Dear Mr. Eveleigh:

Thank you for your replies and for the signature which you kindly forwarded to us.

In reply to your letter of 18 July, we have further problems in connection with the publication of your poster which we would like to discuss with you. In the light of your opinion concerning the border, we have an alternative suggestion which you might prefer.

We feel, however, we should point out that our only reason for suggesting this is that the general opinion of our experts, as well as that of the majority of those who have seen the poster on exhibition in the Delegates Lounge here, is that while the idea is excellent, its presentation is not sufficiently strong.

In consultation with the Jury, it was agreed that while we naturally submitted to their decision and heartily approved their choices, we should undertake to smooth out with the artists concerned any technical difficulties which might arise, inasmuch as the United Nations would be responsible for the production and presentation of the poster.

The alternative we would suggest, therefore, would be to enlarge slightly each leaf of the tree, thereby giving the poster the necessary carrying power.

Besides this, we are informed by the printers that the art work is technically unsatisfactory for reproduction where the photographs of the two hands are faded into the white background, and that the line of demarcation will be clearly visible in print. This, we are sure you will agree, would be most unfortunate, and it may be necessary to ask you to execute once again, on a separate underlay, the photographs of the hands and the air brushing needed to denote their gradual disappearance into the background. This point is still under discussion and we may be able to avoid having to ask you to do this, but will let you know the final decision.

These suggestions are only prompted by our desire to see your very interesting design presented to the best possible

advantage for world-wide distribution and acclaim, and it seems to us especially important to consider the effect because we shall be producing the poster in more than one size.

Would you be kind enough, therefore, to consider whether you feel that the strengthening of the scale of the "flag leaves" would be sufficient to achieve the desired effect, and whether you prefer this solution to the idea of the border?

We gather from the last paragraph of your letter that you may be coming to New York. In case it is necessary to re-execute the photographs of the hands, would it be possible for you to do this work here, for if you are going on vacation, we foresee great difficulty in getting the poster published in time for the General Assembly, owing to these necessary alterations.

As we have heard from Mr. Dair, graciously suggesting that the studio would be most happy to make your services available to us, we thought that this might solve the problem of speed. May we have your reply to this at your earliest convenience?

## UVM to Back Roadside Stand Program Of Visualizing International Relations

Pres. Millis to Foster Idea Conceived  
And Developed by a Former Local Woman

The University of Vermont yesterday placed itself in the forefront of a project to visualize international relations through establishing country-wide roadside stands to display visual educational material on the United Nations—an idea conceived and developed by Mrs. Esther Tabor Fox of Cambridge, Mass., a former resident of Burlington.

UVM Pres. John S. Millis said he plans to help the project further by contacting persons in other states and encouraging them to support "We the Peoples" roadside stands.

According to Mrs. Fox, the Vermont Chamber of Commerce will co-operate in the erection of a stand in Vermont, probably before August.

Such a stand, if built, would be the second in the country, the first being in a tent on route 16 at Conway, N. H. These stands, Mrs. Fox explained, could be operated by disabled veterans and would finance themselves through sale of visual education material on the United Nations prepared by Mrs. Fox.

In developing the project, Mrs. Fox has received co-operation from United Nations officials, the Emergency Committee of Atomic Scientists and other interested groups. However, the direction of the work is done by Mrs. Fox, who describes herself as an international economist.

### Tells How It Began

"The work of visualization of international relations took concrete form at the Henry Street Settlement in New York city where the entire settlement co-operated to show how, in music, drama, moving pictures and dimensional exhibits, the people of the world are one in trying to establish world peace through the United Nations," Mrs. Fox said.

"The idea of a 'We the Peoples' roadside stand, where the vacationing citizen could stop and see, ask questions and give ideas, grew out of it," she added.

The primary object of the blueprint charts for bulletin boards and charts for notebooks is to make international relations understandable. "The stands should give the background of international relations together with actual products made in a community, showing their export and import relationship," Mrs. Fox said.

She also commented that the stands should show what the war did and how the people of the United States can help other peoples.

To operate the stands, Mrs. Fox estimated \$750 would be needed.

Mrs. Fox lived in Burlington on North Prospect st. more than 40 years ago. She moved to Chicago where she did social work, then married and moved to Pittsburgh. Three years ago, she began working on her current project.

By September she hopes to have a roadside stand in every state.

In reply to your letter of 28 March 1947, in which you stated that the Department of Public Information of the United Nations was organizing a competition amongst the professional artists in all Member countries, and requested my co-operation in the appointment of a Committee of Experts to publicize the contest in this country, I am pleased to inform you that the text of your letter, the rules of the competition and the copy of the Preamble to the Charter of the United Nations have been sent to the Directorate of Artistic Education and the Promotion of Culture of the Ministry of Public Education. Future correspondence should be addressed to that Directorate, which is the body officially in charge of all artistic competitions.

Sir,

The Department of Public Information is now organizing the first in a series of "Poster of the Year" competitions to encourage professional artists in all Member countries to submit designs for a poster bearing a suitable slogan and portraying some aspect of the aims and principles of the United Nations. The best poster submitted will be adopted by the United Nations for official use.

The Secretary-General is informing all Members of the United Nations about this competition, and I have discussed with Mr. Chauncey J. Hamlin, President of the International Museums, the suggestion that in certain countries the national branches of the Council should be asked to appoint small committees to conduct the contest. Mr. Hamlin expressed the view that the chairmen of such branches of the Council would be willing to assist the Department of Public Information in this way.

Accordingly, I am writing to enquire whether you will be so good as to appoint a small committee of experts to publicize the contest in your country and to select the three best entries submitted. Decisions should be based both on the artistic merit of the posters and on the messages they convey. The three posters selected are to be sent to the Headquarters of the United Nations where an international panel of judges will make the final awards. The selected entries should be addressed to the Department of Public Information, the United Nations, Lake Success, New York, U.S.A., and should be marked "For the attention of Mr. Jean Benoit-Levy".

Since it is planned to issue the winning poster during the second session of the General Assembly this September, and in view of the time required for printing and distribution, I would ask you to point out to such a committee that the three posters selected should be forwarded



in time to reach Lake Success on or before 1 July 1947. I regret that it will be necessary to disqualify any posters arriving after that date.

I enclose herein a copy of the rules of the competition, which is limited to professional artists, and a copy of the Preamble to the Charter of the United Nations, which may serve as a source of inspiration to the competitors.

The United Nations will refund by international money order the costs of duplicating the rules of the contest, of mailing these to professional artists and artists' associations, and of sending the selected posters to Lake Success, up to a maximum of sixty dollars (\$60.00). However, since the funds allotted for the contest are necessarily limited, it is hoped that such expenses will be kept as small as possible.

In conclusion, I wish to assure you that I shall sincerely appreciate the assistance which you will render in ensuring that as large a number of artists from your country as possible take part in this competition.
