SUBJ: SITREP NO. 005 FROM 041800 JUN TO 051800 JUN 95

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE SITUATION WAS RELATIVELY CALM THROUGHOUT THE SECTOR. THREE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED THROUGHOUT THE SECTOR. ONE INCIDENT WAS REPORTED THAT INVOLVED RPA SOLDIERS.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPA. ON THE NIGHT OF 3 JUN, IN BUGARAMA CITY (GR 9002) IT IS ALLEGED THAT RPA SOLDIERS HARASSED SOME LOCALS BY CLOSING THEIR SHOPS, BARS AND RESTAURANTS AT 1800 HRS INSTEAD OF THE NORMAL CLOSURE TIME OF 2000 HRS. THE RPA WENT FURTHER TO SOME HOUSES TO ASK THE IDENTITY OF THE LOCALS WHETHER THEY WERE HUTUS OR TUTSIS. IN VIEW OF THESE NEW DEVELOPMENTS, THE LOCALS HAVE EXPRESSED FEAR AND INSECURITY. THE MAIN CONCERN BEING THE IDEA OF IDENTIFYING THE LOCALS.

3. CIVIL AFFAIRS. NTR

4. OWN ACTIVITIES. THREE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD COVERED. HOWEVER, PATROLS WERE SHORTEN DUE TO HEAVY RAIN

- A. THE FIRST PATROL WAS CONDUCTED IN THE NYAMASHEKE SUB SECTOR. THE PATROL WAS CONFINED TO THE IMMEDIATE AREAS: KIRAMBO (GR 0444) AND KAGANO (GR 9840). SIT WAS FOUND CALM. NO INCIDENTS WERE REPORTED.
- B. A SECOND PATROL WAS DEPLOYED TO GIHUNDWE (GR 7925), NYAGATARE TRANSIT CAMP (GR 8125), RUSAMBO (GR 8030), NYAKAGAMO (GR 9336), RWAMAHWA (GR 9131), GASHURA (GR 8932), GAFUNZO (GR 8935), KAYATAMA (GR 8728) AND CYANGUGU PENINSULA NEAR RUSIZI I (GR 770 258). SIT WAS FOUND CALM.
- C. THE LAST PATROL WAS CONDUCTED ALONG THE ZAIRE/BURUNDI BORDERS. SIT WAS FOUND CALM.

5. HUMANITARIAN.

- A. REF SITREP 004, 4 JUN, EIGHT RETURNEES ARE TO BE ADDED TO THE TOTAL ALREADY REPORTED YESTERDAY. SO, A TOTAL OF 49 RETURNEES ARRIVED FROM BURUNDI (41) AND ZAIRE (8) YESTERDAY IN THE BUGARAMA SUB SECTOR. FIVE OF THEM TRAVELLED TO KIGALI BY TAXI TODAY.
- B. A TOTAL OF 39 RETURNEES WERE AT THE NYAGATARE TRANSIT CAMP TODAY.

C. THE HELP REP, DR MARTIN HEYDECK AND COLLEAGUES LEFT BUSHENGE HOSPITAL (GR 9031) ON 31 MAY. THE CAUSE FOR DEPARTURE IS THAT THE HELP STAFF THOUGHT THEIR LIFE WERE ENDANGERED BY CONTINUOUS HARASSMENT AND INTIMIDATION FROM ONE OF THE LOCAL DOCTORS AND FROM THE MEDICAL DIRECTOR OF CYANGUGU PREFECTURE. DR HEYDECK SUBMITTED A DEMISSION LETTER TO THE PREFET, TO THE RPA LIAISON OFFR AND TO THE MILOB SEC COMD EXPRESSING HIS FEARS. REPLACEMENT WAS EXPECTED, HOWEVER, NOBODY ARRIVED, LEAVING BUSHENGE HOSPITAL WITHOUT ANY HELP SUPPORT. A MILOB VISIT TODAY, ASSESSED THE SIT TO BE GOOD, AND ACCORDING TO THE ADMINISTRATION, THE DRUG SIT WAS ALSO GOOD AND THE TOTAL NUMBER OF BEDS OF 150 WAS ADEQUATE.

C D. RETURNEES FROM BURUNDI WERE INTERVIEWED ON 4 JUN, ON THE SITUATION INSIDE THE COUNTRY. THEY EXPRESSED THEIR FEELING THAT MOST REFUGEES WOULD LIKE TO RETURN HOME BUT THAT THEY HAD NO MONEY FOR TRANSPORTATION BACK TO RWANDA. THESE REFUGEES ARE CURRENTLY LOCATED APPROX 20 KM FROM THE BORDER.



SUBJ: SITREP NO. 004 FROM 031800 JUN TO 041800 JUN 95

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE SITUATION WAS RELATIVELY CALM THROUGHOUT THE SECTOR. HOWEVER, THE SIT IS BECOMING MORE UNSTABLE IN THE NYAMASHEKE SUB SECTOR DUE TO BANDITRY ACTIVITY IN MOST PART OF THE AREA. BANDITS COULD HAVE NOTICED THE RPA ROTATION THAT TOOK PLACE LATELY, THEREBY TAKEN ADVANTAGE OF THE SIT. THREE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED AND INCIDENTS TOOK PLACE IN THE AREAS OF MURAZA AND BUSHENKERI (NYAMASHEKE SUB SECTOR). THE SIT WAS FOUND NORMAL IN THE OTHER SUB SECTORS.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

- A. RPA. REF SITREP 002, 02 JUN, THE RPA TROOPS WHICH WERE SEEN MARCHING TOWARDS RUSIZI II WERE PART OF A ROTATION/STRENGTH INCREASE OF THE TROOPS. THE NUMBER OF SOLDIERS WAS 137 AS OPPOSE TO THE PREVIOUS 173 FIGURE REPORTED.

3. CIVIL AFFAIRS. THE ZAIRIAN BORDER IS STILL CLOSED FOR ZAIRIANS. HOWEVER, AT RUSIZI II, SOME ZAIRIANS ARE ALLOWED TO CROSS CARRYING CLOTHES MEANT TO BE SOLD IN RWANDA.

4. OWN ACTIVITIES. THREE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD COVERED:

- A. THE FIRST PATROL WAS CONDUCTED IN THE NYAMASHEKE SUB SECTOR. THE AREAS PATROLLED WERE NYAMASHEKE (GR 9841), KIRAMBO (GR 0444), MURAZA (GR 0745) AND MATABA (GR 0942). THE SITUATION WAS FOUND RELATIVELY UNSTABLE. ON 2 JUN, AT NIGHT, A BIG GROUP OF BANDITS CAME TO NYAMASHEKE (GR 984 416) IN A BIG BOAT WHICH THEY HID BY SINKING IT IN THE WATER (TECHNIQUE USED TO HIDE A BOAT WITHOUT MAKING IT UNSERVICEABLE). THEY THEN SPLIT INTO TWO GROUPS WHICH WENT, ONE TOWARDS KIRAMBO (GR 0444) AND ONE TOWARDS BUSHENKERI (GR 9832). NO ACTS OF BANDITRY WERE REPORTED, SO IT IS BELIEVED THE BANDITS HID FOR THE NIGHT IN THE ABOVE LOCS. THE STRENGTH OF THE GROUP IS UNKNOWN.

ON 3 JUN, ANOTHER GROUP CAME IN A SIMILAR BOAT AND HID IT AT THE SAME LOCATION. THE GROUP ALSO WENT TOWARDS BUSHENKERI, BUT RAN INTO AN RPA AMBUSH. TWO BANDITS WERE KILLED, ONE WAS WOUNDED AND CAPTURED. TWO WEAPONS WERE CAPTURED, ONE SUB MACHINE GUN AND ONE LIGHT MACHINE GUN. BOTH WEAPONS WERE OLD.

IN THE MEAN TIME, IN MURAZA (GR 0745), AT APPROX 2300 HRS A BIG GROUP OF ARMED BANDITS DRESSED IN UNIFORMS ROBBED MANY HOUSES OF HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND LIVE STOCKS. IN THE PROCESS OF DOING SO, THEY MACHETTED A MAN TO DEATH AND SHOT AND WOUNDED HIS 13 YEAR OLD SON. IT IS NOT YET ESTABLISHED IF IT WAS THE SAME GROUP REPORTED COMING ON 2 JUN. SEVERALS CATTLES WERE TAKEN ACROSS TO UWI IN MANY BOATS. THE STRENGTH OF THE GROUP IS UNKNOWN.

THE LOCAL RPA 2IC AND HIS OFFICERS VISITED NYAMASHEKE SUB SECTOR IN ORDER TO ASSESS THE DEPLOYMENT AND THE STRENGTH OF THEIR TROOPS AS WELL AS THE ABOVE MENTIONED INCIDENTS. THE GROUP WAS SEEN IN NYAMASHEKE (GR 9841) AND IN KIRAMBO (GR 0444).

- B. A SECOND PATROL WAS DEPLOYED TO GHEUNDWE (GR 7925), NYAGATARE TRANSIT CAMP (GR 8125), RUSIZI I (GR GR 7624) AND RUSIZI II (GR 7422). THE SIT WAS FOUND CALM.
- C. ANOTHER PATROL WAS CARRIED OUT IN AREA 4 ALONG THE ZAIRE/BURUNDI BORDERS IN THE BUGARAMA SUB SECTOR. THE SIT WAS FOUND CALM.

5. HUMANITARIAN.

- A. NO RETURNEES WENT THROUGH THE BORDER AT RUSIZI I AND RUSIZI II ON 3 JUN.
- B. 41 RETURNEES ARRIVED FROM THE ZAIRE/BURUNDI BORDERS IN THE BUGARAMA SUB SECTOR TODAY. THEY ARE CURRENTLY AWAITING TRANSPORTATION TO NYAGATARE TRANSIT CAMP.
- C. REF SITREP 001, 1 JUN, MDM PERSONNEL WORKING AT THE BUGARAMA HOSPITAL INDICATED THAT FOLLOWING THEIR COMPLAINT, THE LOCAL RPA COMD VISITED THEM AND ENSURED THEM THAT ACTION WOULD BE TAKEN TO STOP THE HARASSEMENT. NO INCIDENT OCCURRED SINCE.

A. THE 4C SEC COMD WAS INVITED BY THE NEW RPA BATT COMD TO BE INTRODUCED. THEY DISCUSSED SECURITY MATTERS AS WELL AS NGO ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE SECTOR. THE RPA LIAISON OFFR WAS ALSO PRESENT. RPA COMD EXPRESSED HIS WILLINGNESS TO MAINTAIN A CLOSE COOPERATION WITH THE MILOBS OF SEC 4C.

SUBJ: SITREP NO. 002 FROM 011800 JUN TO 021800 JUN 95

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE SITUATION WAS RELATIVELY CALM THROUGHOUT THE SECTOR. TWO PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED AND THE SITUATION WAS FOUND NORMAL IN ALL AREAS. NO INCIDENTS WERE REPORTED.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPA.

(1) REF SITREP 001 ON 01 JUN, THE SHOOTING HEARD ON 011715B JUN SUSPECTED TO BE BANDITRY ACTIVITY WAS IN FACT PRACTICE SHOOTING CARRIED OUT BY RPA SOLDIERS STATIONED IN THE AREA.

(2) TWO MEMBERS OF HUMAN RIGHTS WERE HELD FOR THREE HOURS AT THE RPA CHECKPOINT JUST BEFORE THE FOREST FOR NOT LETTING THE RPA SEARCHING THEIR DOCUMENTS. WHEN THEY FINALLY ACCEPTED, THEY WERE PHYSICALLY SEARCHED BY RPA. MILOBS AND HRL2 INTERVENTION WERE UNSUCCESSFUL. THE INCIDENT TOOK PLACE FROM 1000 TO 1300 TODAY.

3. CIVIL AFFAIRS. THE TOTAL POPULATION OF THE KARENGERA COMMUNE IS 57614 AS OF TODAY.

4. OWN ACTIVITIES. TWO PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD COVERED:

A. THE FIRST PATROL WAS CONDUCTED IN THE NYAMASHEKE SUB SECTOR. THE AREAS PATROLLED WERE KIRAMBO (GR 0444), KAGANO (GR 9840), GISAKURA (GR 9829) AND RWESERO (GR 9938). THE SITUATION WAS FOUND CALM.

B. A SECOND PATROL WAS SENT TO KARENGERA COMMUNE (GR 9321). THE FOLLOWING AREAS WERE COVERED: GIHUNDWE (GR 7925), GISUMA (GR 8526), BIGOTO (GR 8724), BUTARE (GR 9023), MWEZI (GR 9221), GIKO (GR 9027) AND NYAGATARE (GR 8125). THE SITUATION WAS FOUND CALM. HOWEVER ROAD ARE VERY SLIPPERY DUE TO THE HEAVY RAIN OF THE LAST DAYS.

(1) THE AUSTRALIAN HOSPITAL PERSONNEL FINISHED FUMIGATING ORPHANAGES, HOSPITALS, DISPENSARIES AND SOME ETHIOBATT POSITIONS TODAY. THERE ARE EXPECTED TO GO BACK TO KIGALI TOMORROW. THE HUMANITARIAN OFFICER WAS PRESENT AS WELL AS REP FROM MDM. A REPORT WILL BE SUBMITTED BY THE HUMANITARIAN OFFICER.

(2) ONE RETURNEE ARRIVED FROM ZAIRE IN THE BUGARAMA SUB SECTOR TODAY.

(3) AT NYAGATARE TRANSIT CAMP, THE STATISTICS ON ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES FOR THE LAST FEW DAYS ARE AS FOLLOW:

- (2) RPA ESTABLISHED A TEMPORARY CHECKPOINT AT GR 846 077
- (3) AN ACT OF BANDITRY WAS ATTEMPTED ON ISHARA PENINSULA (GR 0143), BUT FAILED DUE TO RPA INTERVENTION. EXCHANGE OF FIRE TOOK PLACE BUT THERE WAS NO CASUALTIES.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE SITUATION WAS RELATIVELY CALM THROUGHOUT THE SECTOR. THREE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED AND THE SITUATION WAS FOUND NORMAL IN ALL AREAS. THREE INCIDENTS WERE REPORTED IN THE NYAMASHEKE AND THE CYANGUGU SUB SECTORS. THE BORDER AT RUSIZI I AND II REMAINS CLOSED TO ZAIRIANS ON THE ZAIRE SIDE.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPA.

- (1) ON 27 MAY, AT GITWA CELLULE (GR 8434) IN THE CYANGUGU SUB SECTOR, A MAN WAS WALKING WITH HIS WIFE AND FIVE CHILDREN. WHEN ORDERED TO STOP BY RPA SOLDIERS, THE MAN REFUSED AND WAS SHOT DEAD IN HIS BACK. A 6 YEAR OLD CHILD WHO WAS BEING CARRIED ON THE MAN'S BACK WAS ALSO KILLED.

- (1) THE TANKER TRUCKS REPORTED AT SITREPS 4, 5, 7, 8 AND 21 ARE STILL WAITING TO GO THROUGH THE ZAIRIAN BORDER AT RUSIZI II.
- (2) THE BRIDGE OF MWITO (GR 853 344) IS DETERIORATING. MAINTENANCE ON THE ROAD HAS STARTED ON THE EASTERN SIDE OF THE BRIDGE.


4. OWN ACTIVITIES. THREE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED DURING THE PERIOD COVERED:

- A. THE FIRST PATROL WAS CONDUCTED IN THE NYAMASHEKE SUB SECTOR. THE AREAS PATROLLED WERE GATARE (GR 1245), ISHARA (GR 0044) AND PINDURA (GR 1326). SITUATION WAS FOUND NORMAL.
- B. THE SECOND PATROL WAS DEPLOYED IN THE CYANGUGU SUB SECTOR. TWO PRIMARY SCHOOLS FROM KAMEMBE COMMUNE WERE VISITED: CYIMBIGA (GR 833 330) AND RWAHI (GR 803 313)

(1) CYIBUMBA: 400 - 450 STUDENTS, 8 TEACHERS. MATERIAL REQUIRED: BOOKS, MAPS, PEN, NOTEBOOKS, BANKS, DESK

(2) RWAHI: APPROX 600 STUDENTS, 11 TEACHERS. MATERIAL REQUIRED: BOOKS, NOTEBOOKS, PENS

ALSO, REF TO SITREP 031, 31 APR (ACCIDENT BETWEEN AN IRC TANKER AND AN RPA VEHICLE), THE IRC STAFF AGREED TO PAY FOR THE REPAIR OF THE DAMAGED RPA TRUCK AS WELL AS THEIR OWN DAMAGES. THE RPA TRUCK HAS BEEN SENT TO A MECHANIC WORKSHOP FOR REPAIR.



C. THE THIRD PATROL WAS CONDUCTED IN THE BUGARAMA SUB SECTOR. AREA 5 WAS PATROLLED AS WELL AS THE MUKIBANGIRO SCHOOL (GR 8492) AND THE SITUATION WAS FOUND NORMAL. MEDECINS DU MONDE STAFF COMPLAINED TO THE MILOBS OF CONTINUOUS HARASSMENT BY RPA ELEMENTS AT THE HOSPITAL OF BUGARAMA CITY (GR 9907). 1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE SITUATION WAS RELATIVELY CALM THROUGHOUT THE SECTOR. THREE PATROLS WERE CONDUCTED AND THE SITUATION WAS FOUND NORMAL IN ALL AREAS. SOME INCIDENTS WERE REPORTED IN THE BUGARAMA AND NYAMASHEKE SUB SECTOR. THE BORDER AT RUSIZI I AND II REMAINS CLOSED.

THE AREA WAS FOUND NORMAL, HOWEVER, ONE INCIDENT WAS REPORTED. AT GASHESE OF MURAZA (GR 0646), ON 300200B MAY, A GROUP OF 30 ARMED BANDITS DRESSED IN MILITARY UNIFORMS, ROBBED SEVERA HOUSES OF THEIR COWS AND GOATS. ALSO, ANOTHER MAN WAS ROBBED OF HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND 600 000 FR. NO ONE WAS INJURED IN THE ATTACKS. ALSO IN THE NYAMASHEKE SUB SECTOR, BETWEEN 1030 AND 1230 TODAY WAS AN OFFICIAL BURIAL. THE CEREMONY WAS WELL ATTENDED BY THE LOCALS AND SOME DIGNITARIES. THE MILOBS WERE NOT FORMALLY INVITED.

- B. ONE PATROL WAS DEPLOYED IN THE CYANGUGU SUB SECTOR. THE PATROLS ARE NOW CONCENTRATED ALONG THE BORDER (RUSIZI I AND II) TO VERIFY AND CONFIRM THE ALLEGED REPORTS OF CONCENTRATION OF FRGF AND ZAIRIAN FORCES ALONG THE ZAIRE BORDER. ALL AREAS WERE FOUND CALM.
- THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION IS TO COMPLEMENT THE REPORT ON THE INCIDENT INVOLVING THE ARMED ATTACK ON A MEDECINS DU MONDE MEMBER. APPROX 5 MINUTES BEFORE THE ATTACK, A CAR OF IRC PASSED ON THE SAME LOCATION AND ALSO FOUND WOODEN LOGS ON THE ROAD BUT NOBODY WAS AROUND, SO THEY REMOVE THE OBSTACLES AND CARRIED ON. ALSO, TO THE CONTRARY OF WHAT WAS REPORTED YESTERDAY, THE MEMBER OF MDM WAS ORDERED OUT OF THE VEHICLE AND FORCED TO WALK SURROUNDED BY ARMED BANDITS WHILE THE VEHICLE WHICH STAYED PARKED WAS GUARDED BY ANOTHER BANDIT. THERE IS NO HARD EVIDENCE ON THE INTENTIONS OF THE BANDITS BUT IT COULD BE THAT THEY PLANNED TO KILL THAT PARTICULAR MEMBER OF MDM OR TO STEAL THAT PARTICULAR VEHICLE.
- C. THE THIRD PATROL WAS CONDUCTED IN THE BUGARAMA SUB SECTOR. AREAS 6 AND 16 WERE PATROLLED AND THE SITUATION WAS FOUND CALM, ALTHOUGH THERE WAS ONE INCIDENT REPORTED. IN KIBANGIRA (GR 9300), NEAR THE BORDERS, LOCALS REPORTED ONE PERSON GOT KILLED BY FIVE ARMED BANDITS DRESSED IN UNIFORMS. THE MURDER OCCURRED BETWEEN 282300 MAY AND 290300 MAY. THE REASONS OF THE KILLING ARE UNKNOWN, HOWEVER BANDITS STOLE SOME UNIDENTIFIED GOODS OF THE HOUSE. THE BANDITS ARE SUSPECTED TO COME FROM BURUNDI. THE TEAM WENT AS FAR AS RUGERA (GR 9718) BUT HAD TO COME BACK BECAUSE OF THE POOR ROAD CONDITION DUE TO THE WEATHER.

- C. OTHER. ON 22 MAY AT APPROXIMATELY 2100 HRS AT GISAGARA (GR 7912), BANDITS WITH WEAPONS STOLE FIVE COWS AND CROSSED THEM INTO ZAIRE. NO CASUALTIES REPORTED.

THE BANDITS SWAM TO SHORE TRYING NOT TO ATTRACT ATTENTION. NONETHELESS, THE BANDITS WERE SPOTTED BY AN RPA PATROL ON SHORE WHICH ENGAGED THE BANDITS WITH MACHINE GUN FIRE. CASUALTY COULD NOT BE DETERMINED BUT ON MORNING OF 14 MAY, A LARGE GROUP OF RPA SOLDIERS CORDONED OFF THE PENINSULA AND CONDUCTED A SWEEP OF THE PENINSULA WITH THE HELP OF LOCALS. BY AFTERNOON, ONE BANDIT HAD BEEN CAPTURED AND WAS IDENTIFIED AS AN INTERAHAMWE, NAME UNKNOWN, AND LIVED IN RWESERO SUB-PREFECTURE DURING THE GENOCIDE, AND WAS LIVING ON IJWI ISLAND.

THE BANDITS CAME BY BOAT ACROSS LAKE KIVU. THE RPA SOLDIERS FROM THE GAFANZO COMPANY (GR 898352) NOW PATROL THE AREA AT NIGHT.

(2) THE SECOND PATROL WAS CONDUCTED TO GAFUNE COMMUNE. THE ROUTE FOLLOWED WAS BUSHENGE (GR 8729), GAFUNZO (GR 9035) AND GAFUNZO HARBOUR (GR 9046). ALL ROADS WERE FOUND PASSABLE BUT A LITTLE SLIPPERY BECAUSE OF THE RAINY WEATHER. AT BUSHENGE HOSPITAL (GR 871299), THE RELATIONS BETWEEN RPA AND THE HOSPITAL STAFF HAVE BEEN NORMALIZED (REFER TO SITREPS NO. 032, 031) AND THE SEARCHES CONDUCTED BY THE RPA OF LOCAL STAFF APPEAR TO HAVE BEEN ORDERED BY THE LOCAL "INSPECTEUR DE POLICE JUDICIAIRE". AT KAGARAME (GR 9041), LOCALS ALLEGE THAT RPA ARE IMPRISONING MEN AND YOUNG ADULTS. THE RPA COMES AT NIGHT ABOUT TWICE A WEEK. THOSE PRISONERS HAVE NOT BEEN SEEN IN THE COMMUNE SINCE THEN. LOCALS HAVE ALSO ALLEGED THAT RPA HAS THREE DETENTION CENTRES WHERE DETAINEES ARE HELD: GAHABWA (GR 9142), BUGESA (GR 9245) AND

KAZIBO (GR 9340). IT IS ALLEGED PRISONERS ARE BEATEN AND SOMETIMES TORTURED IN THOSE DETENTION CENTRES.

- C. THE FOURTH PATROL WAS CONDUCTED IN THE BUGARAMA SUB SECTOR WHERE A TEAM CONDUCTED AN HELICOPTER RECONNAISSANCE OF AREA 4. FIVE LANDING ZONES WERE IDENTIFIED AND COORDINATES WILL BE GIVEN IN THE NEXT SITREP. ALSO, THE ETHIOBATT POSITION AT BUGARAMA (GR 8902) WAS VISITED THIS AFTERNOON AS WELL AS THE RWANDA-ZAIRE AND RWANDA-BURUNDI BORDERS. HE WAS NOT AWARE OF THE INCIDENT SINCE THE DETACHMENT INVOLVED IN THE SEARCHES BELONGS TO THE UNIT OF CAPTAIN RWANYANGA, LOCATED IN BUMAZI (GR 8928). THE PATROL RETURNED TO BUSHENGE HOSPITAL AND MET WITH DR HEYDECK. THE SITUATION HAS IMPROVED TO THE POINT WHERE THIS EPISODE IS CONSIDERED AN INTERNAL ADMINISTRATIVE MATTER. LT KARENGIRE APOLOGIZED FOR THE RECENT EVENTS.**

(3) **NYAGATARE TRANSIT CAMP. THE PATROL ARRIVED AT 1300 HRS AND NO EMPLOYEES WERE PRESENT.**

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE SECTOR IS RELATIVELY CALM. EXCHANGES OF FIRE OCCURRED BETWEEN RPA AND BANDITS ON LAKE KIVU AND ISHARA PENINSULA. IT WAS REPORTED THAT BANDITS WERE KILLED AND INJURED DURING THESE SKIRMISHES. REFER TO PARA 4 FOR DETAILS.

- (1) NO RPA PRESENCE WAS OBSERVED IN THE KARENGELA COMMUNE DURING THE PATROL BY SUB SECTOR CYANGUGU, AS REPORTED AT PARA 4.
- (2) NYAMASHEKE SUB SECTOR HAS REPORTED THAT ON FRI, 28 APR AT 1830 HRS A BOAT WAS SPOTTED APPROACHING GAFUNZO PENINSULA (GR 9444) FROM UWU ISLAND. AN HOUR LATER, TRACER BULLETS WERE OBSERVED FROM THE BOAT IN THE DIRECTION OF UWU ISLAND. TOWED IT FOR A SHORT DISTANCE, ABANDONING IT TO SINK. ON MORNING OF SAT, 29 APR A BOAT WAS OBSERVED STRANDED IN THE LAKE. THIS IS THE SECOND BOAT CAPTURED ON LAKE KIVU SINCE THE RPA STARTED THEIR BOAT PATROLS, AS STATED IN SITREP 029.

- (3) NYAMASHEKE SUB SECTOR REPORTED THAT ON ISHARA PENINSULA (GR 0144), SPORADIC EXCHANGES OF FIRE WERE HEARD BETWEEN 282000B AND 290200B APR. LOCALS STATED THAT BANDITS WERE KILLED AND INJURED DURING THE SKIRMISHES. DURING THE SAME PERIOD, SHOTS WERE ALSO HEARD ON UWU ISLAND AS IF FIRING RANGES WERE BEING CONDUCTED.

THEY WERE ACCOMPANIED BY THE SECTOR COMMANDER, LCOL JOUNITSYN. DR HEYDECK INFORMS US THAT DR CYRIDION, REGIONAL SANITARY DIRECTOR AT THE BUSHENGE HOSPITAL, IS INFORMED ON THIS WHOLE AFFAIR. SPECIFIC DETAILS WILL BE SUBMITTED IN THE NEXT SITREP.

THIS VISIT WAS VERY PRODUCTIVE AND CORDIAL WITH ALL PARTIES INVOLVED ALTHOUGH SOME TENSIONS WERE EVIDENT BETWEEN INDIVIDUALS OF BOTH COUNTRIES AT RUSIZI II, IN THE COURSE OF OUR SHORT VISIT. A VISIT TO THE RWANDA-BURUNDI BORDER IS SCHEDULED FOR SAT, 29 APR 95.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE SECTOR IS RELATIVELY CALM. HOWEVER, SEVERAL INCIDENTS HAVE BEEN REPORTED:

- A. THE NYAMASHEKE SUB-SECTOR IS GETTING MORE UNSTABLE AS BANDITS ARE MOUNTING MORE ATTACKS ON LOCAL POPULATION, TAKING ADVANTAGE OF THE MOONLESS NIGHTS. ON 262100B APR, IN KARIBA OF KININI SECTOR (GR 9535), A GROUP OF ARMED BANDITS ARRIVED IN 4 ROARING BOATS AND ROBBED 7 HOUSES WITHOUT OPPOSITION FROM THE INHABITANTS. ITEMS STOLEN INCLUDE BAGS OF COFFEE AND BEANS. THE BANDITS TRIED TO REITERATE THE FOLLOWING DAY IN ONE BIG BOAT, HOWEVER THE BANDITS GOT SPOTTED BY THE RPA PATROL BOAT RESULTING IN FIRING OF MACHINE GUNS AND THROWING OF GRENADES. ON MORNING OF 27 APR, 2 OF THE BANDITS WERE CAPTURED ALIVE BY LOCALS AND WERE HANDED IN TO THE RPA. ONE BANDIT HAD 2 BULLET WOUNDS IN HIS STOMACH. THE BANDITS ARE BEING HELD IN KIRAMBO PRISON (GR 0444). NYAMASHEKE SUB SECTOR COMMANDER WILL CHECK ON THEIR CONDITION.
- B. AN UNDISCLOSED NUMBER OF FAMILIES ARE SLEEPING AT NIGHT IN THE VICINITY OF THE RUSAYO ORPHANAGE (GR 8212) IN FEAR OF

BANDITS. THIS SITUATION HAS BEEN ONGOING FOR SEVERAL WEEKS NOW.

- C. TWO COWS HAVE BEEN REPORTED STOLEN ON 250500B APR IN KIRANSA (GR 8008). THE BANDITS ARE ALLEGED TO BE COMING FROM ZAIRE.
- D. THE KAMEMBE ORPHANAGE (GR 7928) IS CURRENTLY FACING FOOD SHORTAGE. ALTHOUGH THIS IS A LONG LASTING PROBLEM, THE SITUATION IS NOW DETERIORATING. A REQUEST HAS BEEN MADE FOR FOOD TO PAM AND TO THE RWANDESE GOVT, BUT WITHOUT SUCCESS.

- B. SECTOR COMD 4C RECEIVED THREE FAC SIMILES ON 27 APR, RECEIVED AT ETHIOBATT AT 1050B. THERE WAS NOT ENOUGH TIME FOR ADEQUATE ACTION. DUE TO THE REMOTNESS OF SECTOR 4C AND DISPERSION OF ITS ELMS, IT IS REQUESTED THAT FAX REQUIRING ACTION BE RECEIVED AT LEAST 48 HRS IN ADVANCE.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. REMAINS UNSTABLE BUT RELATIVELY CALM. ONE INCIDENT HAS BEEN REPORTED WHICH TOOK PLACE ON THE PREVIOUS NIGHT. IN MURAHU SECTOR (GR 778 292) AT 2130 HRS ON 24 APR, AN UNIDENTIFIED PERSON KNOCKED AT A HOUSE. THE INHABITANT DIDN'T OPEN THE DOOR WHICH RESULTED IN SOME SMALL ARMS FIRING AND 4 GRENADES BEING THROWN. 2 GRENADES EXPLODED AND 2 WERE RECOVERED BY THE RPA. THE FRAGMENTS INJURED A 17 YEAR OLD GIRL TO THE HEAD, BACK AND ARMS. THE VICTIM HAS BEEN EVACUATED TO THE HOSPITAL WHERE SHE HAS BEEN REPORTED IN STABLE CONDITION BY THE TEAM. BULLET HOLES HAVE BEEN OBSERVED ON THE DOOR OF THE HOUSE AS WELL AS SHATTERED RESPING SHEETS (RIPPLED ALUMINUM SHEETS) CAUSED BY GRENADE EXPLOSION ON THE ROOF. FURTHERMORE, APPROX 30 REFUGEES ARE STILL SLEEPING NEAR THE MILOB LOCATION IN NYAMASHEKE.

1. GENERAL SITUATION. REMAINS UNSTABLE BUT RELATIVELY CALM. THERE WERE THREE INCIDENTS REPORTED:

- A. THE FIRST OCCURRED IN BUGARAMA SUB SECTOR WERE FIVE BANDITS DRESSED IN MILITARY UNIFORM AND WEAPONS ROBBED A LOCAL IN GITAMBI (GR 8714) ON MON, 24 APR AT APPROX 2100 HRS AND LEFT WITH UNSPECIFIED AMOUNTS OF MONEY AND PROPERTY.
- B. THE SECOND INCIDENT IS A FOLLOW UP TO OUR VERBAL REPORT OF 25 APR AT 1230 HRS IN NYAMASHEKE SUB SECTOR. ON 24 APR BETWEEN 2200 HRS AND 25 APR 0100 HRS, A GROUP OF APPROX 20 BANDITS DRESSED IN MIL ATTIRE CAME TO NYAKABINGO (GR 0242) AND ROBBED SIX HOMES. THE GOODS INCLUDED: COFFEE, BEANS, GOATS AND NINE COWS. BANDITS HEADED FOR GASAYO (GR 9941) WHERE BOATS WERE WAITING FOR THEM. A SMALL PTL OF RPA AMBUSHED THE REAR ELMS OF THE BANDIT GROUP KILLING ONE BANDIT. THREE COWS WERE RECOVERED BY RPA. THE REMAINDER OF THE PROPERTY WAS LOADED ON THE WAITING BOATS AND TAKEN ACROSS TO ZAIRE. THE MAN KNOWN AS KABERA WAS CONFIRMED TO HAVE BEEN WITH THE BANDITS.

- C. THE THIRD INCIDENT OCCURRED ON ISHARA PENINSULA (GR 0044) ON 24 APR AT 2300 HRS. A GROUP OF BANDITS ROBBED A HOME OF TWO COWS AND SOME HOUSEHOLD GOODS. THE GROUP IS ALLEGED TO COME FROM UWI ISLAND.
- D. LOCALS IN NYAMASHEKE AREA CONTINUE TO SEEK PROTECTION AT THE RESIDENCE OF MILOBS AT NIGHT. LOCALS FEEL THEIR SECURITY IS STILL THREATENED, REGARDLESS OF INCREASED ETHIOBAT PRESENCE. EFFORTS WILL BE MADE BY SUB SECTOR COMMANDER TO REASSURE THE LOCALS WITH HELP OF NEW ETHIOBAT COMMANDER.

EXCHANGE OF FIRE WAS HEARD BUT IT WAS IMPOSSIBLE TO DETERMINE GR. ENGAGEMENT WAS WEST OF ISHARA PENINSULA AND BRIEF. ELMS UNKNOWN AND QUICKLY DISPERSED. ALSO LOCALS - APPROX 43 PERS - IN NYAMASHEKE AREA STILL CONTINUE TO SEEK PROTECTION AT THE RESIDENCE OF MILOBS AT NIGHT.

SUBJ: SITREP NO. 024 FROM 211800 APR TO 221800 APR 95

1. GENERAL SITUATION. GEN REMAINS UNSTABLE BUT RELATIVELY CALM. HOWEVER THERE WERE TWO SHOOTING INCIDENTS ON ISHARA PENINSULA (GR 0044) ON 21 APR 95 AT 2230 HRS AND AT KAVUNE (GR 9840) TODAY AT 0250 HRS. DETAILS NOT IMMEDIATELY AVAILABLE DUE TO LACK OF MOBILITY. ALSO LOCALS IN NYAMASHEKE AREA STILL CONTINUE TO SEEK PROTECTION AT THE RESIDENCE OF MILOBS AT NIGHT.

A. PATROLS WERE DONE IN AREA OF RESP. SIT IN ALL AREAS PATROLLED WERE FOUND NORMAL.

5. HUMANITARIAN.

A. SEEDS FOR PLANTING. LACK OF SEEDS FOR PLANTING IN KAMEMBE COMMUNE (GR 8131). BURGEMEISTRE COMPLAINED TO MILOBS ABOUT SITUATION AND ASKED FOR ASSISTANCE. SEEDS NORMALLY SUPPLIED BY WFP TO LOCALS.

B. NYAMASHEKE ORPHANAGE. GERMAN EMERGENCY DOCTORS AT NYAMASHEKE ORPHANAGE (GR 9941) COMPLAIN ABOUT PERSISTENT SHORTAGE OF WATER AND LACK OF LATRINES POSING SERIOUS HEALTH HAZARD AT ORPHANAGE. ALSO ORPHANS EXPOSED TO MOSQUITO BITES LEADING TO HIGH INCIDENCE OF MALARIA DUE TO ABSENCE OF LOUVRES IN WINDOWS. PRESENT ACCN ALSO LIKELY TO BE TAKEN OVER SINCE ORIGINALLY A PRIMARY SCHOOL. ORPHANAGE ALSO FACES PROBLEM OF REHABILITATING GROWN-UP MEMBERS OF AGE 15 AND ABOVE SINCE NO KNOWN RELATIVES OR PLACE TO SEND THEM.

Bugarama team patrolled Burundi and Zaire borders and found situation calm.

2 - Factional activities - A) RPA - NTR

A) One team patrolled Kirambo (GR 0444) and Ishara (GR 0144) and situation was found normal and calm.

B) Bugarama team was informed this morning, 0900h, by a local about an unexploded grenade found close to his house. This hand grenade was found last night in Nyabishungu (GR. 905.134). Local in the area claims that RPA throw grenades into the houses and also chastened through the windows with small fire arms. Patrol team found 17 empty ammunition outside the houses and also bullets, and grenade shrapnel marks on the roof and walls of the two houses.

Locals on the area are very frightened of RPA activities.

A). There are 19 refugees present in Bugarama city awaiting for transportation - UNHCR - Imp'd.

SUBJ: SITREP NO 018 FROM 151800 APR TO 161800 APR 95

1. GENERAL SITUATION. THE GEN SIT REMAINS UNSTABLE WITH THE RE-OCCURRING OF BANDITRY, ROBBERY AND KILLINGS IN NYAMASHEKE AREA AFTER A SHORT PERIOD OF RELATIVELY CALMNESS DURING THE LAST WEEK AND A SERIOUS INCIDENT IN BUGARAMA AREA.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES.

A. RPA. REF SITREP-NO 017 PARA 1: BUGARAMA - INCIDENT

ON 14 APR 95 1930 HRS 2 MEN, 1 WOMAN AND 1 A BOY (APPROX 7 YEARS OLD) CAME TO MILOB LOC. THEY WERE AFRAID OF BEING KILLED BY RPA. NAMES: a): MR NAHIMAN ZAKAI

b): MR HABERIMAN

THEY REPORTED TO MILOBS THAT THE SAME DAY AT APPROX 1500 HRS 17 MEN WERE KILLED BY RPA IN NYABISHUNGU AREA GR 9112. ON 15 APR 95 0730 HRS 1 MAN (NAME: NIYWUZIYAREMYE PAPIAS - FRENCH SPEAKING) CAME TO MILOBS LOC AND INF'D THEM THAT ON 14 APR 95 AT 1100 - 1230 HRS 8 BANDITS ATTACKED 2 RPA SOLDIERS IN NYABISHUNGU AREA, 1 RPA SOLDIER WAS KILLED, 1 WAS WOUNDED. THAT RPA SOLDIER INF'D HIS COMRADES ABOUT THIS INCIDENT. THE SAME DAY BETWEEN 1300 AND 1530 HRS APPROX 20 RPA SOLDIERS CAME TO NYABISHUNGU AREA, TAKING 17 MEN (LOCAL CIVILIANS) FROM THE ROAD, BROUGHT THEM TO THE BANK OF RUBYIRO RIVER (IN NYABISHUNGU AREA) AND SHOT THEM ALL (IN FACT 16). ALSO HE TOLD MILOBS THAT 1 OUT OF THIS 17 WAS JUST WOUNDED MIMING DEAD AND LATER CAME TO MASHESHA HOSPITAL GR 895133. HIS NAME: NTAWUMEN NYAMUNS, AGE: 19 YEARS, FARMER FROM NYABISHUNGO.

MILOBS INVESTIGATED TO PROOF THIS STATEMENT AND FOUND THIS MAN IN MASHESHI HOSPITAL WHO TESTIFIED THIS STATEMENT AS A VICTIM. HE IS WOUNDED BY SEVERAL BULLETS IN BOTH ARMS.

AFTERWARDS MILOB TEAM WENT WITH ONE LOCAL BOY TO THE DISCRIBED PLACE OF THE ALLEGED KILLINGS AND FOUND 16 DEAD BODIES - FRESH AND W/O SMELL OF PUTREFACTION - ON THE RIVER BANK OF RIVER RUBYIRO GR 9112 APPROX 2 KMS EAST OF THE VILLAGE NYABISHUNGO.

MILOB TEAM-MEMBER TOOK PHOTOS OF THESE VICTIMS WITH HIS PRIVATE CAMERA - PHOTOS WILL BE PROVIDED AFTER BEING DEVELOPED. ALSO THEY FOUND SOME AMMUNITION OF "AK-47" - SAMPLES ARE AT THIS HQ AVAILABLE.

ON THEIR WAY BACK THEY MET 5 RPA SOLDIERS WITH 1 RPA OFFR (CAPT) AND THE BURGERMASTER OF BUGARAMA PROCEEDING IN DIRECTION OF THE KILLING GROUND. MILOBS SPOKE WITH THEM NOT MENTIONING ANYTHING ABOUT THEIR FINDINGS BUT THEY UNDERSTOOD THAT MILOBS KNEW EVERYTHING.

ON 15 APR 95 AFTERNOON 1 LOCAL MAN (NAME: NTUYIMONSO) CAME TO MILOB LOC AND INF'D THEM THAT RPA PUT 5 MEN IN PRISON - AMONG THEM THEIR VISITORS FROM THE DAY BEFORE PLUS THE MAN WHO REPORTED THE DETAILS THAT MORNING (MR NIYWUZIYAREMYE PAPIAS) PLUS 1 LOCAL (NAME: FIL BUKURU) WHO TOLD THEM SOME NAMES OF VICTIMS.

NAMES OF VICTIMS: NGARISI, PASCAL, MARC, FAIDA.

REMARKS: THE ONLY SURVIVOR AND EYEWITNESS OF THIS EVENT IS AT PRESENT AT MASHESHE HOSPITAL WITHOUT ANY PROTECTION. IT IS SUPPOSED THAT RPA DONT KNOW ABOUT HIS EXISTENCE UP TO NOW.

HUMAN RIGHT-TEAM WAS INF'D PERSONALLY ABOUT THIS FACTS AND ASKED TO STUDY POSSIBILITIES TO PROTECT THIS WITNESS AND IN ADDITION TO TAKE CARE ABOUT THE IMPRISONED PERSONS.

ALSO ETHIOBATT WAS INF'D ABOUT THIS INCIDENT AND ASKED TO INCREASE THEIR PATROLLING IN THIS AREA.

MILOBS IN BUGARAMA EXPRESSED THEIR CONCERN ABOUT THE WITHDRAWAL OF ETHIOBATT-TROOPS FROM NYABISHUNGU AREA SOME TIME AGO WITHOUT ANY INFORMATION ABOUT THE BACKGROUND.

THE NEAREST TROOPS TO THEIR LOC ARE APPROX 23 KMS AWAY WHICH MEANS A 1 HOUR DRIVE.

THERE ARE PATROLS CONDUCTED BY ETHIOBATT ABOUT TWICE A WEEK WHICH IS CONSIDERED TO BE TOO LESS BY MILOBS ON THE SPOT.

THERE WILL BE A DISCUSSION ABOUT THIS MATTER WITH CO ETHIOBATT ASAP.

CONCLUSION: IT SEEMS TO BE AN ACT OF REVENGE EXECUTED BY RPA. THERE ARE NO INFORMATIONS AVAILABLE AT THE MOMENT WHO THE BANDITS WERE AND WHERE THEY CAME FROM NOR THE REASON OF ATTACK ON THE 2 RPA SOLDIERS BY THEM.

MILOBS DID NOT CONTINUE INVESTIGATIONS AMONG CIV POPULATION IN RESPECT OF THEIR SECURITY.

HOWEVER, MILOB TEAM WAS ADVISED TO CONTACT THE BURGERMASTER OF BUGARAMA AND RPA CDR TO RECEIVE AN OFFICIAL STATEMENT ON THIS MATTER.

SINCE THIS IS THE FIRST SERIOUS INCIDENT IN THIS AREA INVOLVING BANDITS AND RPA KILLING CIVILIANS FOR A LONG TIME MILOBS WERE ALSO ADVISED TO MONITOR THIS DEVELOPMENT WITH PARTICULARLY ATTENTION.

AA. SINCE THE BEGINNING OF THIS WEEK THERE ARE APPROX 15 RPA SOLDIERS DEPLOYED TO CIMERWA CEMENT FACTORY OBVIOUSLY TO PROVIDE SECURITY TO THE FACTORY AND THE PRISON NEXT TO IT. IT IS ASSUMED (NO PROOF UP TO NOW) THAT THE ABOVE MENTIONED ACT WAS EXECUTED BY THIS GROUP.

C. OTHER. ON 15 APR 95 AT 2000 HRS APPROX 25 PERS SHOWED UP AT MILOB LOC IN NYAMASHEKE AND SOUGHT PROTECTION BECAUSE THEY WERE AFRAID OF BEING ATTACKED DURING THE NIGHT.

AT 2200 HRS MILOBS REPORTED FIRING OF SMALL ARMS FOR ABOUT 15 MIN AND DETONATION OF 3 GRENADES IN DIR TO LAKE KIVU.

INVESTIGATIONS THIS MORNING DISCOVERED THAT BANDITS FROM THE ISLAND OF IJWI HAVE LANDED WITH 3 BOATS. 2 BOATS LANDED AT KIVUNE AREA GR 9840, 1 BOAT LANDED AT MURWA AREA GR 9841. IN KAVUNE THE BANDITS ROBBED 2 HOUSES AND STOLE ALL HOUSEHOLD GOODS. LOCALS REP TO ETHIOBATT AND RPA. RPA DISPATCHED AN ARMED BODY TO THE SHORE. AT ABOUT 2200 HRS A SKIRMISH BETWEEN RPA AND BANDITS WITH SMALL ARMS FIRE TOOK PLACE GR 9840. 1 RPA SOLDIER WAS WOUNDED.

1 GROUP OF BANDITS ESCAPED BY BOAT TO IJWI. 1 GROUP OF BANDITS PASSED MILOB LOC IN DIR TO NYAMASHEKE. IT IS ASSUMED THAT BANDITS ARE STILL THERE HIDING IN NYAMASHEKE AREA.

ETHIOBATT FOUND 1 SMALL BOAT AT MURWA GR 9841 AT 2200 HRS

ON 16 APR 95 0900 HRS AN ETHIOBATT PATROL PICKED UP 2 BOYS AND DETAINED THEM. THE DETAILS ARE:

A) MUCHESHIMANA SABJEMUNGU, 16 YEARS OLD

B) NACHIRETE ANACRETE, 13 YEARS OLD.

THEY WERE FOUND SWIMMING IN KIVU LAKE TOWARDS IJWI AT GR 9942.

AT PRESENT THEY ARE WITH ETHIOBATT IN CUSTODY. ETHIOBATT IS WAITING FOR FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS.

3. **CIVIL AFFAIRS.** SECCDR AND HUM OFFR ATTENDED CEREMONIES CARRIED OUT IN MBILIZI GR 821-161 IN REMEMBRANCE OF THE VICTIMS OF THE GENOCIDE. PRIME MINISTER AND MINSTERS OF INTERIOR AND JUSTICE ALSO ATTENDED DIFFERENT CEREMONIES. THEY CAME BY UN HELI BUT ONLY THE MINISTER OF INTERIOR HAD THE DEFERENCE OF ANSWERING THE SALUTE OF MILOBS BY SHAKING THEIR HANDS BUT THE OTHER MINISTERS AND THEIR ENTOURAGE IGNORED THEM. THE POPULATION INSTEAD HAD A FRIENDLY ATTITUDE TO MILOBS LIKE RPA. THE CEREMONIES WERE COLORFUL AND ATTENDED BY ABOUT 2000 PERSONS AND CARRIED OUT WITH NORMALITY. THE PROGRAM SCHEDULED FROM 0900 TO 1400 HRS WAS EXTENDED UNTILL 1645 HRS.

4. **OWN ACTIVITIES.**

A) PATROLS WERE CARRIED OUT IN AREA OF RESP. SIT WAS FOUND NORMAL AND CALM (AS USUAL DURING DAYTIME).

B) CYANGUGU SUBSEC-TEAM WAS REQUESTED TO MONITOR THE ETHIOBATT ROTATION BY AEROPLANE FROM 1430 TO 1730 HRS AT KAMEMBE AERODROME WHICH IN THE END COULD NOT BE EXECUTED DUE TO A LACK IN TECHNICAL DEVICES AND THE ABSENCE OF THE AERODROME AUTHORITIES.

5. **HUMANITARIAN.** SECCDR AND HUM OFFR WILL ATTEND EASTER CELEBRATIONS ON 16 APR 95 AT 1900 HRS AT MISERICORDE ORPHANAGE. A GROUP OF 30 ORPHANS FROM THE SAME PLACE AND THEIR CHORUS PARTICIPATED IN THE MBILIZI CEREMONIES THE SAME DAY.
