंगे ?
कब कहा न दंडित हो पंडित अपने दुष्कर्मों के कारण ?
मैंने कब कहा धर्म-सम्मत दलितों या पिछड़ों का शोषण ?

खंड-तीन में विश्व कविता की ओर काव्य-संग्रह से कुछ श्रेष्ठ रचनाएँ चयनित की गई
हैं, जिनमें कवि का व्यापक 'मानवतावादी' चिंतन मुखर हुआ है -

सोचता हूँ - क्या कोई चंद्रगुप्त आएगा
और समरसता की सुरसरी तमाम धरती पर बहाएगा।
विश्व-शांति की ध्वजा वसुंधरा पर फहराएगा। (पृ.81)

इसी खंड में संकलित 'वसुधैव कुटुंबकम्', 'ठहाके', 'विश्वभरा' और 'चक्रव्यूह' में जैसी
रचनाएँ पाठकों को कवि के मानवतावादी चिंतन से अवश्य प्रेरित करेंगी। चौथा खंड 'कृतज्ञता'
को वाणी देकर भारतीय मनीषा के अग्रदूत सुब्रह्मण्य भारती, वल्लतोल, तुलसी, मार्क्स एवं
रवीन्द्रनाथ के प्रति कवि ने अपनी कृतज्ञता व्यक्त की है :

वल्लतोल ठहाका लगाते हैं
सागर की हँसी-सा और फिर विचार-सागर में समा जाते हैं
मुझे 'सुख माणो' का उत्तर मिल जाता है। (पृ.116)

यह काव्य-संकलन वस्तुतः कवि शशि की समग्र काव्य-सर्जना का 'संचयन' है, जिसमें
आरंभ से लेकर अद्यतन प्रकाशित-अप्रकाशित काव्य-रचनाओं से प्रतिनिधि कविताएँ संकलित
हैं। 'युद्धकालीन कविताएँ', 'शिलानगर में', 'यात्रावरी', 'ढाई आखर' और 'विविध' शीर्षक
से प्रस्तुत इन खंडों में पाठकगण कवि के समग्र काव्य-चिंतन का रसास्वादन कर सकते हैं।
खंड पाँच में प्रकलित गीत यह महा-हिमालय मेरा है' का अंतिम छंद उद्धृत करना उपयुक्त
जान पड़ता है :

मेरे पुरखों की यात्री तू, तन भी तेरा मन भी तेरा,
मैं जीता तेरे लिए रहूँ, ओ कुछ भी हो मेरा-तेरा।
मंदिर-मस्जिद-गिरिजाघर सब, गुरुद्वारों में स्वर मेरा है
यह महा-हिमालय मेरा है, उतुंग हिमालय मेरा है।
हिम-शिखर हिमालय मेरा है, सुंदरतम आलय मेरा है। (पृ.135)

(Dr.) Shyam Singh Shashi's book 'Nomads of India' (Published by National Book Trust, Govt. of India) - Excerpts from Preface of the book - an appeal to UNO

I am happy to introduce the 'Nomads of India' to the younger generation, particularly teenagers. This is not a story book just for entertainment but a contribution to the knowledge of mankind. I have studied the nomadic communities of India and the world at large, travelling and conducting socio-anthropological researches in the Himalayas and various tribal belts in India and abroad. The readers may like to refer my other books for intensive studies on these people. Some books are : 'Nomads of the Himalayas', 'The World of Nomads', 'Roma-The Gypsy World', 'Shepherds of India', 'Tribal Women of India', 'Himalaya Ke Yayavar', 'Roma-Vishwa Ke Yayavar', etc.

I also consulted the studies and books on these subjects authored by eminent social scientists - Dr. Donald Kenrick, Dr. Rena Gropper, Dr. Acton Thomas, Dr. Ian Hancock, Dennis Binns, Dr. Hristo Kyuchukov, Dr. Nidhi Trehan and others.

When I was young, I travelled with these people as a researcher and a writer. In fact, in my childhood, I was amazed to see the nomadic life of the Gadia Luhars who used to travel from one village to another for selling their iron equipments. They would stay in one village for some time and then move to another village or town. They called themselves as the descendants of Maharana Pratap, the King of Chittor in Rajasthan. Their *gotras* are similar to those of Kshatriyas or Rajput communities viz. Sisodia, Rathore, Chauhan, etc. Different names and spellings of various castes and tribes are in use by anthropologists and historians, especially in the case of Gujjars. Therefore I have referred to them differently.

History says: when Maharana Pratap was defeated by the Mughals, he had to leave his fort. His artisan soldiers took a vow that they would not have a settled home, would not eat in a plate and would not sleep on cot till the fort is re-conquered. Thus they became nomads and even after the independence of the country, their present generation leads a semi-nomadic life.

During my visit to Europe and America in 1981, I met many nomadic people, known as Roma, Gypsies, Gitanos, Sinti and Manus. They migrated from India one thousand years ago and speak many Hindi-Hindustani words in their home-language 'Romani'

viz. 'Kan' for ear, 'Bal' for hair, 'Nak' for nose, 'Yankh' (Ankh) for eye, 'Jao' for go and 'Mei' for I, etc. I travelled with them in their *karvans* in various countries and wrote books - 'Roma Children Around the World', 'Desh-Desh Mein Roma Bachche', etc.

We generally talk about the great world travellers - Columbus, Vasco-De-Gama, Fi-yan and When-Sang but not the people mentioned above. In this book we are going to introduce such people who are neglected and are disadvantaged groups of the society. It is not a story book but a factual narration of nomadic people of India.

I would like to express my sincere thanks to the social scientists, educationists and writers who have constantly given me assistance in my research-work.

I am sure, the book will create an awareness among the young readers about the forgotten and neglected communities and to work for their well-being in missionary spirit.

I appeal to the social, academic and cultural activists of India and the world including Ban Ki-Moon, Secretary General, United Nations, UNESCO, UNICEF, Roma-Banjara organizations and all peace-lovers to pay special attention to these nomads of India and other countries.

Number of organizations viz World Roma Organization Rromanipen, Belgrade, Serbia, headed by **Jovan Damjanovic**, Bhartiya Adim Jati Sevak Sangh, founded by Thakkar Bapa, Research Foundation International, Roma Research Center, International Roma Cultural University - Belgrade, International Goodwill Society of India, Institute of UN-UNESCO Studies, Antar Rashtriya Sahayog Parishad, Delhi and a number of eminent scholars are associated with the Roma and nomadic communities' movement in India and abroad. I have sought their advice in the work. I am thankful to all.

Lastly, I dedicate this book to Kailash Satyarthi, founder of 'Bachpan Bachao Andolan' and winner of Nobel Peace Prize 2014.

He had just launched his latest book (he has written around 400) on the Nomads of India and presented a copy to UNIC Director for Mr. Ban Ki-Moon."

DR. SHYAM SINGH SHASHI: PROFILE

An eminent Social Scientist, Poet, Litterateur, Academician, Journalist, Dr. Shyam Singh Shashi (डा. श्याम सिंह शशि) was awarded 'PADMASHRI' in 1990 for his multifaceted achievements in the field of literature of two languages-Hindi and English. A Socio-Anthropologist of International repute, he has **400 books** to his credit, which include-20 collections of poems, one epic-Agnisagar, 24 books and monologues on tribals including nomadic communities and 10 travelogues, 2 dictionaries.



5 encyclopaedias and 25 books for children. His 300 books in English include 'The World of Nomads', 'Nomads of the Himalayas', 'Tribal Women of India', 'Roma-The Gypsy World', 'Nehru and the Tribals', 'Gaddis of Himalayas', 'A Socio-History of Ex-criminal communities OBCs', 'White Darkness' (Poetry) etc. His first book 'Lal Savera' (Poetry) appeared in his teens and four before his Graduation. His books have been published by over 30 publishers in India and abroad. He has edited 50 volumes of Encyclopaedia of Humanities and Social Sciences, 12 Volumes of Encyclopaedia of Indian Tribes. 10 Volumes of Encyclopaedia of World Women and 200 Vols. of Encyclopaedia

INDICA.

Rating him as one of the few Hindi poets who have shown human concerns, the doyen of Indian Literature **Dr. Mulk Raj Anand** says "Your poems promise survival... I hope you will one day face the challenges to man like Alen Ginsberg and the other poets who are aware of the dangers before humanity." His anthropological epic '**Agnisagar**' (अग्निसागर) based on the unending journey of man-Manu or Menes interpreting '**Manusmriti**' in social change has been acclaimed as the best model of modern poetry in Hindi and world literature. Scholars conducted research on this monumental work and obtained Ph.D., D.Phil. etc. His book 'Vishwa Kavita ki or' (Towards World Poetry) is a landmark in contemporary world literature.

His creative literature in Hindi has been admired by Sumitranandan Pant, Ramdhari Singh Dinkar, Viyogi Hari, Sohan Lal Dwivedi and various Indian Language writers of eminence like Uma Shankar Joshi, G. Shankar Kurup, Dr. Dasarathi, Amrita Pritam and C. Narayana Reddy who have spoken high of Dr. Shashi's poetry that underlines basic issues haunting the humanity today.

Dr. Shashi has been **honoured** by Govts. of U.P., H.P., A.P., Bihar and various leading Institutions in India and abroad for his contributions to literature. In 1991, **Hindi Akademi** (Delhi State) honoured him with cash award for his outstanding achievements in Hindi literature and Uttar Pradesh Hindi Sansthan (U.P. Govt.) awarded him for his epic '**Agnisagar**'. On 14th Sept. 93 he got another national award-**Mahapandit Rahul Sankrityayan Puruskar** with a cash prize for his contribution to nomadic literature. On 2nd Oct. '93. he got yet another national award - **Mahakavi Jai Shankar Prasad Puruskar** for his epic '**Agnisagar**' besides felicitations in India and Abroad. Dr. Shashi has been honoured by many organisations of India and abroad. In 2007 he was felicitated in Mauritius, Belgrade, Serbia Republic etc. In 2008, U.P. Govt. Hindi Sansthan honoured him with **Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Sahitya Samman** along with a cash prize of Rs.2,00,000/- which he donated to the cause of Hindi, Indian Languages and social work.

Widely travelled, Dr. Shashi was born on 1st July 1936 in an agricultural and freedom fighter's family of village Bahadurpur near Haridwar. His studies and researches into tribal life and culture have taken him to numerous travels in India and abroad to 75 countries in Asia, Europe, the Americas etc.

During his two-months' literary journey in USA, UK from May to July 2003, Dr. Shashi was honoured by various International literary and cultural organisations. Vishwa Hindi Samiti America invited him as Chief Guest at their special function and presented a plaque on June 22, 2003 in recognition of his invaluable contribution and service to literature and culture. Earlier, he participated in seminars and conferences and also presided over number of poetic symposia organised by Antar-rashtriya Hindi Samiti USA in North Carolina and other organisations in Cary, Austine, California and UK. He has been interviewed by various leading newspapers, journals television channels and Voice of America. 'New York's weekly *Caribbean New Yorker*' of 20th June, 2003 published his interview on front page. Later, Dr. Shashi was honoured in

First in many fields, Dr. Shashi is the first scholar to get his Doctorate in Sociology of **Himalyan Nomads** from Agra University under the able guidance of Dr. R.N. Saxena, an eminent social scientist of international repute. He is again the first scholar to be conferred upon with D.Litt. in Anthropology for his pioneering work on **Roma of Europe** and America by the International University-Colombo, Sri Lanka. He topped in his classes from 8th Std. to M.A. He has his post Graduation in **Man Management** and Man Power Planning from Manchester University **England**. He taught Sociology, Mass Communication, translation and delivered lectures on Indian culture, nomadic tribes, poetry etc. in various Universities of India and abroad. He is the first sociologist in India, who has edited-authored five vols. of the first encyclopaedia of Social sciences in Hindi. He is also the first Anthropologist who travelled from Mexico to Japan for research on sun-worship and wrote a book on sun temples of the World.

Dr. Shashi, though a Poet-Anthropologist, has been a very successful Media Head and Director, Director-General, Publications Division, I & B. Govt. of India, for about 10 years. Earlier he was the Editor of *'Sainik Samachar'* (Armed Forces). In Pub. Div. he controlled 20 journals in 12 languages viz. *Yojana* (Planning Commission), *Indian & Foreign Review* (Ministry of External Affairs), *Kurukshetra* (Ministry of Rural Development), *Employment News*, *Ajkal* (Hindi & Urdu), *Balbharti* (Children's Magazine), etc. and welfare organisation viz. ISA, IAA, AGI. Translators Association. He fought in the promotion of Indian Languages and resigned three times from Govt. service but ultimately succeeded. He however, decided to leave Govt. service on voluntary retirement basis. He kept himself engaged as Visiting Professor, consultant in various Universities/Institutions in India and abroad.

Ten episodes of Dr. Shashi's epic '*Agnisagar*' were telecast on National TV in 1993-94 and a dance drama on the same was performed by Nalini-Kamalini (Kathak Dancers) in 2003. Dr. Shashi also wrote TV serials and Radio Dramas.

Books—Dr. Shashi published his first book in his teens and 100 books till 1990 and 300 books in English and Hindi after his voluntary retirement from Govt. service. (Profile presented by Dr. H.K. Kaul, English Poet and Secy. General, Poetry Society of India on the occasion of poetry reading programme at India International Center New Delhi by the single poet, Dr. Shashi for about two hours. The function was attended by a number of eminent poets and writers (Today's Engagement column Hindustan Times, dated May 31, 2007). Later, on 2nd Dec. 2010 Dr. Shashi recited his poems at Kavi Sandhi (single poet's reading) of Sahitya Akademi Programme.)

I have been trying to create an atmosphere of peace, non-violence, love and brotherhood through my pen and action which are reflected in my books and articles on variety of subjects.

"Indian Literature" - 150 Vol.(Jul-Aug 1992): "Shyam Singh Shashi's Hindi epic *Agnisagar* is based on the legendary Manu, the first man on earth, his wife, Sraddha; his mistress Ira; his son Manav and the scattered survivors after the great Flood. But then this is the skeleton plot of the epic. the main strength of the work is the re-interpretation of *Manusmriti* and demolition of numerous misnotions popularly held about the class-structure in India society. It is therefore a poetic attempt to restore the authentic message of *Manusmriti* and to weed out the chunk of social rules added by the interpolators attributing to the sage Manu.....As a form, *Agnisagar* qualifies the traditional traits even as it is far less in detailed treatment than the old epics. It has a lofty theme, grand style, lofty purpose, variety of verification, a mission and description of nature and society. It has more than seven cantos required in an epic. Despite these features the term epic may be a bit controversial for its spatial limitation. The epic contains a commentary of our time. This is not an age of epic and the epics attempted by the ambitious poets are merely of academic interest and even there the fate is uncertain. But then, certainly this is a model which will be advantageously seized by the coming generations." - Manohar Bandhopadhyay

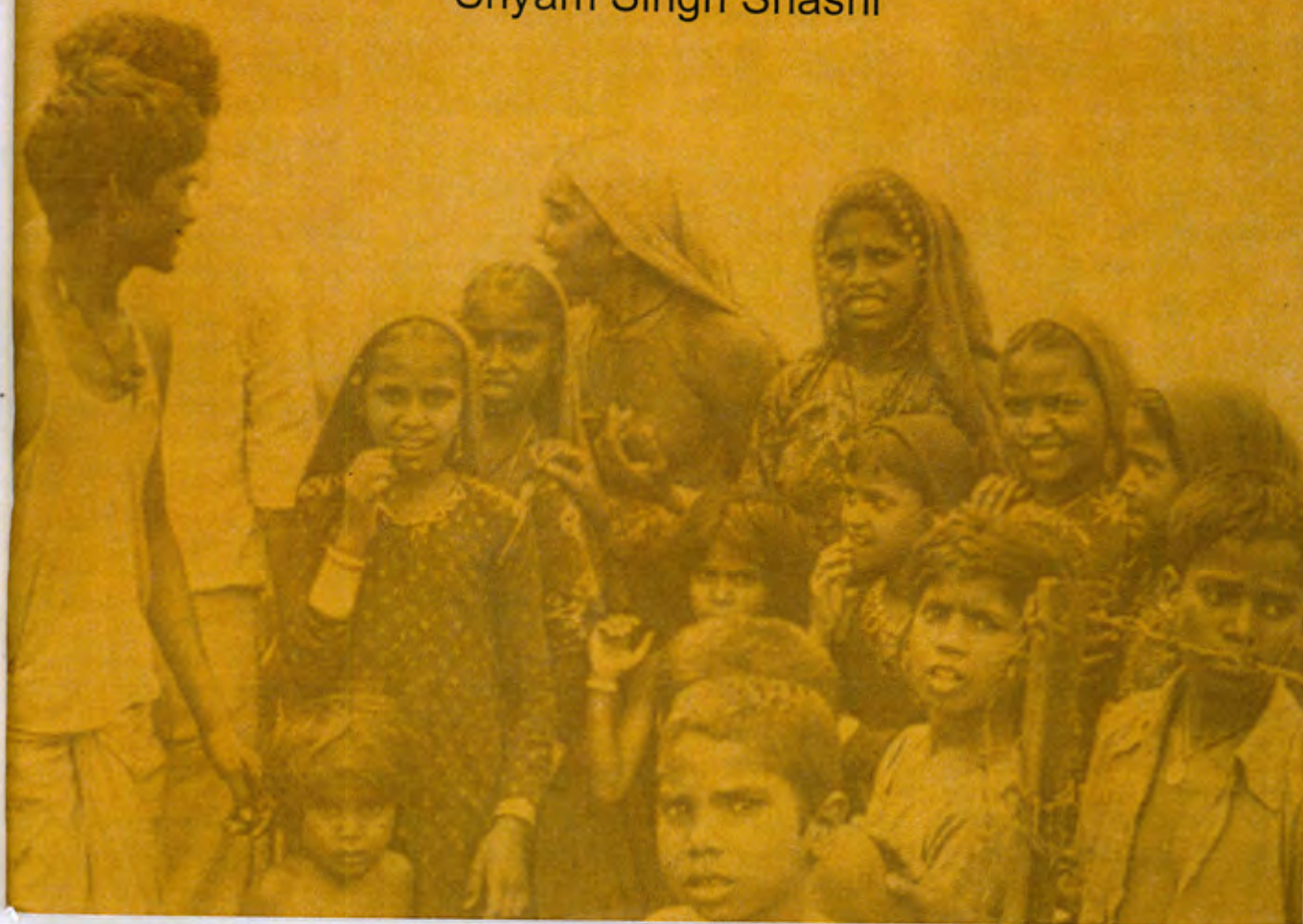
