

ARRESTS OVER THE PAST THREE MONTHS. THE PEOPLE GAVE SEVERAL COMPLAINTS INCLUDING HARASSMENT, EXTORTION AND AT TIMES ROBBERY BY RPA. THEY INFORMED MILOBS THAT MOST PEOPLE SLEEP IN THE FIELDS AT NIGHT AND ONLY RETURN HOME DURING DAYLIGHT.

(3) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS TO RUNYINYA ORC (GR 6012) AND REPORTED A DECREASE IN THE FLOW OF IDPs MAINLY BECAUSE OF INSECURITY. THE PEOPLE ARE SAID TO BE AFRAID OF ATTACKS FROM THE NEIGHBOURING KIBEHO CAMP. IT WAS REPORTED THAT ON 27 FEB 95, AT APPROXIMATELY 2300 HRS, BANDITS SUSPECTED TO HAVE COME FROM KIBEHO CAMP, ATTACKED AND SERIOUSLY WOUNDED THREE OLD WOMEN, RAPED AN 18 YEAR OLD GIRL AND ESCAPED WITH BLANKETS AND CLOTHING. THE INCIDENT OCCURRED AT KABUREMERA (GR 6111) AND THE VICTIMS ARE NOW RECEIVING MEDICAL TREATMENT. FURTHER INVESTIGATIONS TO CONTINUE.

(4) MILOBS ALSO CONDUCTED PATROLS TO SOME OTHER AREAS IN THEIR AOR. THE SITUATION ELSEWHERE WAS REPORTED CALM.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS TO SEVERAL AREAS IN THEIR AOR INCLUDING THE BORDER POST AS PART OF OPs RUBY AND RETOUR. THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED CALM. HOWEVER, PATROLS FOR OP RETOUR REPORTED THAT IDPs IN RWAMIKO DPC REFUSED TO BE EVACUATED TO THEIR HOME COMMUNES.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM.

(2) MIOLBS CONDUCTED PATROLS TO BWAKIRA COMMUNE. THEY REPORTED THAT THE DEPARTURE OF FRAFBATT FROM BIRAMBO COINCIDED WITH AN INCREASE IN BANDITRY. THEY ALSO LEARNED OF THE ARREST OF A RWANDESE DOCTOR FROM THE HEALTH CENTRE AT SHYEMBE IN KIGALI ON EITHER FRIDAY OR SATURDAY ON SUSPICION OF HAVING TAKEN PART IN THE GENOCIDE.

(3) SECTOR HQ ASSISTED UNHCR REP TO ARRANGE TRANSPORT FROM SENBATT TO MOVE RETURNEES TO THEIR HOME COMMUNES BEGINNING TOMORROW. MILOBS ARE TO ACCOMPANY AND OVERSEE THE MOVE AND WILL SUBSEQUENTLY CONDUCT FOLLOW-UP SECURITY CHECKS OF THE RETURNEES.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD. ACTS OF BANDITRY CONTINUED.

(2) MILOBS WERE INFORMED OF AN ARMED ROBBERY IN NYAMASHEKE ON THE NIGHT OF 27/28 FEB 95. ONE HOUSE WAS LOOTED AND NO ONE WAS INJURED. ALSO IN ISHARA (GR 0245), ON SAME NIGHT, A GROUP OF BANDITS LOOTED BEANS, 40,000 RF TWO CATTLE AND TWO SHEEP. NO ONE WAS INJURED.

(3) MILOBS CARRIED OUT ROUTINE PATROLS TO OTHER AREAS IN THEIR SECTOR. THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED CALM.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONTINUED INTENSIVE ROUTINE PATROLS IN GISENYI TOWN.

(3) MILOBS RECEIVED INFORMATION AT 0715 HRS TODAY THAT

LOCAL AND 1959-60 CASE LOAD RETURNEES WERE CARRYING OUT A DEMONSTRATION NEAR THE BORDER POST AT GISENYI. THE INITIAL CROWD OF ABOUT 100 PEOPLE WAS REPORTED MOVING TOWARDS OTHER RETURNEE CENTRES IN THE VICINITY IN ORDER TO INSTIGATE OTHERS TO JOIN THEM. THE CROWD BUILT UP TO ABOUT 200 PEOPLE AT 0805 HRS. MILOBS CALLED IN TUNBATT TROOPS TO SECURE THE WAREHOUSES IN THE AREA, FOR FEAR OF LOOTING. THE RPA AND GENDARMERIE WERE ALSO INFORMED AND THEY SENT ELEMENTS TO ASSIST THE TUNBATT TROOPS. THIS DEPLOYMENT DISSUADED THE CROWD AND IT DISPERSED. MILOBS AND REPS FROM UNHCR AND THE MINISTRY OF REHABILITATION THEN FOLLOWED UP AND TALKED TO THE RETURNEES IN THE NURSERY SCHOOL CENTRE. DETAILS OF THIS MEETING TO BE FORWARDED LATER.

(4) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN AND AROUND RUHENGARI. THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED CALM.

(5) MILOBS VISITED THE ORPHANAGE AT NEMBA (GR 7619) TO INVESTIGATE A REPORT OF HARASSMENT OF THE SISTERS RUNNING THE ORPHANAGE BY THE BOURGMESTRE OF NYARUTOVU (GR 7517). DETAILS WILL BE FORWARDED LATER.

(6) MILOBS/HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM/CIVPOL INVESTIGATED FOR THE SECOND DAY THE SHOOTOUT ON 27 FEB 95. THREE DIFFERENT VERSIONS OF THE INCIDENT WERE RECEIVED FROM THE RPA, LOCAL POPULATION AND THE CONSEILLER. DETAILS WERE SKETCHY AND TEAM COULD NOT TALK TO ONE OF THE EYEWITNESS AND THE TWO RPA SOLDIERS ADMITTED AT THE HOSPITAL. INVESTIGATIONS CONTINUE.

j. SECTOR 6- KIGALI

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND KIGALI RURAL REMAINED CALM.

UN RESTRICTED

(2) MILOBS MONITORED THE EXHUMATION OF A MASS GRAVE NEAR KIGALI HOSPITAL. IT WAS EXPECTED THAT ABOUT 5,000 CORPSES WOULD BE FOUND AND TRANSFERRED TO NYAMIRAMBO CEMETERY FOR REBURIAL. THE ACTIVITY IS CONSIDERED AS PART OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE HYGIENIC CONDITIONS AROUND THE HOSPITAL AREA.

(4) ROUTINE PATROLS WERE ALSO CONDUCTED IN THE KANOMBE AREA. THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED NORMAL.

k. AIR OPS.

a. THE GENERAL SITUATION IN KIA REMAINED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

d. A TOTAL OF 22 FLIGHTS WERE UNDERTAKEN AT KIA TODAY. DETAILS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

(3) CHARTERED AND SCHEDULED FLIGHTS	- 10.

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.

a. THERE WERE REPORTED TO BE ABOUT 6 RETURNEES STRANDED AT THE BORDER POST AT GATUNA BORDER OUTPOST (GR 0142) FOR THE PAST ONE WEEK AWAITING TRANSPORT TO KIGALI. MILOBS SECTOR 1 SUGGESTED UNHCR BE REQUESTED TO PICK THEM UP.

b. WORLD VISION TODAY DISTRIBUTED FOOD TO LOCALS IN RAMBURA SECTEUR (GR 0038) IN SECTOR 1.

c. STILL IN SECTOR 1, CRS PROVIDED 500 BAGS EACH OF MAIZE

AND BEANS IN ADDITION TO COOKING OIL IN PREPARATION FOR THE RE-OPENING OF RUTARE (GR 1908) SECONDARY SCHOOL SCHEDULED FOR 3 MAR 95.

d. IN SECTOR 2, WFP DISTRIBUTED FOOD TO OVER 2,000 PEOPLE IN RILIMA TODAY.

e. UNHCR ORGANISED A GENERAL FOOD DISTRIBUTION IN SATINSYI COMMUNE (GR 5800) TODAY.

f. IN SECTOR 4B, SWISS DISASTER RELIEF DISTRIBUTED COFFEE BEANS TO ABOUT 45 FARMERS TODAY.

g. A TOTAL OF 176 IDPs WERE EVACUATED FROM DPCs TODAY. DETAIL ARE AS FOLLOWS:

(1) KIBEHO - 139.

(2) NDAGO - NIL

(3) NYAMIGINA - 7.

(4) GISUNZU - 30.

h. MILOBS IN SECTOR 5 REPORTED AN ORGANISED MOVE OF 500 RETURNEES WHO ARRIVED FROM CAMPS IN ZAIRE ON 27 FEB 95, FROM GISENYI TO THEIR HOME COMMUNES IN RUHENGERI PREFECTURE. MILOBS ASSISTED UNHCR IN THE MOVEMENT PROCESS.



5. CIVILIAN AFFAIRS. SECTOR 1 MILOBS REPORTED THAT A LOCAL BODY HAD BEING FORMED IN CYUMBA COMMUNE (GR 0133) TO TRY MINOR OFFENCES SUCH AS THEFT EVERY MONDAY AND THURSDAY. THE PEOPLE WERE SAID TO BE HAPPY WITH THE SYSTEM.

7. MISC SECTOR 3 MILOBS REPORTED THAT THE ZAMBATT VEHICLE WHICH WAS INVOLVED IN AN ACCIDENT IN BUTARE ON 09 FEB 95 HAD BEEN TOWED FROM THE SITE OF THE ACCIDENT TO THE GENDARMERIE OFFICE IN BUTARE.

1. SITUATION

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

b. BORDERS

(1) GATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) RUSIZI BORDER POST IN SECT 4C WAS OPEN TO TRAFFIC.

(4) GISENYI BORDER POSTS WERE CLOSED TO UNAMIR PERS.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL. NTR

b. MILITARY

(1) RPA.

(a) SECTOR 2 MILOBS REPORTED THAT AT APPROXIMATELY 250800, A GIRL AGED ABOUT 15 YRS REPORTED TO GHANBATT TROOPS AT GISHALI THAT HER FATHER HAD BEEN ARRESTED BY RPA SOLDIERS AND SOME POLICEMEN AT GATI (GR 4392) ON 24 FEB 95. THE GIRL THEREFORE SOUGHT REFUGE WITH THE GHANBATT TROOPS FOR FEAR OF HARASSMENT.

(b) SECTOR 5 MILOBS REPORTED THAT THE RPA CHECK-POINT AT THE ENTRANCE OF GISENYI HAD BEEN SHIFTED TO AREA GR 18912.

(2) FRGF. NTR.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTIN ED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS TO GATUNA (GR 0142), MATIMBA (4874), KAGITUMBA (GR 5184) AND NYAGATARE (GR 3550). SITUATION IN AREAS PATROLLED WAS REPORTED CALM.

(3) MILOBS HELD A MEETING WITH THE SUB PREFECT OF BYUMBA. HE REQUESTED FOR TRANSPORT TO SHIFT SOME RETURNEES.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN SEVERAL PARTS OF THE AOR. THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS CALM.

(3) MILOBS ALSO INVESTIGATED THE REPORTED ARREST BY THE RPA IN GATI. THE ARREST WAS CONFIRMED AND LOCAL AUTHORITIES TOLD MILOBS THEY WOULD LOOK INTO THE CASE ON 27 FEB 95. MEANWHILE, VILLAGERS INFORMED MILOBS THAT ABOUT 15 MORE PEOPLE WERE ARRESTED THAT DAY.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED HELI RECCE OVER THE NORTH-WESTERN COMMUNES OF GITARAMA PREFECTURE. ROADS, BRIDGES AND LANDING SPOTS WERE CHECKED. SMALLER SETTLEMENTS ACCESSIBLE ONLY BY SINGLE TRACKS WERE ALSO NOTICED. MILOBS PLANNED TO VISIT THESE SETTLEMENTS LATER AND SUGGESTED MOTORBIKES AS FOUR-WHEELED VEHICLES CAN NOT GET THERE.

(3) PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED TO KANYARU-HAUTE BORDER CROSSING POINT. SITUATION WAS REPORTED CALM.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

UN RESTRICTED

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT PATROLS TO DPC's AND BORDER POSTS IN THEIR SECTOR AS PART OF OPS RETOUR AND RUBY. THEY WERE INFORMED BY SOME IDPs AT NYAMAGINA THAT RPA SOLDIERS OFTEN TAKE AWAY FROM THEM SOME ITEMS SUCH AS PLASTIC SHEET SHELTERS AND WOODEN BICYCLES. THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS REPORTED CALM.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT PATROLS TO KIVUMU COMMUNE. THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED CALM.

(3) MILOBS WERE INFORMED OF AN ALLEGED KILLING OF THREE PERSONS IN RWAMATAMU COMMUNE ON 24 FEB 95. A PATROL IS TO INVESTIGATE ON 27 FEB 95.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT ROUTINE PATROLS TO SEVERAL AREAS IN THEIR AOR. THE SITUATION REMAINED CALM EXCEPT REPORTS OF BANDITRY.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT INTENSIVE PATROLS IN GISENYI TOWNSHIP. NO INCIDENT WAS REPORTED AND THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS CALM.

UN RESTRICTED

(3) PATROLS WERE ALSO CARRIED OUT IN OTHER AREAS OF THE SECTOR. MILOB PATROLS WERE INFORMED OF THE KILLING OF ONE MR CEBAHUTU OF KANZANZE SECTEUR (GR 3019) IN THE NIGHT OF 25/26 FEB 95. THE CASE IS BEING INVESTIGATED BY CIVPOL.

j. SECTOR 6- KIGALI

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND KIGALI RURAL REMAINED CALM.

(2) MILOBS WERE DETAILED AS QRT FOR DUTY DURING THE PERIOD.

k. AIR OPS.

a. THE GENERAL SITUATION IN KIA REMAINED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

b. ROTATION OF PART OF MALAWIAN CONTINGENT WAS CARRIED OUT IN THE AFTERNOON.

c. MILOBS SUGGESTED A SIGNBOARD BE PUT AT THE REMERA JUNCTION TO DIRECT UNAMIR PERSONNEL TO THE HELI DISPERSAL POINT TO AVOID THE PRESENT PRACTICE OF CROSSING THE RUNWAY AS THIS IS DETRIMENTAL TO FLIGHT SAFETY.

d. A TOTAL OF 15 FLIGHTS WERE UNDERTAKEN AT KIA TODAY. DETAILS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

(1) UNAMIR	- 10.
(2) CANDY LOGISTICS	- 1.

(3) COMMERCIAL AND OTHERS - 4.
TOTAL - 15.

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.

a. SECTOR 1 MILOBS REPORTED AN INFLUX OF IDPs INTO MATIMBA AND NYAGATARE RECEPTION CENTRES IN SPITE OF THE PLANNED CLOSURE OF THESE TWO CENTRES BY WFP AND UNHCR. THEY REPORTED A SHORTFALL IN FOOD AND WATER SUPPLY.

5. CIVILIAN AFFAIRS. SECTOR 3 MILOBS REPORTED THAT APPROXIMATELY 400 CIVILIANS WERE OBSERVED RETURNING FROM VISIT TO BUTARE PRISON.

6. LOGISTICS. NTR.



1. SITUATION

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

b. BORDERS

(1) GATUNA AND KIGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) RUSIZI BORDER POST IN SECT 4C WAS OPEN TO TRAFFIC.

(4) GISENYI BORDER POSTS WERE CLOSED TO UNAMIR PERS.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL.

(1) THE YOUTH OF GITI COMMUNE IN SECTOR 1 (GR 2303) HELD

UN RESTRICTED

A MEETING TO MOBILISE THE YOUTH IN THE RECONCILIATION PROCESS.

b. MILITARY

(1) RPA.

(a) SECTOR 4A MILOBS REPORTED THAT RPA WANTED TO ARREST A DP IN KIBEHO (GR 5107) WITHOUT INFORMING THE ZAMBATT PLATOON PROVIDING SECURITY IN THE CAMP. THE DPS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE STONED THE RPA TROOPS. THE INTERVENTION OF ZAMBATT TROOPS WAS EFFECTED TO PREVENT THE SITUATION FROM GETTING OUT OF CONTROL.

(1.) IN KIRAMBO COMMUNE IN SECTOR 4C, RPA WERE REPORTED TO HAVE SHOT AND KILLED A MAN WHO HAD BEEN ACCUSED OF BY 3 LOCALS PARTICIPATING IN THE GENOCIDE. THE 3 COMPLAINANTS WERE ALSO REPORTED TO BE IN RPA CUSTODY. LOCAL RPA COMMANDERS WERE NOT AVAILABLE TO COMMENT ON THE INCIDENTS. INVESTIGATIONS STILL IN PROGRESS.

(3) IN KAMEMBE IN SECTOR 4C RPA SHOT AND KILLED ONE BANDIT WHO TRIED TO ESCAPE FROM CUSTODY. THE BANDIT WAS ARRESTED BY LOCALS AND WAS ALLEGED TO BE CARRYING 2 GRENADES AT THE TIME OF HIS ARREST. INVESTIGATIONS IN PROGRESS.

(2) FRGF. NTR.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS TO GITI COMMUNE (GR 2303) TO COLLECT DATA ON THE COMMUNE. THE PATROL WAS ACCOMPANIED BY THE PREFECT OF BYUMBA. HELI PATROLS WERE ALSO CONDUCTED OVER THE GENERAL AREA OF NGARAMA (GR 2628), KIVUYA (GR 9532) KAGITUMBA (GR 5184) AND ALONG THE AKAGERA RIVER TO THE LAKE HAGO (GR 8015). THERE WAS REPORTED TO BE AN INCREASING NUMBER OF RETURNEES INSIDE THE AKAGERA NATIONAL PARK. A LARGE NUMBER OF CATTLE WAS ALSO OBSERVED GRAZING IN THE PARK. THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS HOWEVER NORMAL.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN SEVERAL PARTS OF THE AOR. THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS CALM. NO UNTOWARD INCIDENT WAS REPORTED.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED INVESTIGATIONS OF REPORTS OF A SECRET PRISON IN KIGOMA (GR 7750). THREE LOCALS INTERVIEWED CONFIRMED THE EXISTENCE OF THE PRISON. IT WAS ALSO REPORTED THAT PRISONERS WERE NOT BEING REGISTERED. LOCALS ALSO REPORTED THAT ARRESTS WERE NORMALLY MADE AT NIGHT. THE HOLDING FACILITY AT THE COMMUNAL OFFICE WAS EMPTY.

(3) PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT TO THE KIGEMBE AND

UN RESTRICTED

NYAHUNGERI COMMUNES. THE BOURGEMESTRE OF KIGEMBE COMMUNE INFORMED MILOBS OF THE IMPENDING EXERCISE TO REPATRIATE 380 REFUGEES FROM BURUNDI DURING THE COMING WEEK. HITHERTO THE REFUGEES HAD REFUSED TO RETURN ON THE DATES SET BY THE ICRC. THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES ALSO INFORMED MILOBS OF THEIR INTENTION TO LIAISE WITH THEIR COUNTERPARTS IN BURUNDI TO COORDINATE THE EXERCISE.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT PATROLS TO DPC's AND BORDER POSTS IN THEIR SECTOR AS PART OF OPS RETOUR AND RUBY. THERE WAS NO INCIDENT TO REPORT EXCEPT THE STONING OF RPA PROOPS WHEN THEY ATTEMPTED TO ARREST A LOCAL IN THE KIBENO DPC. THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY NORMAL.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT PATROLS IN NDABA (GR 4127) AND RUKOKU (GR 4772). NO RECENT CASES OF ARRESTS OR INTIMIDATION HAD BEEN REPORTED. LOCAL AUTHORITIES WERE HOWEVER NOT AVAILABLE FOR COMMENT. THE PATROL ALSO ASSESSED THE STATE OF MEDICAL FACILITIES AT THE NYANGE HOSPITAL (GR 5472). BASIC FACILITIES WERE REPORTED TO BE LACKING. HOSPITAL AUTHORITIES ALSO COMPLAINED ABOUT FREQUENT ACTS OF VANDALISM RESULTING IN DAMAGE TO HOSPITAL PROPERTY.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

UN RESTRICTED

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT ROUTINE PATROLS TO SEVERAL AREAS IN THEIR AOR. A PATROL TO KAMEMBE REPORTED THAT 8 BANDITS ATTACKED A HOUSEHOLD IN RUHERO (GR 0741) AND INFLICTED MACHETE WOUNDS TO THE HEADS OF A MAN AND A WOMAN. BOTH VICTIMS ARE RECEIVING TREATMENT AT THE KAMEMBE HOSPITAL. PATROLS TO OTHER PARTS OF THE SECTOR REPORTED THE SITUATION NORMAL.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT INTENSIVE PATROLS IN GISENYI TOWNSHIP. NO INCIDENT WAS REPORTED AND THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS CALM.

(3) ESCORTS WERE PROVIDED FOR WFP TRUCKS CONVEYING FOOD FOR RETURNEES IN GISENYI AND MUTURA COMMUNES (GR 4332).

(4) COORDINATING CONFERENCE WAS HELD TO COORDINATE THE CONTINGENCY PLAN FOR THE EVACUATION OF REFUGEES IN ZAIRE IN THE EVENT OF A VOLCANIC ERUPTION. CONFERENCE WAS ATTENDED BY REPS OF ALL UN AGENCIES AND NGOS IN THE AREA. DETAILS OF THE CONFERENCE TO BE SUBMITTED SEPARATELY.

j. SECTOR 6- KIGALI

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND KIGALI RURAL REMAINED CALM.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS TO KICUKURO COMMUNE. LOCALS AUTHORITIES WERE AT A MEETING AND WERE NOT AVAILABLE TO MILOBS FOR INTERVIEW. THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS HOWEVER NORMAL.



UN RESTRICTED

OF RUTARE HELD A RALLY TODAY. THE AIM WAS TO ENCOURAGE THEM TO ASSIST IN THE RECONCILIATION PROCESS. AN OFFICIAL OF THE MINISTRY OF REHABILITATION PRESIDED.

(2) IN SECTOR 3, THE PREFECT OF GITARAMA VISITED THE SECTOR HQ THE ISSUE OF FOOD SUPPLIES AND THE COMING REBURIAL CEREMONIES AT MUGINA. HE STATED THAT HE BELIEVED THE VICE PRESIDENT WOULD ATTEND AND THAT SEVERAL MINISTERS HAD ALREADY CONFIRMED THEIR ATTENDANCE. HE WENT FURTHER TO SAY THAT HE HAD CONVENED A MEETING OF THE LOCAL BDE COMMANDER, THE BISHOP AND SOME OF HIS STAFF TO DISCUSS WAYS AND MEANS OF IMPROVING CONDITIONS IN THE GITARAMA PRISON; THIS AS A RESULT OF FC'S VISIT. THE BISHOP ANNOUNCED THE POSSIBILITY OF FUNDS FROM THE CHURCH TO ASSIST IN THIS EFFORT.

(4) SECTOR 5 SUB-SECTOR HQ IN RUHENGERI REPORTED
THAT ONE PLATOON OF RPA MOVED TO GISENYI PREFECTURE
TO REINFORCE THE EXISTING RPA DEPLOYMENT IN GISENYI
PREFECTURE IN LIGHT OF THE INCIDENTS OF THE PAST
WEEK.

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN RUNDA (GR 9882), MUGINA (GR 9367) AND NTONGWE COMMUNES TO GATHER INFORMATION AND IMPROVE WORKING RELATIONS WITH LOCAL AUTHORITIES. THE SITUATION IN THE AREAS WAS REPORTED NORMAL EXCEPT IN RUNDA WHERE ISOLATED CASES OF BANDITRY WAS REPORTED.

(3) A JOINT MILOB/UNHCR PATROL WENT TO IMBARE CELLULE OF MUSAMBIRA (GR 8374) COMMUNE. THE PATROL WAS INFORMED BY SOME WOMEN THAT THERE WERE ONLY 3 MEN LEFT IN THE VILLAGE, ALL OVER 60 YEARS. THE REST HAD BEEN ARRESTED BY RPA OR FLED THE VILLAGE FOR FEAR OF SUCH ARREST. THE PREFECT OF GITARAMA WHEN CONTACTED, CONFIRMED THAT MUSAMBIRA WAS A SPECIAL PROBLEM AND HE FINDS IT DIFFICULT CONTROLLING THE BOURGEMESTRE. THE SECTOR COMMANDER PLANS VISITING THE BOURGEMESTRE NEXT WEEK TO RESOLVE THE PROBLEMS.

(4) PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT IN MUGANZA COMMUNE (GR 8409) AND REPORTED A POOR SECURITY SITUATION THERE DUE TO FREQUENT ACTS OF BANDITRY. THE POPULATION HAD DECLINED FROM 17,926 IN DEC 94 TO 15,000 MAINLY DUE

TO THE INSECURITY AND LACK OF FOOD AND MEDICINE. MOST PEOPLE ARE SAID TO HAVE FLED TO BURUNDI.

IT WAS ATTENDED BY THE PREFECT, CHIEF OF GENDARMERIE, VICE PRESIDENT OF COURT, PUBLIC PROSECUTOR, DIRECTOR OF PRISON, HUMAN RIGHTS TEAM AND MILOBS HUMANITARIAN TEAM. A LOT WAS DISCUSSED ON THE RUNNING OF THE JUDICIARY SYSTEM AT PREFECTURE AND COMMUNE LEVELS.



(2) RPA TROOPS IN SECTOR 4C RELEASED THE BOURGEMESTRE OF BUGARMA DURING THE PERIOD. IN ALL IT WAS ESTIMATED THAT 25 PERSONS INCLUDING 5 COUNSELLOPS AND 20 INTELLECTUALS HAD BEEN ARRESTED IN THE SAME SECTOR ON CHARGES OF PARTICIPATING IN THE GENOCIDE.

(3) RPA TROOPS IN NEAR THE APEEDUC ORPHANAGE (GR 78228) IN SECTOR 4C WERE REPORTED TO HAVE OPENED FIRE ON SOME BOATS ON AN INLET NEAR THE ORPHANAGE BETWEEN 222200B - 222330B FEB 95. THE IDENTITY OF THE TARGET WAS UNKNOWN AND THERE WERE NO CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED. RPA LOCAL COMMANDERS REFUSED TO COMMENT ON THE INCIDENT WHEN QUESTIONED BY SECTOR MILOBS.

(4) TWO LOCALS WERE ARRESTED IN BUGARAMA (SECTOR 4C) ON 16 FEB 95. ONE WAS ARRESTED FOR POSSESSING 2 GRENADES AND A WEAPON. THE OTHER LOCAL WAS ARRESTED FOR MURDER OF HIS NEIGHBOUR. IN THE SAME SECTOR, MILOBS REPORTED THAT HUMAN RIGHTS MONITORS WERE STILL BEING REFUSED ACCESS TO THE CELLS IN KAMEMEBE.

(2) FRGF. NTR.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD. A GHANAIAAN DELEGATION, LED BY CDS OF THE GHANA ARMED FORCES VISITED THE SECTOR.

(2) MILOBS WITHDREW COMPLETELY FROM RWAMAGANA TO THE NEW SUB-SECTOR LOCATION IN GATUZA (GR 3122) DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED IN THE KINYAMI COMMUNE (GR 1418) TO COLLECT DATA ON THE BYUMBA PREFECTURE. THERE WAS REPORTED TO BE AN FRGF SOLDIER WHO WAS SKILLED IN DEACTIVATION OF MINES. TO DATE THE SOLDIER HAS DEFUSED ALL THE MINES AND EXPLOSIVES FOUND. ONLY 5 RETURNEES WERE REPORTED IN THE COMMUNE. THEY HAD BEEN PROVIDED UNOCCUPIED ACCOMMODATION UNTIL THE RETURN OF THEIR BONA FIDE OWNERS. THE ABSENCE OF A JUDGE AND A POLICE INSPECTOR WAS REPORTED TO BE HINDERING THE JUSTICE SYSTEM. THE SECURITY SITUATION WAS HOWEVER ASSESSED AS GOOD.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT ROUTINE PATROLS IN BIRENGA (GR 5959), RUKIRA (GR 6658), KAYONZA (GR 5784) AND KAYONZA (5874). THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS NORMAL IN ALL

AREAS PATROLLED.

(3) MILOBS ESCORTED HUMAN RIGHTS MONITORS TO MUGASERA (GR 4764) FOR INVESTIGATIONS.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS IN MUYIRA (GR 8641) AND NTYAZO (GR 8623) COMMUNES. 200 ARRESTS OF LOCALS WERE REPORTED IN THE MUYIRA COMMUNE WHILE 396 WERE REPORTED IN THE NTYAZO COMMUNE. THE MUYIRA COMMUNE BOURGEMESTRE INFORMED MILOBS THAT THERE WERE ABOUT 2,000 RETURNEES TO THE COMMUNE.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGOI

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD. THE FC VISITED THE KIBEHO DPC DURING THE PERIOD. SECTOR MILOBS PROVIDED ESCORTS AND VEHICLES FOR THE FC AND ACCOMPANYING STAFF OFFICERS.

(2) MILOBS MONITORED THE EVACUATION REFUGEES FROM KIBEHO AND RWAMIKO AS PART OF OP RETOUR. THE DPS AT RWAMIKO REFUSED TO BE EVACUATED DUE TO THEIR FEAR OF RPA HARASSMENT IN THEIR HOME COMMUNES.

(3) MILOBS ALSO MONITORED THE EVACUATION OF DPCS IN NYAMIGINA (GR 4523), KANYINYA (GR 5621) AND MUGANO (GR 5621) AS PART OF OP RETOUR.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM BUT UNSTABLE.

UN RESTRICTED

(2) MILOBS ACCOMPANIED BY BOURGEMESTRE OF KIVUMU COMMUNE CONDUCTED HELI RECCE OF THE KIVUMU COMMUNE. BAD WEATHER PREVENTED THE PATROL FROM COMPLETING ITS MISSION.

(3) MILOBS INVESTIGATED REPORTS OF A MEASLES OUTBREAK IN KIVUMU COMMUNE. SITUATION WAS NORMAL AWN ROUTE. THE NUMBER OF REPORTED CASES OF MALARIA WAS REPORTED TO HAVE DROPPED IN THE KILINDA COMMUNE FROM 136 PER WEEK TO 74 DURING HE PERIOD.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD. THE CURFEW WAS REPORTED TO BE STILL IN FORCE AND MINOR ACTS OF BANDITRY WERE REPORTED DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOB PATROLS TO GISUMA COMMUNE REPORTED THE PRESENCE OF 12 PRISONERS, INCLUDING 1 FEMALE IN THE CAMP IN THAT LOCATION. ALL PRISONERS WERE BEING DETAINED ON ALLEGATIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE GENOCIDE. IT WAS REPORTED BY SECTOR MILOBS THAT PROPER DOCUMENTATION WAS BEING MADE BY LOCAL AUTHORITIES IN RESPECT OF THE DETAINEES.

(3) MILOB PATROLS TO THE NYAGATARE REPORTED THAT A TOTAL OF 191 PERSONS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE LEFT THE CAMP DURING THE PERIOD 18 FEB-22 FEB 95. 109 NEW DPS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE ARRIVED IN THE CAMP DURING THE SAME PERIOD.

(4) SECTOR MILOBS ATTENDED CONFERENCE WITH ICRC AND HUMAN RIGHTS MONITORS TO EXCHANGE INFORMATION ON RECENT ARRESTS, ACCESS TO DETENTION AREAS AND REHABILITATION PLANNING.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

UN RESTRICTED

(2) INVESTIGATIONS WERE CONDUCTED INTO THE MURDER OF THE CHIEF OF THE RWANDESE HEALTH AUTHORITIES AND HIS TWO YEAR OLD SON IN GISENYI ON 22 FEB 95. PRELIMINARY REPORT INDICATES THAT THE INCIDENT OCCURRED AROUND 2015 HRS ON THE SAID DATE. 2 WOMEN, 1 MAN AND 4 CHILDREN WERE ALSO SERIOUSLY WOUNDED IN THE ATTACK. GERMAN EMERGENCY DOCTORS WERE AVAILABLE TO TREAT THE WOUNDED. A 12-YEAR OLD SON OF THE DECEASED HEALTH OFFICIAL WAS EVACUATED TO RUHENGARI HOSPITAL IN TUNBATT AMBULANCE. IT WAS REVEALED THAT THE DIRECTOR HAD RECEIVED BUT IGNORED DEATH THREATS FROM THE FORMER GOVT DUE TO HIS COOPERATION WITH PRESENT GOVT. INVESTIGATIONS BY CIVPOL AND HUMAN RIGHTS MONITORS STILL IN PROGRESS.

(3) MILOBS, TOGETHER WITH LOCAL GENDARMERIE, ESCORTED A CONVOY OF COOPI FROM KORA (GR 3821) TO THE WAREHOUSE IN GISENYI.

(4) MILOBS RECEIVED REPORTS OF THE MURDER OF 9 PERSONS WHICH OCCURRED ON THE NI 22/23 FEB 95 IN THE MUTURA COMMUNE (GR 3223). THE MURDERS WERE COMMITTED IN THE RUSENGA (GR 3926) AND GASESERO (GR 3925) COMMUNES. MILOBS AND HUMAN RIGHTS MONITORS INVESTIGATING.

(5) MILOBS ASSISTED IN THE PROCESSING OF 250 RETURNEES FROM GISENYI TRANSIT CENTRE TO THEIR HOME COMMUNE AT KINIGI (GR 5440). ESCORTS COULD NOT BE PROVIDED DUE TO THE NON-AVAILABILITY OF VEHICLES.

(4) MILOBS ALSO CARRIED OUT PATROLS TO VARIOUS PLACES IN THEIR SECTOR. SITUATION IN AREAS PATROLLED WAS REPORTED CALM.

j. SECTOR 6- KIGALI

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND KIGALI RURAL

REMAINED CALM.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS TO RUBUNGO COMMUNE. THE SITUATION WAS QUIET AND NORMAL IN THE COMMUNE. NO NEW INFORMATION WAS ACQUIRED.

k. AIR OPS.

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIA REMAINED CALM OVER THE PERIOD. THE RWANDESE ARMY AVIATION (RAA) COMMANDER INDICATED THAT THERE WAS A REQUIREMENT FOR THE TAKE OVER OF THE RPA HANGAR BEING USED BY UNAMIR TO CONTINUE HIS EFFORTS TO RESUSCITATE THE RAA. IT WAS RECOMMENDED BY THE UNAMIR AIR LIAISON CELL THAT IT WOULD BE IN THE INTEREST OF THE GOVT AND UNAMIR TO OPERATE SIDE BY SIDE.



1. SITUATION

a. GENERAL. THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

b. BORDERS

(1) GATUNA AND KAGITUMBA BORDER POSTS WERE OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) RUSUMO BORDER POST (RWANDA/TANZANIA) REMAINED OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) RUSIZI BORDER POST IN SECT 4C WAS OPEN TO TRAFFIC.

(4) GISENYI BORDER POSTS WERE CLOSED TO UNAMIR PERS.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL. NTR.

UN RESTRICTED

b. MILITARY

(1) RPA.

(a) AN RPA ESCORT VEHICLE FOR THE VICE PRESIDENT OF RWANDA WAS REPORTED TO HAVE KNOCKED DOWN A LITTLE GIRL IN BUTARE (SECTOR 3). THE CHILD WAS EVACUATED TO BUTARE HOSPITAL. THE EXTENT OF INJURIES IS STILL UNKNOWN.

(b) SECTOR 4C REPORTED AN INCREASE IN THE STR OF RPA TROOPS IN KAMEMBE COMMUNE. IT WAS UNKNOWN IF THERE WAS A GENERAL TROOP ROTATION GOING ON OR IT WAS A BUILD UP FOR A SPECIFIC OPERATION. IN THE SAME SECTOR, RPA WAS REPORTED TO HAVE ARRESTED THE BOURGEMESTRE OF GISHOMA FOR UNKNOWN REASON AND ANOTHER PERSON ON 16 FEB ON ALLEGATIONS OF HAVING TAKEN PART IN THE GENOCIDE.

(c) RPA WAS REPORTED TO HAVE APPROACHED TUNBATT AND INFORMED THEM OF THEIR ARREST OF THE CONSEILLOR OF TAMIRA (GR 3125) IN SECTOR 5 ON CHARGES OF MURDER. THEY REQUESTED TO EVERYONE'S SURPRISE THAT MILOBS AND HR MONITORS SHOULD INVESTIGATE THE CHARGES. INVESTIGATIONS ARE TO BE CARRIED OUT.

(2) FRGF.

(a) IT WAS DISCOVERED THAT THE PRISONER ARRESTED BY ETHIOBATT ON 19 FEB 95 (SITREP OF 19 FEB 95 REFERS) IS AN FRGF SOLDIER. HE INFORMED MILOBS ON QUESTIONING THAT THERE WERE ABOUT 100 FRGF SOLDIERS OF HIS AGE ON THE IJWI ISLAND.

(3) OTHER MILITARY ACTIVITY. NTR

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES

a. MILOB GP HQ. CONTINUED COORDINATION AND MONITORING OF MILOBS ACTIVITIES IN THE SECTORS.

b. SECTOR 1 - BYUMBA

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS OCCUPIED THE NEW SUB-SECTOR AT GITUZA IN THE NGARAMA SUB-SECTOR DURING THE PERIOD.

(3) ROUTINE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED TO THE GATUNA BORDER POST AND THE KIYOMBE COMMUNE (GR 0940). AT THE KIYOMBE COMMUNE THE PATROL LIAISED WITH A REP OF THE PREFECTURE OFFICE FOR DATA ON THE COMMUNE. THE BOURGEMESTRE ALSO COMPLAINED OF A SHORTAGE OF SEEDS FOR SOWING. HE SAID THAT THERE WAS AN URGENT NEED FOR FOOD DISTRIBUTION IN THE COMMUNE. THE SECURITY SITUATION WAS CONSIDERED GOOD.

c. SECTOR 2 - KIBUNGO

(1) THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS INVESTIGATED AN INCIDENT OF BANDITRY WHICH OCCURRED IN RUMAMANYONI (GR 535138) ON 10 FEB 95. IT WAS REPORTED THAT AROUND 2300 HRS ON THE SAID DAY, ARMED BANDITS RAIDED A VILLAGE IN THE VILLAGE AND KILLED A 36 YEAR OLD WOMAN IN THE PROCESS. THEY STOLE A BICYCLE, 2 MATTRESSES AND 4 BAGS OF CLOTHES. RPA TROOPS AMBUSHED THEM ON THEIR ESCAPE ROUTE TO THE AKAGERA NATIONAL PARK, KILLED TWO BANDITS AND RETRIEVED THE STOLEN ITEMS. DETAILED REPORT TO BE SUBMITTED SEPARATELY.

(3) MILOBS ALSO CONDUCTED ROUTINE PATROLS IN VARIOUS PARTS OF THE SECTOR. THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS NORMAL.

d. SECTOR 3 - GITARAMA

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR WAS CALM DURING THE PERIOD. THE FC VISITED THE SECTOR, MET THE PREFECT OF GITARAMA AND VISITED THE GITARAMA PRISON. IT WAS LEARNT THAT 7-10 PRISONERS WERE DYING DAILY AS A RESULT OF THE OVERCROWDED CONDITIONS. IT WAS AGREED THAT THE CONDITIONS AT THE PRISON REQUIRED IMMEDIATE IMPROVEMENT. THE FC ANNOUNCED HIS INTENTIONS TO TAKE NECESSARY ACTION TO AMELIORATE THE CONDITIONS IN THE PRISON.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT A ROUTINE PATROL TO THE BORDER CROSSING POINT AT KANYARU-HAUTE. THERE WERE REPORTED TO BE A LARGE BUT UNSPECIFIED NUMBER OF DPS RETURNING ON FOOT TO THEIR HOME COMMUNES FROM THE DPCS IN GIKONGORO.

e. SECTOR 4A - GIKONGORO

(1) THE SIT IN THE SECTOR REMAINED GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) MILOBS CARRIED OUT PATROLS IN THE VARIOUS DPCS AND BORDER POSTS AS PART OF OPS RUBY AND OP RETOUR. TRUCKS FOR EVACUATION OF DPS WERE PROVIDED BY ZAMBATT AND UNHCR. THE DPS WERE REPORTED AS UNWILLING TO LEAVE THE DPCS AT KANYINYA (GR 5621) AND NYAMIGINA (GR 4523). IT WAS ESTIMATED THAT 600 NEW DPS WERE ARRIVING DAILY TO THE KIBEHO CAMP. MOST OF THEM POSSESSED MACHETES. MILOBS ASSESS THAT THE MACHETES MIGHT CAUSE SECURITY PROBLEMS WITHIN THE CAMP.

(3) ROUTINE PATROLS IN THE GIKONGORO TOWN REPORTED THE SITUATION NORMAL.

f. SECTOR 4B - KIBUYE

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD. THE OUTGOING FORCE SIGNAL OFFICER AND HIS RELIEVER VISITED THE SECTOR DURING THE PERIOD. THEY WERE ESCORTED TO MT KARUNGI AND OTHER LOCATIONS TO ASSESS THE COMMUNICATION REQUIREMENTS.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED A RECCE FOR A HELI LANDING SITE. A SUITABLE SITE WAS LOCATED AT GR 551773.

g. SECTOR 4C - CYANGUGU

(1) THE SITUATION WAS GENERALLY CALM DURING THE PERIOD. HOWEVER, IT WAS REPORTED THAT THE ARREST OF MANY LOCALS IN THE PREFECTURE WAS MAKING THEM NERVOUS

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS TO BUGEZA (GR 9244). LOCALS REPORTED THAT THERE WERE NIGHTLY ATTACKS ON THEIR VILLAGE BY ARMED UNIFORMED MEN. LOCALS WERE REPORTED TO HAVE FORMED A VIGILANTE GROUP FOR THEIR OWN PROTECTION AND SECURITY.

(3) ROUTINE PATROLS WERE ALSO CONDUCTED TO THE BORDER POSTS. THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS REPORTED NORMAL.

h. SECTOR 5 - GISENYI

(1) THE SECTOR WAS REPORTED CALM DURING THE PERIOD.

(2) INTENSIVE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED IN THE GISENYI TOWNSHIP FOLLOWING THE SERIOUS INCIDENTS OF LOOTING OVER THE PAST TWO DAYS. THE SITUATION WAS REPORTED CALM.

(3) THE SECTOR COMD AND HQ STAFF VISITED THE VARIOUS WARE HOUSES TO ASSESS THEIR SECURITY REQUIREMENTS. HE

UN RESTRICTED

ALSO HELD DISCUSSIONS WITH REPS OF VARIOUS NGOS TO DISCUSS THE SECURITY SITUATION.

(4) MILOBS, ACCOMPANIED BY THE FORCE PUBLIC AFFAIRS OFFICER AND A JOURNALIST CONDUCTED FOOT PATROLS IN POSTE BISOKE (GR 449393), KARISOKE RESEARCH CENTRE (GR 428360) AND THE ZAIREAN BORDER.

j. SECTOR 6- KIGALI

(1) THE SITUATION IN KIGALI CITY AND KIGALI RURAL REMAINED CALM.

(2) MILOBS CONDUCTED PATROLS TO GIKOMERO COMMUNE. THEY VISITED TWO SCHOOLS IN THE COMMUNE AND HELD DISCUSSIONS WITH SOME OF THE TEACHERS. THEY WERE INFORMED OF THE PROBLEMS OF STATIONERY AND CLASSROOM AND OFFICE FURNITURE IN THE SCHOOLS. THE TEACHERS APPEARED SATISFIED WITH THE SECURITY SITUATION.

(3) ROUTINE PATROLS TO OTHER PARTS OF THE SECTOR REPORTED THAT THE GENERAL SITUATION WAS NORMAL.

k. AIR OPS. NTR.

4. HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES.

a. SECTOR 4B MILOBS REPORTED THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PREFECTS OF GISENYI AND GITARAMA TO RETURN ABOUT 400 DPS TO THE KIBUYE PREFECTURE (SITREP OF 19 FEB REFERS).

b. A TOTAL OF 233 DPS WERE EVACUATED FROM DPCS IN SECTORS 3 AND 4A DURING THE PERIOD. DETAILS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

(1) KIBEHO	-	66.
(2) NYAMGINA	-	20.
(3) NDAGO	-	113.

(4) MUGANGO - 34.

c. THERE WERE REPORTED TO BE 87 REFUGEES WAITING AT GISHUMA (GR 8211) FOR TRANSPORT TO BUGARAMA AND CYANGUGU. EVACUATION WAS PLANNED FOR 22 FEB 95.


