As you have taken the trouble to send me your letter dated Oct. 1st. and received by me on Dec. 15th., I draw the inference, that OTC is not fully informed about my final report.

Following unanimous instructions from the Lesotho Government and the former Res. Rep. my final stencilled report was submitted as a restricted project report to the Government around May 1st. The report was authorized for printing by the Ministry of Works at the end of May.

On May 30th. I handed over 7 stencilled copies (plus one set of 43 drawings) to the Res. Rep. in accordance with Guide for Experts and made the optimistic statement that printed copies would be available in about a months time. (Copy of my letter of May 30th. to Res. Rep. enclosed).

1. TECHNICALITIES

a) Overall Dimensions:

Internal length	6796 mm

b) Main Structure & Chassis:

The main structure will be built according to our standard specification as enclosed, save and except for the following points:

- The body will be fitted on an accepted roadworthy 5 ton capacity twin axle chassis.


