1. PLEASE FIND ATTACHED THE DAILY INFOSUM MENTIONED ABOVE.
2. REGARDS

1. OVERVIEW. THE GENERAL SITUATION REMAINS RELATIVELY CALM. THE RPA CONTINUE TO INTENSIFY THEIR SECURITY MEASURES ALONG THE BORDER. ONE UNAMIR VEHICLE WAS REPORTED STOLEN IN THE GITARAMA AREA.

2. RPA/GENDARMERIE.

A. IN SECTOR 3

(1) IN NTONGWE GR 9057, TWO RPA SOLDIERS EXCHANGED GUNFIRE ALLEGEDLY IN A DISPUTE OVER STOLEN CATTLE. ONE OF THE SOLDIERS WAS KILLED.

(2) AT 0030 HOURS IN GITARAMA GR 7370, A HUMAN RIGHTS VEHICLE (LANDROVER #1927) WAS STOLEN FROM THE RESIDENCE COMPOUND BY RPA SOLDIERS. MALICOY PATROLS WERE UNABLE TO FIND ANY TRACE OF THE VEHICLE.

B. IN SECTOR 4A: HUNDREDS OF RPA SOLDIERS WERE SEEN ALONG THE ROUTE FROM KITABI GR 3520 AND CYANGUGU GR 7824. COMMENT: THE RPA HAS INTENSIFIED PATROLS ON THE KITABI-CYANGUGU HIGHWAY AS IT IS SUSPECTED THAT THE FRGF USE THE ROAD AS AN INFILTRATION ROUTE.

C. IN SECTOR 4C: RPA REINFORCEMENTS HAVE BEEN REPORTED THROUGHOUT THE SECTOR MOST PROBABLY DUE TO THE PRESIDENTIAL VISIT TO CYANGUGU ON 12 JUN 95. AS WELL MACHINE GUNS HAVE BEEN POSITIONED IN THE PINDURA AREA GR 1426 AND MANY SOLDIERS WERE DEPLOYED IN THE NYUNGWE FOREST.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. NSTR.

4. REFUGEES/IDPS. UNHCR ORGANIZED THE RETURN OF RWANDAN REFUGEES FROM BURUNDI THROUGH THE RUTETE BORDER CROSSING IN SECTOR 2. THE REFUGEES WERE HOUSED IN THE GASHORA TRANSIT CAMP. REPORTS INDICATE THAT THE MOVE WAS WELL ORGANIZED.

5. POLITICAL. NSTR.

6. REGIONAL. _

7. MISC. A HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM VISITED GITARAMA PRISON AND REPORTED THAT THERE WERE 6840 INMATES AND THAT A AVERAGE OF 28 PEOPLE DIE EACH WEEK. A NUMBER OF THE PRISONERS ARE SUFFERING FROM INFECTIONS TO THEIR FEET OR EARS WHICH HAS RESULTED IN AMPUTATIONS IN SOME CASES. THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES SEEM INDIFFERENT TO THE SITUATION.

8. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

A. SECTOR 1.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) NIBATT PTL TO MUHURA COMMUNE MET THE BOURGEMESTRE WHO COMPLAINED OF LACK OF OFFICE EQPT, TRANSPORT AND WATER FACILITIES IN THE AREA. HAC INFORMED.

(3) NIBATT MED STAFF TREATED 14 LOCALS IN AOR.

SECTOR 2.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) GHANBATT REPORTED THAT AT KAYONZA GR 5789 A FEMALE LURED SIX KIDS INTO A ROOM AND LOCKED THEM UP. SHE THEN BEAT THEM WITH OBJECTS INCLUDING A KNIFE AND A STICK WHICH RESULTED IN THE DEATH OF ONE WHILE FOUR OTHERS WERE LEFT WITH MULTIPLE INJURIES. ONE CHILD MANAGED TO ESCAPED UNHURT. GHANBATT ARRESTED THE ASSAILANT WHO IS BELIEVED TO BE MENTALLY ILL AND HANDED HER OVER TO RPA.

(3) GHANBATT REPORTED THAT UNHCR REP AND ONE MILOB TEAM VISITED BARE DPs CAMP TO CONFIRM PREPARATION FOR RECEPTION OF DPs FROM BURUNDI.

(4) GHANBATT MED STAFF TREATED 25 LOCALS IN AOR.

(5) UNICEF DISTRIBUTED 30 TONS OF FLOUR IN GASHORA COMMUNE. LWF DISTRIBUTED FOOD ITEMS TO 7,000 PEOPLE AT RWINKWAVU SECTEUR. UNHCR SUPPLIED WATER TO ISAR KARAMA TRANSIT CAMP (2349). IRC BUILT TWO PLASTIC SHELTERS AT GASHORA TRANSIT CAMP TO ACCOMMODATE OVER 500 RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI AND OXFAM PROVIDED FOUR HAND-PUMP EQUIPMENT FOR WATER TO REHABILITATE BROKEN DOWN PUMPS AT RWINKWAVU.

C. SECTOR 3 (KIBUYE AND GITARAMA)

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) MALAWICOY PTL TO NYAKAHINGA GR 3468 REPORTED THAT LOCALS IN THE AREA LIVE IN FEAR DUE TO INCESSANT ARRESTS BY RPA.

(3) MALAWICOY MED STAFF TREATED 13 LOCALS IN AOR.

(4) MILOBS REPORTED THE PREFECT OF GITARAMA VISITED THE SECTOR COMMANDER TO DISCUSS THE ISSUE OF STOLEN VEHICLES. HE PROMISED TO TRANSMIT TO HIS SUPERIORS A SUGGESTED SOLUTION TO THIS PROBLEM.

(5) A JOINT MILOB/HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM WENT TO BULINGA COMMUNE (6679). THE BOURGEMESTRE MET THE TEAM AND REQUESTED AID IN THE FIELDS OF HEALTH, HOUSING, WATER AND EDUCATION. SOME INMATES OF THE COMMUNE PRISON COMPLAINED TO THE HR MONITORS THAT THEY HAVE NOT BEEN INTERVIEWED BY THE PROSECUTOR AND THAT THEY WERE ALWAYS BEATEN BY THE SOLDIERS DURING INTERROGATION.

HR PROMISED TO TAKE THE MATTER UP.

(6) MILOBS REPORTED THAT HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM VISITED GITARAMA PRISON AND REPORTED THAT THERE WERE 6,840 INMATES. TWENTY-TWO WERE HOSPITALIZED AT THE MSF HOSPITAL AT KABGAYI. THE MORTALITY RATE IS HIGH AND STANDS AT APPROXIMATELY 28 PER WEEK. THERE IS A FOOT INFECTION WHICH CAUSED MANY INMATES TO HAVE THEIR LEGS AMPUTATED AND ALSO AN EAR INFECTION WHICH CAUSED MANY INMATES TO LOSE THEIR HEARING. THERE HAS BEEN NO RELEASES OF LATE AND THE AUTHORITIES ARE IGNORING THE PLIGHT OF THE INMATES. THE EXTENSION WORK IN THE PRISON IS AT AN ADVANCED STAGE.

(7) REF YESTERDAY'S SITREP, MILOB INVESTIGATIONS REVEALED THAT THE 5 PEOPLE REPORTED KILLED IN MAHAMBE SECTEUR (1854) WERE A HUTU RETURNEE FAMILY. THEY WERE KILLED BY TUTSI RETURNEES AND NOT RPA OR CROSS-BORDER RAIDERS AS REPORTED. ALSO THE TEACHER AND HIS SEVEN PUPILS WERE NOT FOUND AT THE GITARAMA PRISON WHEN HUMAN RIGHTS INVESTIGATED. EFFORTS TO LOCATE THEM CONTINUE.

D. SECTOR 4A.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) ZAMBATT REPORTED THAT ICRC HELD A COORDINATING MEETING AT RWAMIKO WITH THE BOURGEMESTER. DISCUSSION CENTRED ON POSSIBLE HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE TO LOCALS.

(3) ZAMBATT MED STAFF TREATED 295 LOCALS IN AOR.

(4) MILOBS PATROL TO AKABUGA (4988) AND REMERA (4289) INDICATED THAT LOCALS CLAIMED THAT RPA INTENDS TO ARREST ALL MALES AGED BETWEEN 18 AND 40. SOME MALES ARE REPORTEDLY FLEEING TO BURUNDI AND ZAIRE. OTHERWISE SITUATION WAS REPORTED CALM.

(5) ANOTHER MILOBS PATROL TO MUSEBEYA (4038) AND MUKO (3742) COMMUNES. THEY WERE INFORMED BY LOCALS THAT THEIR RELATIONS WITH THE RPA HAD IMPROVED.

E. SECTOR 4B.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR. NSTR.

(2) SENBATT TRANSPORTED BLANKETS AND FOOD ITEMS FROM BUTARE TO MUGANZA GR 8507 FOR PRISONERS.

(3) SENBATT MED STAFF TREATED 163 LOCALS IN AOR.

(4) MILOBS REPORTED THAT THERE IS AN INFLUX OF RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI THROUGH KANYARU-BAS BORDER POST REPORTEDLY DUE TO UNSTABLE SITUATION IN THE NGOZI PROVINCE OF BURUNDI.

(5) MILOBS REPORTED THAT ABOUT 85 IDPS WERE STILL AT THE BUTARE WAY STATION AWAITING TRANSPORTATION TO THEIR HOME COMMUNES.

(6) SECTOR MILOBS CONVEYED USED CLOTHES, BLANKETS, SOAP, COOKING UTENSILS, JERRY CANS, MATRESSES AND BISCUITS DONATED BY ICRC TO NYAZA AND SAINT ANTOINE ORPHANAGES.

F. SECTOR 4C.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SECURITY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) ETHIOBATT MED STAFF TREATED 17 LOCAL DENTAL PATIENTS IN AOR.

(3) MILOBS CONDUCTED PTLs IN AOR. REPORTED THE SITUATION IN THE SECTOR REMAINED CALM. LOCALS IN NYAMASHEKE SUB-SECTOR ARE GETTING MORE TENSE DUE TO THE BEGINNING OF THE WITHDRAWAL OF NON-ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS OF NGOS IN THAT AREA.

G. SECTOR 5.

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) TUNBATT REPORTED THAT A BROWN AND ROOT LOCAL WORKER WAS REPORTED MISSING ON 10 JUN 95. EARLIER ON RPA SOLDIERS WERE SAID TO HAVE CONFISCATED ALL HIS PROPERTY. INVESTIGATION IN PROGRESS. MILOB AND HR INFORMED.

(3) TUNBATT PTL TO BUSOGO GR 4828 REPORTED THAT THE LOCAL AUTH ARRESTED ONE LOCAL FOR UNKNOWN REASONS.

(4) TUNBATT PROVIDED TWO VEHs TO TRANSPORT MATERIALS FROM RUHengeri TO OTHER PARTS OF THE SECTOR.

(5) RPA BN COMD AND AN RPA OPS OFFR FROM KIGALI VISITED BN HQ. THE TEAM WANTED TO KNOW WHEN TUNBATT WOULD BE LEAVING THE COUNTRY. NO POSITIVE ANSWER WAS GIVEN. THEY WERE REFERRED TO UNAMIR HQ.

(6) TUNBATT MED STAFF TREATED 111 LOCALS IN AOR.

(7) MILOBS CARRIED OUT A HELI PATROL TO KIBILIRA (5685) AND A HELI RECCE OF THE GISHWATE FOREST. AT KIBILIRA, THE SECRETARY TO THE BOURGMESTRE INFORMED MILOBS OF TWO ROBBERY/MURDER CASES THAT HAPPENED ON 24 MAY AND 04 JUN 95. SIX PERSONS WERE KILLED IN BOTH CASES. THE SECRETARY COMPLAINED THAT THE AREA DID NOT RECEIVE FOOD AID SINCE MARCH AND THE LOCAL CLINIC LACKED DRUGS AND QUALIFIED PERSONNEL.

(8) MILOBS REPORTED THAT THE RECCE OF GISHWATE FOREST

INVESTIGATED RUMOUR THAT THERE WAS A SIGNIFICANT MOV OF IDPS INTO THAT AREA. NO NEW SETTLEMENTS OR INDICATION OF SUCH MOVEMENT WAS FOUND.

(9) MILOBS REPORTED THAT THE COLLEGE RELOCATION CENTRE IN THE SECTOR WOULD BE EMPTIED COMMENCING 16 JUN 95. THERE ARE OVER 3,000 RETURNEES IN THE CENTER NOW.

H. SECTOR 6

(1) CONDUCTED PTLs AND SECURITY DUTIES IN AOR.

(2) INDBATT REPORTED THAT 134 IDPS WERE EVAC BY UNHCR TO THEIR RESPECTIVE HOMES. 124 IDPS STILL AWAITING EVAC FROM NDERA CAMP.

(3) INDBATT ESCORTED BROWN AND ROOT WATER TANKER FOR NIGHT SHIFT DUTIES.

(4) TWO RPA DENTAL OFFICERS VISITED INDBATT DENTAL CLINIC TO STUDY THE EQUIPMENT HELD IN LOC FOR PROCUREMENT OF SIMILAR EQUIPMENT FROM INDIA.

(5) INDBATT DEPLOYED RRF IN RESPONSE TO CALL FROM UNHCR WHERE THEY REPORTED THAT THEY HAD HEARD CRIES OF SOME CHILDREN IN A BUILDING 50 METRES FROM UNHCR BUILDING. RRF FOUND THt THERE WAS NOTHING SERIOUS AND THEY REPORTED BACK TO BASE.

(6) INDBATT MED STAFF TREATED 30 UNAMIR CIVILIAN STAFF IN AOR.

(7) MILOB PATROLS TRIED TO GET DETAILS OF THE ON-GOING BANDITRY REPORTED IN KANOMBE COMMUNE BUT COULD NOT OBTAIN ANY CONCRETE EVIDENCE. IT WAS ALLEGED THAT ARMED AND UNARMED ELEMENTS WITH IMITATIONS WEAPONS, HARASS LOCALS AT NIGHT. PATROLS ALSO SHOWED THE AUSTRALIAN MINE-CLEARING TEAM ONE HAND GRENADE AND ONE MORTAR GRENADE AT GR 113826 IN KICUKIRO.

(8) SECTOR MILOBS REPORTED THAT UNICEF DONATED A 1,500 LTR WATER BLADDER TO KICUKIRO PRIMARY SCHOOL. IT WOULD BE INSTALLED TODAY AND FILLED EACH OTHER DAY BY A WATER TANKER FROM TRAFIPRO.

I. FORCE ENGR COY.

(1) CONTINUED TO PROVIDE ENGR SP TO UNAMIR.

(2) CONTINUED DOZER WORK FOR IMPROVEMENT OF ROAD IN BUTARE.

(3) COMPLETED SHIFTING OF REFUGE FROM KIBUNGO ROADSIDE DUMP TO NYANZA CITY DUMP.

(4) CONTINUED ERECTION OF SECURITY FENCING FOR EXTENSION OF TRANSIT CAMP.

(5) EOD TEAM RECOVERED ONE RIFLE GREN FROM KACYIRU ORPHANAGE.

(6) DEPLOYED WHEEL DOZER FOR DIGGING OF DTLS IN KAWASUZU PRIMARY SCHOOL IN NYABIRANGO.

J. AUSMED.

(1) PROVIDED MEDICAL SPT TO UNAMIR AND HUMANITARIAN MED SPT TO THE PEOPLE OF RWANDA.

(2) TREATED A TOTAL OF 100 MEDICAL PATIENTS DURING THE PERIOD. CHK IS CURRENTLY HOLDING 12 IN-PATIENTS.

(3) RIFLE COY ELM PROVIDED SECURITY AT THE MIL BKS AND CHK.

(4) ROTATION OF MED SPECIALISTS CONCLUDED WITH THE DEPARTURE OF THE FIVE OUTGOING SPECIALISTS.

K. AIR OPS. NORMAL UNAMIR AND COMMERCIAL FLIGHTS WERE IN OPERATION AT THE KIA DURING THE PERIOD. A TOTAL OF 16 FLIGHTS DEPARTED AND ARRIVED KIA.

L. UN MP COY. THERE WERE TWO ACCIDENT INVOLVING UNAMIR 600 TOYOTA LAND CRUISER AND UNAMIR 4031 CHEVROLET. ALSO TWO THEFT CASES WERE REPORTED DURING THE PERIOD. A CASE OF ATTEMPTED THEFT WAS ALSO REPORTED IN BUTARE. MPs RESPONDED AND THE THIEVES RAN AWAY.

1. PLEASE FIND ATTACHED THE DAILY INFOSUM MENTIONED ABOVE.
2. REGARDS

1. OVERVIEW. THE SITUATION REMAINS RELATIVELY CALM ALTHOUGH THERE ARE REPORTS OF INCIDENTS IN SECTORS 3 AND 4C. RPA CONTINUING TO INTENSIFY THEIR SECURITY MEASURES.

2. RPA/GENDARMERIE.

A. IN SECTOR 3A

(1) ON 24 MAY, RPA SOLDIERS HARASSED AND BEAT SOME LOCALS FROM MUGOZI COMMUNE GR 1858 AND EXTORTED MONEY AND PROPERTY FROM THEM.

(2) ON THE SAME DATE, AT MAHEMBE GR 1854, RPA KILLED FIVE PEOPLE FOR REASONS UNKNOWN.

B. IN SECTOR 3B: ON 11 JUN AT 1630 HOURS, ARMED PERSONS SUSPECTED TO BE RPA SOLDIERS STOLE A UNAMIR VEHICLE FROM MALICOY ON THE ROAD BETWEEN GITARAMA AND NTONGWE GR 9057.

C. IN SECTOR 4B: TWO TRUCK LOADS OF PROVISIONS ACCOMPANIED BY SEVERAL RPA SOLDIERS WERE OBSERVED AT BUTARE HEADING IN THE DIRECTION OF 4C.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. IN SECTOR 4C, ON THE NIGHT OF 11 JUNE, A GROUP OF SEVEN ARMED MEN IN CIVILIAN DRESS CAME FROM ZAIRE AND ATTACKED LOCALS IN THE KIRANGA AREA GR 8008. THE GROUP STOLE 67,000 RF FROM ONE LOCAL AND A COW FROM ANOTHER. BOTH LOCALS WERE SHOT AND ONE WAS SEVERELY INJURED. THE BANDITS RETURNED TO ZAIRE AND WERE IDENTIFIED BY LOCALS AS FORMER VILLAGERS OF THE KIRANGA AREA.

4. REFUGEES/IDPS. NSTR.

5. POLITICAL. NSTR.

6. REGIONAL.

A. RADIO RWANDA REPORTED THAT ON 9 JUNE IN A JOINT COMMUNIQUE, THE DEFENCE MINISTERS OF RWANDA, BURUNDI AND ZAIRE AGREED TO SET UP JOINT PATROLS TO CONTROL THEIR COMMON BORDERS AND TO TAKE OTHER MEASURES TO ELIMINATE ARMED GROUPS AS WELL AS PREVENTING THE PROLIFERATION OF ARMS IN THE REGION.

B. IN A PRESS CONFERENCE GIVEN IN BURUNDI, MAJ GEN KAGAME REJECTED THE CREATION OF SEPARATE HUTU LAND AND TUTSI LAND TO RESOLVE THE ETHNIC PROBLEMS IN RWANDA AND BURUNDI. HE EXPLAINED THAT IT WAS NOT EVIDENT TUTSIS FROM BURUNDI WOULD BE ABLE TO CO-EXIST PEACEFULLY WITH TUTSIS FROM RWANDA.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY. IN SECTOR 4C THE FOLLOWING INCIDENTS WERE REPORTED

A. AT KIRAMBO, REF THE INCIDENT OF BANDIT REPRISALS 08 JUN. THE HUSBAND OF THE WOMAN MACHETED TO DEATH DIED YESTERDAY (09 JUN) OF HIS WOUNDS. HE WAS ABLE TO IDENTIFY SIX OF THE PEOPLE WHO ATTACKED HIM. THEY HAVE BEEN ARRESTED AND SENT TO GATARE PRISON.

B. AT MURURU (7521) ON 05 2100B JUN, A LOCAL CLOTHES MERCHANT WAS KILLED BY 4 MEN IN UNIFORM. THESE MEN HAD BEEN INVITED FOR DINNER, AFTER WHICH THEY DEMANDED MONEY FRANCS FROM THE MAN. ALTHOUGH THE BANDITS WERE GIVEN 37,000 FRANCS, THEY DEMANDED MORE. THE VICTIM COULD NOT PROVIDE, SO THE BANDITS SHOT AND KILLED HIM AND HIS 18 YEAR OLD DAUGHTER, SHOT AND WOUNDED HIS WIFE AND FOUR OTHER CHILDREN. IT IS ALLEGED THAT THESE BANDITS HAD BEEN INVITED FOR DINNER A NUMBER OF TIMES. COMMENT: WITH NEW RPA TROOPS IN LOCATION, THE INCIDENT SUGGESTS LOCAL RPA SHAKEDOWN/PROTECTION HOWEVER CONDITIONS ALSO EXIST TO INDICATE THAT THIS MIGHT BE A FORM OF GUERRILLA TAXATION.

C. IN BUREMERA (7622) ON 07 JUN, LOCALS REPORT THAT ARMED MEN STABBED A BUSINESSMAN AND HIS PREGNANT WIFE TO DEATH FOR FAILING TO PAY AN UNIDENTIFIED AMOUNT OF MONEY TO THE BANDITS. THEY ARE PRESENTLY IN PRISON. COMMENT: EXTORTION IS NOT UNCOMMON, THIS TEAM MAY, HOWEVER, HAVE SHAKEN DOWN THE WRONG PERSON/PEOPLE.

WEEKLY HUMANITARIAN REPORT FOR THE PERIOD 28 MAY - 03 JUN 95

GENERAL SITUATION

1. The Humanitarian situation within Rwanda continues to improve. There are still movements of IDPs returning to their Communes.

HAC ACTIVITIES

2. HAC is now located in UNAMIR HQ room 2004 and can be reached on phone number 11250.

3. Sector 1

a. Gen Situation

The general situation in this sector remained calm during the period.

b. Food

Food shortage is reported in Kabacuzi and Bizhonde sectors.

c. Water

Ngarama and Byumba face acute water shortage.

4. Sector 2

a. Gen Situation

The humanitarian situation for the period under review is considered generally calm. The various UN Agencies, ICRC and NGOs continued to provide humanitarian assistance to the communities in the sector.

b. Own Hac Activities

(1) Milobs visited commune bureaux in the sector to establish rapport with Bourgemestres and various resettlement/transit.

(2) HAC team visited UN Agencies, ICRC and NGOs in Kibungo Prefecture to co-ordinate humanitarian activities.

c. Orphanages

Report received from RUKARA Commune indicated the harassment of some orphans by two RPA soldiers. Human Rights and Milobs are said to be investigating the report.

d. Water

(1) Good and portable water is said to be the major problem facing some hospitals in the sector. Musenyi in Kanazi Sous Prefecture and Rwinkwavu in Rwamagana Sous Prefecture face acute water shortage.

(2) Nyakirambi Transit Camp in Kirehe Sous Prefecture is accommodating more than 500 returnees is facing acute water shortage.

e. Health

(1) The GHANBATT RAP at Kibungo provided medical and dental assistance to some locals during the period under review.

(2) Rwinkwavu hospital management requires 79 beds to augment their current holding.

Sector 3

a. Sit Gen

The situation remained calm. However, due to move of Malawi Coy and Sub Sector 3 A MILOBS to their new location, humanitarian activities in Kibuye were restricted.

b. Health

(1) Malawi Coy provided medical assistance to 227 locals during the week under review.

(2) Chronic skin problems is reported in orphanages in the sector.

c. Orphanages

Milobs patrol to Nyanza Orphanage indicated that the Orphanage needs furniture, food and medical assistance.

d. Food

The food situation in east and west Gitarama Communes is poor, primarily because of the number of people to be fed by the few number of working people.

e. Housing

Housing facilities are required for IDPs in the sector.

f. Special Needs

(1) Nyanza Orphanage in dire need of adoptions by suitable NGOs.

(2) Food supplement is required for prisoners in commune cachots.

(3) All health centers require additional medicines. Mobile clinics for hinterland areas are required. The dispensaries in Rutsiro 3909 and Muhira 3886 have inadequate food stock for the number of patients being treated.

6. Sector 4

a. General Situation

The situation was reported to be calm during the period. The Sector Hum Offr attended meeting with Human Rights and Security meeting with NGOs.

b. Medical

Medical cover needed in almost all the communes.

c. Housing

Building materials required in most communes.

d. Agriculture

Farming implements needed in most communes

e. Water

Portable water required in communes.

7. Sector 5

a. General Situation

The general situation in sector remains calm. However, sporadic incidents of sabotage, in form of explosives planted to destroy vital transformers in Ruhengeri have occurred. Stray incidents of killing by the interhamwe have also been reported.

b. Own HAC Activities

(1) The Ministry of Family and Promotion of Women received substantial assistance from the MILOBS in transporting aid materials to the widows and destitute in the communes.

(2) MILOBS also assisted MSF in reaching their remote posts (Jomba 5609) made inaccessible by rains by providing helipatrol, similarly they provided heliflight to UNHCR to monitor the food and returnees situation in communes.

c. Orphanages

The Orphanage at Mugongo faces acute water problem. The ICRC is said to be carrying out water rehabilitation in the area.

d. Hospitals

The NGO-MSF has expressed dissatisfaction over the quality of local staff manning the health posts. There seemed to be lack of motivation in the people manning these posts.

8. Sector 6

a. Gen Sit

The situation in Kigali Sector is calm with isolated areas requiring attention though these are minor in nature.

b. Own HAC Activities

(1) HAC team went to Nyakabanda Sector to verify the fact that some houses were being occupied by orphans without being looked after by relatives or NGOs. Out of the seven houses visited two had orphans who were not being looked after by relatives or NGOs.

(2) The team also visited Kicukuo commune to familiarize itself with humanitarian activities in the commune. The inhabitants requested for quantity eight hundred (800) hoes for their farming activities.


c. Water

Portable water is needed in the sector as most communes drink water from dug out wells

d. Housing

(1) Housing facilities are needed to house 290 widows and 105 returnees in Kimisagara sector.

(2) There is also no shelter for IDPs in the sector.

1. SITUATION

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

b. BORDERS

(1) GATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) RUSIZI BORDER POST IN SECT 4C WAS OPEN TO TRAFFIC.

(4) GISENYI BORDER POSTS WERE CLOSED TO UNAMIR PERS.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL. GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND LOCAL AUTHORITIES ARE REPORTED HOLDING MEETINGS IN SEVERAL PARTS OF THE COUNTRY IN AN ATTEMPT TO DISPEL RUMOURS AND ALSO TO PLAN ACTIVITIES FOR THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE WAR.

b. MILITARY

(1) RPA.

(a) RPA TROOPS AT THEIR ROAD BLOCK AT GR 042868 TODAY DETAINED FOR SEARCH, A HUMAN RIGHTS VEHICLE FOR ABOUT TWO AND A HALF HOURS. A MILOB TEAM FROM KIGALI WAS SENT TO THE SCENE BUT COULD NOT CONVINCE THE RPA TO LET THE VEHICLE THROUGH WITHOUT SEARCH. THE SEARCH WAS THOROUGH AND LASTED FOR TWENTY MINUTES. NOTHING WAS FOUND AND NOTHING WAS TAKEN. A SIMILAR INCIDENT HAPPENED AT THE SAME PLACE ON 18 MAR 95.

(b) SECTOR 3 REPORTED THAT THE RPA PROGRAMME TO TRAIN CIVIL SECURITY OFFICERS SEEMED TO BE NEARING COMPLETION IN THE GITARAMA PREFECTURE. IN NTONGWE COMMUNE (GR 9057), 47 TRAINEES GRADUATED TODAY.

(c) IN THE SAME SECTOR, THE INFORMATION CONCERNING SOME RENEGADE RPA SOLDIERS IN A STOLEN VEHICLE THAT WAS HIDDEN AT RUTOBWE ORPHANAGE; IT WAS LEARNT TODAY THAT THE RPA HAD CAPTURED THE VEHICLE IN THE SHOGWE AREA. NO FURTHER DETAILS WERE GIVEN.

(d) SECTOR 4C MILOBS REPORTED THAT THREE RPA OFFICERS; MAJ BUSHANDA (COMDT DEF), LT GAFFIZI (COMMS DEF) AND MACUMU EVARISTE (SECUR OFFR) WENT TO UNHCR TO GATHER INFORMATION ON THEIR RADIO COMMUNICATION TYPES AND FREQUENCIES. THE UNHCR STAFF DECLINED AND TOLD THEM THEY WOULD HAVE TO ASK THEIR HQ IN KIGALI.

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN VARIOUS LOCATIONS IN THE SECTOR INCLUDING THE BORDER POSTS.

(3) PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED TO KISARO (GR 0220), MIYOVE (GR 9721), CYUNGO (GR 9321), GATUNA (GR 0143), KIBALI (GR 0424) AND RUHONDA. SITUATION IN THESE AREAS WAS REPORTED CALM.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS FROM RILIMA (GR 2561) TO GASHORA (GR 2655) AND RUTETE (GR 2242). THE SITUATION IN THE AREA WAS CALM.

(3) PATROLS WERE ALSO CONDUCTED IN SAKE (GR 4354), MUGESERA (GR 4764) AND BIRENGA (GR 5959). AT SAKE, MILOBS WERE INFORMED BY THE BOURGMESTRE THAT THE AUTHORITIES WERE PLANNING REBURIAL OF SKELETONS FROM THE MASS GRAVE AT RUKUMBELI (GR 0061) ON 07 APR 95.

(4) MILOBS ALSO PATROLLED KIBUNGO AND SURROUNDING AREAS, RUKARA (GR 5601), MUHAZI (GR 4590), RUTUNDE (GR 4884) AND KAYONZA (GR 5784). SITUATION IN THESE AREAS WAS CALM. PATROLS OBSERVED THAT BOURGMESTRES OF THESE COMMUNES WERE HOLDING A MEETING. THE BOURGMESTRE OF RUTUNDE INFORMED MILOBS THAT PEACEFUL DEMONSTRATIONS WERE BEING PLANNED FOR THE 6 AND 7 OF APRIL AT RWAMAGANA.

THE PATROL ALSO LEARNED OF 11 ARRESTS OVER THE LAST TWO WEEKS. THE PRISONERS ARE ALLEGEDLY KEPT IN A PIT AT THE RPA CAMP AT SURI. MILOBS TO INVESTIGATE FURTHER.

(4) TEAMS FROM UNAMIR ENGINEER COY AND HUMAN RIGHTS TODAY VISITED THE KIBUYE PRISON TO DISCUSS RENOVATIONS TO EASE OVERCROWDING.



A. SECTOR 4C.

(1) NYAMASHEKE (984416): 02 JUN: A LARGE GROUP OF BANDITS CROSSED FROM ZAIRE IN ONE LARGE BOAT, WHICH THEY HID BY SINKING (A TECHNIQUE COMMONLY USED TO HIDE THE BOATS WITHOUT MAKING THEM UNSERVICABLE). THEY THEN SPLIT INTO TWO GROUPS, ONE TOWARDS KIRAMBO (0444) AND ONE TOWARDS BUSHENKERI (9832). NO ACTS OF BANDITRY WERE REPORTED AND IT IS BELIEVED THEY HID IN THESE LOCATIONS FOR THE NIGHT.

(2) BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 03 1115-1140B JUN, CONTINUOUS MORTAR FIRING WAS OBSERVED COMING FROM IJWI ISLAND, FALL OF SHOT AND TARGET COULD NOT BE IDENTIFIED. SUSPECTED PRACTICE, AS MORTAR WAS FIRING IN SAME PLACE AS SEVERAL SMALL ARMS PRACTICES IN THE PAST FEW WEEKS.

(3) NYAMASHEKE (984416): 03 JUN: ANOTHER GROUP OF BANDITS CAME ACROSS IN A SIMILAR BOAT AND HID IT AT THE SAME LOCATION. THIS GROUP ALSO WENT TOWARDS BUSHENKERI BUT WAS CAUGHT IN AN RPA AMBUSH. TWO BANDITS WERE KILLED, ONE WOUNDED AND CAPTURED. A SUBMACHINE GUN AND A LIGHT MACHINE GUN WERE RECOVERED, BOTH WERE OLD MODELS.

(4) MURAZA (0745): 03 2300B A LARGE GROUP OF ARMED BANDITS ROBBED MANY HOUSES OF HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND LIVESTOCK, MACHETEING ONE MAN AND WOUNDING HIS SON. SEVERAL CATTLE WERE TAKEN BACK TO IJWI ISLAND IN A NUMBER OF BOATS. IT IS UNKNOWN IF THIS IS THE SAME GROUP WHICH HAD LANDED THE NIGHT BEFORE.

(5) ISEARA (0145)/NGOMA (9637) AREA: RPA CAPTURED A BOAT AND 8 ARMED BANDITS FROM ZAIRE. (NFI)

B. SECTOR 5. RUHENGARI: FURTHER TO SATURDAY'S (03 JUN) REPORT OF SECURITY MEETING HELD 02 JUN: 5,000 PERS WERE IN ATTENDANCE. AUTHORITIES INDICATED THAT LOCALS WERE HARBOURING SUBVERSIVE ELMS. THEIR PLANNED SOLUTION IS TO ORGANIZE COMMUNITIES INTO "NYUMBA KHUMI" (10 HOUSE SECTORS WHO ARE RESPONSIBLE TO PATROL THEIR AREAS BY NIGHT). MILITARY WILL PATROL STRATEGIC POINTS. ALSO AUTHORITIES

URGED THOSE RESPONSIBLE FOR ARRESTS TO CONDUCT MORE THOROUGH INVESTIGATIONS BEFORE LAYING CHARGES.

4. REFUGEES/IDPS. SECTOR 4A: ZAMBATT REPORTS A "REMARKABLE" EXODUS OF CIVILIANS FLEEING TO ZAIRE FROM RUKONDO AND DUSENYI AFTER HEARING MEDIA REPORTS OF AN IMMINENT FRGF ATTACK.

6. REGIONAL.

A. BURUNDI: BUJUMBURA: SHOOTING AGAIN LAST NIGHT IN THE HUTU GANG STRONGHOLDS OF KAMENGE AND KIMANA. THE MILITARY HAS CORDONNED THE AREAS SUPPORTED BY TANKS AND APCs. THAT'S AS MUCH DETAIL AS CAN BE GOTTEN AS SOURCES CAN'T GET THROUGH THE CORDON. THE REMAINDER OF THE CITY, HOWEVER, APPEARS CALM, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF SOME SHOOTING HEARD IN THE TUTSI DISTRICTS OF CIBITOKÉ AND BWIZA. THE GOVERNMENT HAS MAINTAINED A NEWS BLACKOUT, BUT A MILITARY SPOKESMAN STATED THAT THE ARMY WAS IN CONTROL. AN OAU BID TO BROKER A CEASEFIRE BY THE OAU SECRETARY HIMSELF (SALIM AHMED SALIM) FAILED WHEN THE ARMY COULD NOT GUARANTEE THE SAFETY OF THEIR REPRESENTATIVE. THERE ARE 47 OAU MILITARY OBSERVERS WITH 20 MORE TO COME IN THE NEXT TWO WEEKS.

B. ZAIRE: THE US OFFICIALS HAVE BEEN IN DISCUSSIONS WITH ZAIRAN AUTHORITIES FOR THE STATIONING OF MILITARY OBSERVERS IN THE FOUR EASTERN ZAIRAN AIRPORTS. THIS IS IN THE WAKE OF COMMON PRESS STATEMENTS OF THE REARMING OF THE FRGF AND MILITIA. COMMENT: THIS WOULD SERVE TO CLOSE THE STABLE DOOR AFTER MANY OF THE HORSES HAVE ALREADY BOLTED.

AMBUSH BY RPA AT BUSHENKERI. TWO BANDITS WERE KILLED AND TWO AUTOMATIC WEAPONS WERE CAPTURED WITH ONE WOUNDED BANDIT. IN THE MEANTIME, IN MURAZA SQ 0745, AT ABOUT 032300HRS A BIG GROUP OF BANDITS DRESSED IN UNIFORM ROBBED MANY HOUSES. THEY ALSO MACHETTED A MAN TO DEATH AND WOUNDED HIS 13-YEAR-OLD SON. SEVERAL CATTLE WERE TAKEN TO IJWI IN MANY BOATS. THE LOCAL RPA 2IC AND HIS OFFERS VISITED NYAMASHEKE SUB-SECTOR IN ORDER TO ASSESS THE DEPLOYMENT AND THE STRENGTH OF THEIR TROOPS AS WELL AS THE ABOVE-MENTIONED INCIDENT.

1. OVERVIEW. RPA CONTINUES SECURITY MEASURES AS CONTINGENCY AGAINST AN FRGF ATTACK.

(1) IN GITARAMA, REGARDING THE THEFT OF A UNAMIR VEHICLE ON 13 MAY 95 THE CONCERN AND COOPERATION BY RPA LEADERSHIP ON WERE ACTUALLY DECEPTION AND COMPLICITY. ON 2 JUN 95, SECTOR 3 MILOBS OBSERVED THE STOLEN VEHICLE IN FRESHLY PAINTED RPA COLOURS BEARING A REGISTRATION NUMBER "APR 011 J". IN TRACKING THE VEHICLE, MILOBS AND CIVPOL USED RADIO TRANSMISSIONS IN ENGLISH. RESULTING IN THE VEHICLE BEING REPLACED IN ITS ESCORT DUTIES. MILOBS WERE UNABLE TO FOLLOW THE VEH DUE TO HEAVY TRAFFIC, BUT BELIEVED THE VEHICLE WAS HEADED FOR KIGALI. UNAMIR HQ RPA LO WAS INFORMED.

(2) HOTEL MERIDIAN: AT 011830B JUN 95, 3 ARMED PERS IN UNIFORM, REPORTEDLY RPA, AND TWO IN CIVILIAN CLOTHING, HIJACKED A UNDP VEHICLE AT GUNPOINT.

UNAMIR AND RPA ARE NO FURTHER IN RESOLVING PASSENGER MANIFESTING AND BOARDING POINT DIFFERENCES. NO RESOLUTION IS EXPECTED IN THE UNTIL LATE NEXT WEEK.

2. REGARDS

1. OVERVIEW. RPA IN SECTOR 5 HAVE CLARIFIED THEIR POSITION ON UN HELICOPTER FLIGHTS. NEW THREAT TO UNAMIR FROM DISCHARGED LOCAL EMPLOYEES. A WFP TRUCK MAY HAVE BEEN DESTROYED BY HOSTILE ACTION ON THE UGANDA/ZAIRE SUPPLY ROUTE.

2. RPA.

A. IN SECTOR 3, ON 31 MAY 95, 2KM WEST OF GITARAMA ON THE GITARAMA-MUSHUBATI ROAD THREE RPA SOLDIERS, OPERATING AN UNAUTHORIZED ROADBLOCK ATTEMPTED TO STEAL A HUMAN RIGHTS VEHICLE, BUT FAILED BECAUSE THE DRIVER OF THE VEH SPED AWAY. NIGHT ROADBLOCKS HAVE BEEN REESTABLISHED.

B. IN SECTOR 5, AN RPA BDE COMD HAS CLARIFIED HIS POSITION ON UNAMIR AIR TFC. FLIGHTS AND PATROLS ARE PERMITTED ONCE THE RPA LO AT GISENYI IS INFORMED OF THE ROUTES AND PLANS. COMMENT: THIS REFLECTS NO CHANGE IN THE WAY SECTOR 5 HAD BEEN CONDUCTING BUSINESS, ALTHOUGH IT DOES NOT APPEAR TO REFLECT OFFICIAL UNAMIR POLICY.

3. FRGF/MILITIA/BANDITRY.

4. REFUGEES/IDPS.

5. POLITICAL. NEW THREAT TO UNAMIR IS SURFACING WITH THE SUDDEN AND APPARENTLY UNEVEN DISMISSAL OF A SUBSTANTIAL NUMBER OF RWANDAN EMPLOYEES. THESE WORKERS HAVE KNOWLEDGE OF LOCS AND SECURITY MEASURES AROUND VALUABLE ITEMS AND, FEELING HAVING BEEN UNJUSTLY TREATED, MAY PILFER, STEAL OR EVEN SABOTAGE UN AND PERSONAL ITEMS.

6. REGIONAL. IN UGANDA/ZAIRE THERE HAVE BEEN INITIAL REPORTS TO SUGGEST THAT AT 300730R MAY, POSSIBLY NEAR BUNAGANA, ON THE UGANDA-ZAIRE SUPPLY ROUTE, A WFP VEHICLE WAS DESTROYED BY A MINE. REPORTEDLY, THIS WFP VEHICLE WAS CARRYING SUPPLIES AND PERSONNEL BOUND FOR ZAIRE. INITIAL REPORTS PLACE CASUALTY FIGURES AT 21. THE CRATER IS REPORTED TO BE ONE METER DEEP BY TWO METERS RADIUS. COMMENT: IT IS STILL TO BE DETERMINED THE LOCATION, TYPE OF MUNITION AND OTHER COLLATERAL. THE DEMOLITION SIGNATURE SUGGESTS AN ANTI-TANK MINE OR A PREPARED DEMOLITION. MORE INFORMATION IS NEEDED TO DETERMINE WHO PREPARED THIS ORDNANCE, HOWEVER TWO MAIN SUSPECTS, IN DESCENDING ORDER OF PROBABILITY ARE: "ANTI-FRGF" ELEMENTS WITH THE AIM OF INDICTING SUPPLIES TO THE REFUGEE CAMPS OR FRGF/INTERAHAMWE ATTEMPTING TO DISCREDIT RPA. IF THE MUNITION IS DETERMINED TO HAVE BEEN COMMAND DETONATED, THIS WILL SPEAK TO THE PERPETRATORS' CAPABILITY AND INTENTION TO TARGET WFP AND SIMILAR AGENCIES.
