Review, in B-1683-4, of background leading to Kitona episode of thirteenth and fourteenth is very helpful and particularly as indicating lines your own thinking.

Basic principles applying to the two bases, their installations and supplies, are as set forth in my third report to Security Council (S/4475). Thus U.N., as a provisional measure in sense of article 40 of Charter, has assumed temporary responsibility for administration of Kitona, acting as "caretaker" for all legitimate interests involved in accordance with recognized principles of law." This has relevance to question of arms and ammunition raised in para onezero of B-1684. It is noted from B-1686 that while Kitona has large supplies of ammunition, gasoline and vehicles, the supply of arms fortunately seems not to be substantial.

Safeguarding of arms and ammunition stores at Kitona by adequate U.N. security measures is an action consistent with our caretaker role. ANC claim to ownership of such material, supported by belgians, would at least have raised some delicate questions about removal and/or requisitioning by U.N. Our requisitioning claim seems to have received little recognition at Kamina. On basis all circumstances, I concur

1. In letter to me of 9 September Belgian Mission states "The men remaining at Kitona are technicians, together with a group of Airfield Guards. The latter are ready for their departure, which is to take place immediately upon the arrival of United Nations troops capable of taking over this duty. Perhaps that arrival will already have taken place by the time you receive this letter. The Belgian Government hopes for assistance from the United Nations in evacuating the men as quickly as possible. Any technicians whose activity was considered, in agreement with the representative of United Nations, not to be essential would also be evacuated. The number of men needed will have to be determined on the spot".

2. We have advised Belgian Mission to make request for airlift direct to United States in order to use planes bringing in Indian hospital unit. We are supporting this request to the United States.

3. We assume that the group of Airfield Guards can be taken out immediately in light of your B 839. With respect to the "Technicians" you will note the Belgian statement that all will be evacuated except those considered essential in agreement with representatives of Nations. In light of this please make urgent determination as to number, if any, temporarily needed. Please then inform senior Belgian representative at base that all the rest should go as soon as transport is arranged between the Belgians and the United States Air Force. Please notify us as the number to be airlifted so that we can coordinate with Air Force this end.
