1. STOCKHOLM REPORT INCORRECT AS NO CABLE ON THIS SUBJECT HAS BEEN SENT FROM WASHINGTON TO HUNGARY.
2. IN CONVERSATIONS HERE HELD BY COHEN AND SCHACTER WITH HUNGARIAN REPRESENTATIVE IT WAS AGREED THAT HUNGARIAN REPRESENTATIVES SHOULD CONTACT ERO TO DISCUSS PROBLEM OF ARRANGING TRANSPORT, AND FOR HANDLING OF ANY FINANCIAL NEGOTIATIONS WITH RESPECT TO SEA PASSAGE FROM SWEDEN TO GERMANY. NO FINANCIAL COMMITMENTS MADE HERE.

1. Stockholm reports following cable sent by you to Hungarian Government about April 10: "UNRRA to Prime Minister Ferenc Nagy: UNRRA shall do everything in its power for home transportation of nearly 1700 Hungarian DP's from Sweden and is ready to pay expenses for same."
2. No new of this cable in ERO. Kindly confirm.
3. ERO is currently endeavouring to secure transport via Germany. Swedish Government would pay to Lubeck thence Military Authorities. Your reference UNRRA readiness to pay therefore not understood. Please clarify.
