Global Governance is a kind of world ordering principle founded on the conviction that global problems demand global solutions by global players. What with a diverse and growing number of traditional and new players in the world of politics, the UN undoubtedly remains the universal institution to accommodate conflicting or diverse interests and take co-operative action. In order to sustain a widely recognized role of the world's central organization and address new issues of global development, the UN requires an up-to-date personnel strategy. As a response, a multilateral awareness-raising, education and training strategy for the UN system can be put forward. Consequently, this calls for development of a practical model of a UN Global Governance Training Centre to become a foundation work of that strategy.

The goal of the proposed project is to contribute to the creation of new communicational, educational and training patters for the UN system, along the lines of the global governance concept. This can be done in form of a multilateral awareness-raising, education and training strategy aimed to tackle the global problems, i.e. poverty, terrorism, HIV-AIDS, human rights and environment. 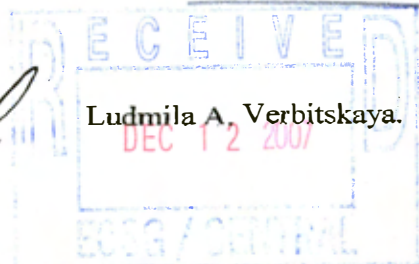
