MANY SOLDIERS FROM STANLEYVILLE AREA EXPECTED TO DESERT AND RETURN HOME. Even such a humanitarian mission as that referred to above can produce to UNations considerable embarrassment and place us in a very difficult position.

1. I am sure that you will remind all concerned that evacuation ~~is~~ on instructions repeat instructions of Sec Gen supported by instructions of Directors General of Agencies. Such instructions were given following careful discussions in Leo at which all chiefs of missions, without exception, approved the action.
2. Reasons you give are very similar to those given by some experts in Albertville, Stan and Bukavu up to last few days before evacuations which in Albertville case came too late to move experts and families.
3. In current Congo circumstances it is essential precautions be taken deliberately and in good time. In particular dependents must be moved before any question of near risk arises. Day to day changes of military fortune are irrelevant to such considerations.
4. I have carefully considered in your para. three but I do not believe such views could lead us to upset basic instructions.
5. Question remains therefore one of timing. Object is to accomplish evacuation dependents by 31 August but if there are circumstances in individual cases which would warrant some delay in departure the expert concerned should cable his mission chief and with copy my info. You should cable your comments on case to me.
6. I would ~~xxxxix~~ consider for example medical reasons or reasons given your para. 2 DDD but with much shorter time. Argument based on general political situation would not be acceptable.
7. Glad discuss this question by SSB if ~~tax~~ it would help you.
8. If, however, some experts chose not to send his family away you should ask him to note this in a letter which would confirm he understood that he was following such a course entirely at his own risk. I should take official notice of such a decision taken after receipt of an instruction.

1. Discussions with Director of mechanisation have resulted in following procedure being laid down in connection with acquisition of vehicles by Provincial Authorities:  
AAA) Authorities may inspect and determine requirements;  
BBB) Formal application to purchase must be submitted to Chief Purchasing and Supply Section;  
CCC) Chief Purchasing and Supply Section will have application approved by Director of Mechanisation and will confirm agreement to sell.  
DDD) Applications must not be submitted through a United Nations TAB Agency. In the interests of speed advise Provincial Government Authorities that all correspondence relating to such applications must be hand carried between offices otherwise undue delay will result in disposal being effected without regard for outstanding applications.
2. Request by Minister of Education (through UNESCO) being referred to Director of Mechanisation for approval.
3. Director of Mechanisation instructing Mr. Wilson of Service Mechanisation Elisabethville to have residual vehicles inspected to determine whether Central Government has any requirement.
