We have heard indirectly that Barakat, former Director BCE, might be willing to return to that post. Understand this is influenced ~~by~~ by his wife's changed attitude to living in Leopoldville. We would welcome his reappointment.

However, in considering an approach to Barakat, account should be taken of the fact that he is somewhat out of favour with Mladek of IMF for having opposed recommendations of latter's Mission on monetary reform and carrying this opposition with Prime Minister Adoula to meetings with IMF officials in Washington. IMF might therefore feel unhappy to see Barakat's return to post of Director of BCE, though we have no doubt whatever that ~~Barakat's~~ Barakat's work was influenced entirely by objective and honest consideration and he enjoyed the full confidence of Congolese Government.

1. This report is submitted in compliance with your verbal request.
2. It should be made abundantly clear, that the so-called Fellowship Unit, as a department of ONUC Civilian Operations, or as an ONUC-sponsored section under the Bureau of Economic Coordination, does not exist. Nor is there any reason to believe that it would come into existence within the foreseeable future. After M. de Harivel left in late 1962, the decision on the distribution of scholarships and subsequent supervision of allotted fellowships have been in the hands of the Foreign Aid Office of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. They seem to be guarding rather jealously the prerogatives which they are now exercising, and there is no visible tendency towards handing over their responsibilities to the B.E.C. - so much the less as the Prime Minister does not, at least at the moment, appear interested in a transfer of the authority in question.
3. Under the circumstances, all I can do in the way of a report on the Fellowship activities, is to outline the functions of the personnel, who are officially assigned to the so-called Fellowship Unit. After the termination of Mme Jules's contract, the personnel in question consists of only three staff-members: Mr. Salducci, Mlle Bernier and myself.
4. Mr. M. Salducci.- I have visited Mr. Salducci's office and looked into his work. Mr. Salducci has nothing to do with the scrutiny and selection of candidates for ENDA scholarships. Not until a candidate has been accepted and admitted as a student at the ENDA does he appear in Mr. Salducci's files. Thereafter the responsibilities of Mr. Salducci's Office are of a purely administrative and primarily financial character. The office effects all payments to the students and keeps very efficient records of such transactions. However, the activity is so strictly limited to the financial aspects, that, e.g., when I asked if any statistical records were available, showing the distribution of the candidates (or, rather, students) by age-groups, province of origin, previous education, etc. etc., the reply was in the negative. Against this background it seems to me misleading to consider Mr. Salducci as assigned to the Fellowship Unit, in the until now accepted meaning of that term. I suggest he be regarded as an ONUC sponsored Administrative Assistant (or Officer) assigned to ENDA.

5. Mlle S. Bernier.- Practically all the daily routine work in the Section des Bourses in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs is in the hands of this staff-member. The work comprises the following main components:

- transmittal of received offers of fellowships to Ministry of National Education (bourses d'études) and Ministry of Public Administration (bourses de perfectionnement);
- for each accepted candidate, the establishment of a personal dossier;
- supervision of compliance with all formalities required before the departure of a student (medical examination, vaccination, passport etc.);
- statistics of candidates (according to various classifications);
- follow-up on fellows after their departure, i.e., in respect of results obtained, prolongation of scholarship, expected date of return to the Congo, employment here after the studies abroad are finished, etc.
- liaison with Embassies, particularly in the case of ONUC or Specialized Agency fellowships;
- special travel arrangements in connection with UN fellowships, including liaison with airlines.

Miss Bernier is doing an extremely conscientious and efficient job, and I am recommending an extension of her contract which expires 31 December 1963. Staff member was being assisted in her work by Mrs. Y. Jules, whose contract has expired without being renewed. It is essential that a replacement be provided for Mrs. Jules, as Miss Bernier will not be able single-handed to keep abreast of all the work outlined above.

6. G. V. Igum.- As you will understand from para. 2 above, I have never been able to function as Chief of the Fellowship Unit, or even, in any meaningful sense of the term, as Adviser on Fellowships. You will also gather from what has been said, that no change is imminent in this respect. As a matter of fact, the prolongation of my contract (expiring December 31) until end February 1964 has been requested not for the purpose of the Fellowship Unit, but for a special assignment concerned with the liquidation of the pre-independence loans from the International Bank to the Belgian Congo.

7. If nothing energetic can be done, without the fear of hurting political feelings, it would be my recommendation that the illusion of an ONUC-controlled Fellowship Unit be dropped.

AIDE-MEMOIRE

Je suis entrée au Service des Bourses d'études à l'étranger, faisant partie du Ministère des Affaires Etrangères, en septembre 1961. M. Pierre Le Harivel en était alors le Directeur. Il a terminé son contrat au Congo en octobre 1962 et c'est alors Mme Paulette Guilbaud-Coltsinos, son assistante, qui s'est occupée du Service des Bourses, sous l'autorité du Directeur de l'Assistance technique des Affaires Etrangères.

En janvier 1963, Mme Coltsinos a quitté le service en nous faisant savoir qu'elle prenait un congé-maternité de six semaines. Le Service des Bourses se composait alors à ce moment-là, et se compose toujours, de deux secrétaires Onuc (Mme Y. Jules et moi), et d'un employé congolais (M. J. Sumbu), travaillant au sein du Ministère des Affaires Etrangères.

Mme Coltsinos n'a jamais repris son travail depuis et, étant au service des Bourses depuis 1961, je l'ai donc remplacée, assurant la coordination concernant toutes les questions de bourses d'études et de stages à l'étranger, entre le Ministère des Affaires Etrangères et l'Onuc.

Quelque temps après le départ de Mme Coltsinos, j'avais expliqué la situation de notre service à M. Tooby, alors Chef du Congo Fund, en lui faisant part de mon embarras concernant certaines responsabilités. M. Tooby m'avait répondu de faire pour le mieux, en lui demandant conseil à l'occasion.

En juin 1963, Miss B. Gray, Chef du Personnel, m'avait demandé des précisions sur le travail effectué au Service des Bourses et, comme suite à notre entrevue, je lui avais adressé le mémo dont copie jointe.

Je tiens à préciser que notre service est, jusqu'à ce jour, le seul assurant la coordination entre le Ministère des Affaires Etrangères et l'Onuc concernant les questions de bourses à l'étranger, et son effectif n'a pas changé.

Je suis détachée de l'Unesco Paris et j'ai le grade D. Je tiens à votre disposition une copie de mes notes professionnelles établies par M. P. Le Harivel en 1962. Je n'ai obtenu aucun "post allowance" depuis mon arrivée au Congo, en novembre 1960, et les demandes de promotion adressées à l'Unesco par M. P. Le Harivel sont restées sans suite.

Congolese Delegation is scheduled to return to Brussels by end of current week to continue discussions on settlement of 'contentieux' and of transfer of portfolio to Congolese Government. Hitherto delegation had been led by Ambeka, representative of Congo Government at EEC but Adoula is not sending him back with delegation and proposes to replace him by a member of Congolese Embassy in Brussels. Chefic Said, Unations legal expert attached to BCE has been asked by Adoula to continue to ~~advise~~ serve as legal adviser to Congolese delegation.

During Adoula's visit to Brussels in August 1963 some measure of agreement had been reached both on 'contentieux' and portfolio. We understand however that differences arose soon thereafter over transfer of portfolio to Government of Congo until adequate guarantees had been provided for its satisfactory administration. Discussions on this point have continued to drag on and would be resumed by the Congolese delegation in Brussels upon its return. We understand that Adoula's position on transfer of portfolio under complete charge and administration of Congolese Government remains unchanged.

During the two years that Mr. Rafie has served in the Congo he has exhibited great comprehension and the Minister of National Economy, to whose Ministry he was posted, has expressed great satisfaction with his work.

Mr. Rafie has now completed his contract and is returning to Beirut. 



1. Reference attached cable from New York concerning Succar. I would like to let you know we have recommended the reclassification of Mr. Succar's post to P-5 level in the light of his responsibilities in his substantive post in the Bureau of Economic Coordination as the Chief of the Foreign Aid Section. The job description for this post, which has already been sent to New York would, I am sure, serve to indicate clearly that the responsibilities of the post justify the placing of the post at the P-5 level. Mr. Succar has carried out his functions at this post in an eminently satisfactory manner and I would like to recommend that Headquarters, New York, be urged to take early action to regrade the post and to place Mr. Succar at the P-5 level.

2. On account of the delay in the recruitment for the post of the Director of the Bureau, the Prime Minister has temporarily drafted him to carry out some of the functions of the Director of the Bureau. This is, however, a temporary arrangement and Mr. Succar will return to his post as Chief of the Foreign Aid Section as soon as the Director is appointed. However, the fact that the Prime Minister and the President of the Republic have approved of Mr. Succar's temporary nomination as Director of the Bureau is indicative of the confidence of the Government in his work.

3. As regards the question of payment of Mr. Succar's salary, I should like to let you know that I have had discussions on this subject on two separate occasions during visits to New York and have explained the position to the competent officials. I should like to add that Mr. Succar was first recruited for the Congo on an ONUC contract and was transferred from the post of Deputy Civilian Officer in Lulusburg to the Bureau of Economic Coordination in the interest of the United Nations. I therefore very much hope that the documentation submitted by Mr. Succar would be found acceptable for the payment of his salary in Lebanese currency if, in fact, the continuation of the original arrangements, on the basis of which he was recruited for service in ONUC, cannot be maintained for the duration of his service in the Congo.

To the Prime Minister

I have the honour to invite your attention to the fact that since the early days of the commencement of the United Nations technical assistance programme in the Congo, the Civilian Operations have maintained a small section within the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for the handling of foreign fellowships awarded both by the United Nations and under bilateral programmes.

However, with the promulgation of Ordinance 136 of 15 September, the Government of the Congo decided to incorporate the handling of all foreign fellowships for Congolese nationals within the organization of the Bureau of Economic Coordination. The Ministerial Decree of 20 October 1962 concerning the organization of the Bureau called for the creation of a Foreign Aid Section to assist in the coordination of requests for foreign experts and study scholarships and training programmes in collaboration with the Ministries concerned.

The Fellowship Section with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs consists of the following staff:

International	-	1 Programme Assistant
		2 Secretaries
Local	-	1 Clerk Typist

The United Nations has already appointed an officer in the Bureau of Economic Coordination for the coordination and handling of all foreign fellowships in accordance with the organizational plan for the staffing of the Bureau. In the circumstances the continued existence of the Fellowships Section in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs constitutes a duplication of effort and maintenance of staff above the actual needs. Since we are anxious to reduce the administrative costs of the technical assistance programme as much as possible I should like to request that the fellowship work be transferred as early as possible from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs to the Bureau of Economic Coordination. This would result in a saving of the cost of two international staff members out of three presently employed in the Ministry of Foreign Affairs since the work involved can be handled within the staffing provided for the Foreign Aid Section in the Bureau of Economic Coordination.

I have no doubt that any assistance which the Ministry of Foreign Affairs might need in the handling of inquiries which might be received by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs for foreign fellowships for Congolese nationals, would be handled by the Bureau by providing necessary aid to that Ministry through its own staff resources.

... I am transmitting to you herewith the form P.11 completed and signed by Mr. Mohamed Chafik Akhrass as requested by your cable 179.

I had an opportunity to interview Mr. Akhrass. He showed great interest in the position offered to him by the United Nations and he is inclined to accept it. However, he pointed out to me, that he has no intention to ask for leave of absence from his bank for a short period. If accepting the offer of the United Nations, he definitely wants to resign from the post he is holding now and build up a new career. For this reason, Mr. Akhrass would like to know what are the possibilities to continue his services with the United Nations after the assignment in the Congo comes to an end. He knows that no definite assurances can be given but nevertheless he would like to receive some indications as to what the prospects for continuing to work for the UN would be. The candidate is to-day close to 35 years old and has a family. He cannot therefore light-heartedly give up his career. In his situation he is interested in having a reasonable amount of security and stability especially as he would accept the position with UN not for the sake of making money but because he is interested in the work and in rendering a service.

I had a very good impression of Mr. Akhrass. He is a serious-minded and mature person. His background of economics and finance is very solid. Undoubtedly Mr. Akhrass devotes his entire energy and knowledge to the tasks which are entrusted to him. I certainly would not hesitate to recommend him.

1. Thank you for your memo dated 14 November concerning the expert posts to be filled in the Ministry of National Economy.

2. I have discussed this matter with Mr. D'Astagues and would like to make the following proposals:

(a) every effort should be made to find the best possible experts to fill the posts in the Office of Supply of the Ministry. The programme is gaining in importance with the devaluation of the Congolese franc and, in addition to the detailed work involved in the preparation of import quotas consideration would now have to be given to the reorganization of the entire supply programme of the country, both in the public and the private sector. All expert posts under this programme must therefore be recruited in the normal way through New York so as to be able to get the best possible person for each post;

(b) we should try to keep Ribo Cebrian on his post as long as possible subject, of course, to his personal problems, and the necessity for ensuring the availability of the TAB post for him when he leaves the Congo. In the meantime we should cable to New York asking them to advise us whether there were any candidates on their roster whom they could propose as a replacement for Ribo Cebrian, as a matter of urgency. The job description for the post is already with the Office of Personnel in New York;

(c) Mr. Rafie I understand must return to Lebanon for family reasons. He is, however, prepared to return to the Congo after two or three months and Mr. D'Astagues considers that in view of Rafie's experience, it would be desirable to obtain his reassignment after three months. Would you therefore kindly consider whether Rafie could be given special leave for this period which I hope could be reduced to two months. Alternatively he may be allowed to depart now and reappointed for a period of one year after he has settled his personal affairs;

(d) as regards Mr. Brisson, I should be grateful if you would ask Mr. DeCandia to arrange for him to be interviewed by Mr. D'Astugues to see whether he could be used as a temporary replacement either for Ribo Cebrian or Rafie, for the former until other candidates have been explored, and for the latter, during his absence on leave.

I refer to your memorandum dated 12 November 1963 informing me that Mr. Azzam is considered as a replacement for Mr. Rafie who is due to leave shortly and requesting that Mr. Azzam should not leave Leopoldville until a decision is taken in his case.

As I mentioned to you yesterday at the meeting we had with Mr. Seward, I have reviewed Mr. Azzam's file and I do not consider that his background would qualify him in the least for a post of such responsibility as Assistant to the Adviser on the Supply Programme in the Ministry of National Planning. Also it appears from Mr. Azzam's file that his performance in the Congo was not such as to encourage great expectations for the future.

You agreed that we should let Mr. Azzam leave the Congo and that you would consider any candidature for his post that would appear acceptable.

I got in touch with Mr. de Candia who suggested Mr. Brisson, a staff member in the Finance Office. However, Brisson is already considered as a possible replacement of Mr. Ribo-Cebrian. Should you need a second candidate with similar qualifications, we should be glad to make suggestions.
