Subject: Sitrep No 25/11

1. General Security in the Sector

The security situation within the prefecture is not all safe. From the month of September until now, we have witnessed 5 land mines of both anti tank and anti person's explosions causing the death of innocent persons and leaving many others in a permanent state of disability. Not forgetting the anti tank mines which were laid on one of the main patrol roads, Kabaya-Ngororero-Kibilira and then were removed before they could cause any harm. It is still anticipated that, many others have been laid and therefore timing for the daily patrol has been pegged between 09.30 hrs and 15.00 hrs. With the capture of Ile by the RPA it is suspected that, the incessant raids by the infiltrators would be minimized. Further it is reported that the acts of banditry is on increase.

The RPA LO has indicated on 30/10/95 that a second cordon and search operation in the Gishwati Forest is continuing due to the last mine incidents and infiltrations from Zaire. The RPA are sweeping from the west and south however the going is difficult. During the first sweeping

as reported the RPA have had some limited success consist of finding some caches of military equipment such as rucksacks, grenades and some anti-pers mines. CPMT held discussions with RPA L.O. on 09/11/95 who confirmed that the sweeping in Gishwati Forest is going to be permanent.

2. Reconciliation/Rehabilitation

A promotion and education course has been held during the past week at 3 communes/sectors in the prefecture by Human Rights for local authorities, especially for

- Civilian authorities such as bourgermestres, sub-Prefects, assistants and counsellors

- Military authorities

- Communal Police and

- Population generally. Subjects of the course have been:

- The Mandate of Human Rights

- The concept of Human Rights and United Nations

- The international instruments of Human Rights and the agreement with Rwandan Government.

- The procedures of arrests and detention .

- The mechanism of protection by Human Rights.

This course will be held 2 - 3 times a week in several communes/sectors to provide a climate of confidence and trust to the local authorities.

3. Own Activities:

3.1 Prisons

CIVPOL Gisenyi visited the Central Prison of Gisenyi on 30/10/95 and was informed by the Assistant Director of the prison as follows:

The total number of prisoners in Gisenyi Central Prison are 1,502.

The break-down is as follows:

Male	-	1475
Female	-	27
Minors	-	39
Babies with their mothers	-	10

The Assistant Director further informed the team that he has reported to the Central Authorities to Kigali that the maximum

level of prisoners has been reached in the prison because the normal capacity is 700. If they will detain more prisoners it would be unacceptable conditions and he feared about the sanitary and health conditions. He further disclosed that there is no nurse attached to the prison. On several times a nurse of the near by hospital is visiting them. The Assistant Director also complained of lack of food supplied by the ministry of justice.

The team further tried to visit the second Gisenyi prison on 03/11/95 for the second time but it was told that, the Director is not available.

The total number of detained persons are:

The conditions in this prison are also quite acceptable.

On 25/10/95 a joint Team of MILOBS, CIVPOL and Human Rights visited Ramba prison. The conditions are quite acceptable, every day at 12.00 hrs the prisoners were supplied by their relatives with food.

3.3 Human Rights Abuses:

Mr. Elie BIRYURAME, the Counsellor of Kanama is still languishing behind the prison bars for no crime committed, even though CIVPOL has never rested on its oars to have him released. It is now patent that, the promises made by the local authorities to release him when the "Commission de Triage" was functioning, must not be taken for anything and the matter must be taken on a higher level. On 08/11/95 CIVPOL visited again the Gisenyi Prosecutor who disclosed that the "Commission de Triage" is not functioning in the whole Rwanda and that we must wait until a tribunal is established.

It is reported that at Byahi Sector, the RPA has imposed a curfew during the hours of darkness because of the constant activities of insurgents within the area.

8. General Assessment:

The Zairian/Rwandan border is closed on the Zairian side for immigration of Rwandan Nationals. The border remains closed to humanitarian and UNAMIR traffic. The general situation in the prefecture continues to be under control but somewhat tense due to the mine incidents and infiltrations as reported. The relationship with local Authorities is cordial. Most of the roads within the prefecture are becoming impassable owing to the continuous rainfall.

1. General Security in the Sector

The security situation within the prefecture is not all safe if we consider the nine insurgents who have been able to infiltrate into since 28/9/95 with all their weapons and were only seen and arrested on 17/10/95. They could have done any havoc and return un-noticed. Also the tank mines which were luckily found by the locals on the main roads in the prefecture and later removed by the RPA could have done a great harm. Yet still nobody knows if there are other mines planted somewhere so it has been decided the daily patrol should start from 09.30 hrs and finish not later than 15.00 hrs.

d) Military Operations by RPA or FRGF:

A. CIVPOL patrolled Rwerere Commune and it was confirmed by the Bourgermestre that, on 24/10/95 about 100 Militias infiltrated into Rwanda and entered Gabiro Sector, Cell. Kitanihirwa. The Counsellor and the RPA Commander of the sector stated that, they followed them but they eluded them and suspected might be hiding in Gishwati Forest at Kanama Commune. They could not say as to whether they were armed because of darkness.

g) Special CIVPOL activities:

A. As a follow up, a joint team of CIVPOL and Gendarmerie patrolled Rubavu Commune, Murara Sector, Rwerere Commune and Kinyazavu Sector with the view to tracing the 22 years old girl, Rosi Nyirasabimana who was abducted but every effort made proved abortive during the past week. Today we found the girl at MSF health center at Murura Sector. We interviewed the victim; the report was recorded by OPJ Patrick of Gisenyi Gendarmerie Brigade. On 3/10/95, 21.00 hrs 7 persons forced the door of her house and have stolen several personal items including her cloths and 7500 FR. She was abducted, taken to the bush and slashed the right arm. She recognized 2 people among the 7 individuals; they were from Rwerere Commune, Kinyazavu Sector:

1. Sengiyumva, mother is Nyirakamana
2. Sibomana, father is Ndeze.

We met the relatives at their house who reported that the perpetrators lived in refugees camp in Goma.

We patrolled Rwerere Commune and informed the Assistant Bourgemestre and the Counsellor to arrest them in the Commune's prison when they arrived again. The Assistant Bourgemestre further disclosed that 4 robberies occurred on the night 7/10/95 by 8 armed

individuals in Military uniforms. Investigation in progress.

3.3 Human Rights Abuses:

It was reported by MILOBS that, at Mutura and Rwerere Communes, 4 boys aged 16/17 who were allegedly searching for manual work had been arrested by RPA for not possessing proper documents. The boys who are from Ramba Commune are presently being detained at Rwerere Commune cells. Human Rights have been informed.

The locals are in a state of fear to release informations pertaining to certain occurrences in their communes because of RPA and this is greatly hampering smooth monitoring in the prefecture.

A. A joint team of CIVPOL, Gendarmerie and one IPJ patrolled Kayove Commune to follow up the investigations of the murder of the bourgemestre of Kayove as reported in Sitrep No 28 on 28/9/95. We met the Assistant Bourgemestre who reported that the security situation in the commune is calm. The Assistant Bourgemestre named two persons who were against the killed Bourgemestre. Further we patrolled Busanza Sector. Locals told us, that one soldier was seen in the area met a woman on several days when the murder happened. Investigation in progress.

B. CIVPOL and Gendarmerie are investigating an accident involving UNAMIR 428 driven by Lt. Commander Aziz Ul Hag, ID No, MO-7589 and RPA vehicle No, APR-107 F on Gisenyi-Ruhengeri main road about 1 Kilometer from Gisenyi on 5/10/95 at 13.55 hrs. No-body was injured, both vehicles slightly damaged. Case of accident under investigation. Full report follows.

7. Miscellaneous Reports

A. On 03 October CIVPOL CPMT attended the ceremony of German National Holiday. On This occasion CPMT, Major Siggie Sczech held discussions with the Chief of Gendarmerie, CIVPOL Commissioner and other invited Authorities. The discussions centered on the generally security situation in Rwanda and the tasks of CIVPOL.

B. Further the CPMT was directed by Deputy CIVPOL Commissioner on 04.10.95 to send a conclusion of the mass murder in Kanama. In this case we report as follows:
The figures of the mass murder have been reported in sitrep No 20 of 13/9/95. Meanwhile the number of dead bodies is 110. One woman is still on admission in Gisenyi hospital. One child was transferred to Ruhengeri hospital because of serious condition. A commission of inquiry was established under the Chairmanship of the Prefect of Gisenyi. The RPA BN Commanders at Mutura and Bigogwe are reported to have been taken to Kigali. The Brigade Commander is reported to be under house arrest.
CIVPOL Gisenyi is not able to send a conclusion of this very sensitive incident. In my opinion a conclusion could be arrived by the established Commission of inquiry in connection with Rwandan Authorities in Kigali including all investigations carried out by Human Rights, MILOBS and CIVPOL.

8. General Assessment

The Zairian/Rwandan border is now closed for all traffic including UN vehicles. The general situation in the prefecture continues to be under control. Increased in social and economic activities observed. The relationship with local Authorities is cordial.

On the 10/09/1995 in the Commune of Kayove Sector Mibirizi two persons were arrested by an officer of military service called Mubikiso Ephreme.


The Two persons were arrested because they possess a gun which type is R4, the gun belonged to a former soldier who is still in Zaïre.

According to their statement, in ^{central} prison of Gisenyi where we met them with a member of human rights and Unamir, the detained called Musembyukundi Jean 50 years old son of pjakuru Moise and Sindibuzi; married father of six children, a farmer living at Mibirizi declares as follows:

I was arrested on the during the night of 10/ Sept 1995 by the chief of military service from the Unity of Kayove, because I had a gun type R4 belonging to a former soldier who gave it to me when he left to Zaïre, After that, I gave it to my son. I don't know the owner of the gun but I took it because of his friend Habiyambere the latter knows the soldier. I was afraid to give back the gun to RPA fearing to be arrested. I was also afraid to give it back because once the owner comes back from Zaïre and asks it and doesn't find it, he could kill me.

I am not involved in killings even the Captain, Commander of the Unity, has recognized it. Those who have participated in killings are in sectors and I have already given their names to the Captain.

the second is called Usabimana Paul born in 1984 in Kayove Cell: Mubirizi he is still living in Kayove, he is a farmer son of Shirambere Gabriel and of Mukajero Thérèse married. He was arrested on the 16/09/1995 by the Captain Mubirizi Ephrem. He declares: I have kept the gun during the period that my father has travelled to Gakoni the latter has requested me to keep for him. It was during July last year that he gave it to me. I don't remember the date when rumours began on the gun, I went to see my father and told him to give it back to soldiers. I found him sick and told him but he has hesitated saying that he was afraid to give it back. One week after, I saw the Captain with two soldiers and my father asking me to give what I keep. From that time I was arrested and interrogated and the next day I was interrogated by the Captain. We have been also interrogated at the prefectural office by the assistant Bourgmestre of Kayove.



We found 15 bodies in various huts. The mix was random, men, women and children of all ages. We had seen different wounds but machetts and hoes but most of them were gunshot wounds. Includes in the death were also in Counsellor of this sector. There were a total of 101 dead bodies viewed by MILOBS. One grave reported as containing one body was seen and seven bodies reported by the locals as having been buried in a separate area.

THE MURDERS APPEARED TO BE RANDOM HOWEVER ORCHESTRATED IN A MILITARY FASHION. IT APPEARS THAT THE MAJORITY OF THE DEAD WERE FIRST REMOVED FROM THEIR ACCOMMODATION AND THEN KILLED BY RIFLE FIRE. THE ONLY PHYSICAL EVIDENCE THAT WAS GATHERED WAS CONSIDERABLE 7.62mm AK EMPTY CASINGS AND SEVERAL WHOLE ROUNDS.

At about 17.30 hrs we meet one RPA Officer at the house where the Bourgemestre was killed. He reported that one RPA OFFR (LT) and three RPA soldiers were killed in a veh which was travelling on the road GISENYI - RUHENGARI near the incident site last night. At about 17.40 hrs the Prefect of Gisenyi visited the house of the killed Bourgemestre of Kanama Commune. Investigation in progress.

At the briefing on 13/9/95 at 08.00 hrs we have been informed by RPA LO,MSF and MILOBS as follows:

After the murder of the RPA Officer and his escort on 11/9/95 at about 19.00 hrs on the above road RPA asked for reinforcement. The shooting in this area started at 01.30 hrs, at 03.00 hrs and again at 05.00 hrs. The

population was asked by RPA to bury the dead bodies as soon as possible. The perpetrators at some areas had identified the next target when they will come back. The RPA LO further reported that 2 EXFAR had been arrested and RPA found 2 kalaschnikows and 6 grenades in this area where the EXFAR had their HQ to coordinate the sabotage attacks in Gishwati Forest.

21 injured people have been transported to Gisenyi hospital and 5 people to Ruhengeri hospital, one died on the way to the hospital. Today the Brigade Commander Col. Bagira will visit MILOBS station at Gisenyi. Investigation in progress.



Both Bourgemestres are invited by the Prefect of Gisenyi to attend the bourgemestres conference in Gisenyi on 25/8/95 at 10.00 hrs. We informed the bourgemestres that UNAMIR will organise the transport of all Bourgemestres to the conference.

The bourgemestre further disclosed that the situation in the area cooled down after RPA increased their strength in the commune. After the mine explosions in the past week no other sabotage attacks of unknown Militia could be reported.

Further the Team patrolled Nkamira Transit Camp to access the situation in the camp. We interviewed some returnees and the chief of UNHCR in the camp (see Humanitarian).

When the 4 dead bodies were found about half an hour later, it was also found that the perpetrators had taken RF 50,000, a radio and battery, and an unknown sum of money to a local who lived in the house.

The RPA is also investigating in this case. The bourgmestre came too.

2. They ordered her late husband to open the gate, which
 he did.
3. The soldiers entered the compound and ordered the above
 mentioned deceased persons out of the house and to lie
 faced down on ground.
4. The eyewitness was forced by the soldiers to deep her
 head in a drum half filled with water.

5. She heard the soldiers shoot the deceased persons. She managed to peep from her position and saw 2 soldiers firing at the deceased persons.
6. The first listed victim was her husband. A Hutu who was a soldier of the FRGF, but became a potato merchant after the FRGF was defeated by the RPA. He did not participate in last years genocide since he was only a staff sergeant in the administrative section of the FRGF. He ran away briefly after the RPA defeated the FRGF, but returned back to his home in Gisenyi on 1/8/94. He had been resident with his family in the present location for the past 5 years. No criminal charge or charges was brought against him by the present RPA government. He was neither arrested nor detained after the war. He was a responsible member of the commune and the bourgemetre and some other government officials used to come to his residence on friendly visits.
The second listed victim, was a neighbor and the first victim's motor mechanic. He is also Hutu.
The third victim was the brother of the witness. He is Tutsi.
7. The soldiers threw some grenades after killing their victims.
8. The soldiers stole a total sum of 3,400,000RWF from the deceased house and also damaged the television and video sets.
9. The combined CIVPOL and HR team saw the corpses of the 3 deceased persons who apparently died from gunshot wounds on various parts of their bodies.
10. The team counted 15 fresh bullet holes in the front of the house, 8 behind and 10 in the sitting room.

At the Gishwati forest, 5 km from the Kimihira Refugee Camp, we saw a MEMISA (NGO) pickup vehicle coming from kayove commune. The driver, a doctor was carrying an RPA soldier and some locals who appeared afraid, informed us that 3 RPA soldiers on patrol were shot at by unknown militia. He further informed us that the shooting occurred 10 minutes ago, 5Km away, on the route to Kayove commune. We continued the patrol. At Kimihira refugees camp we were informed by some locals that the shooting took place 30m from there towards Gisenyi direction. We were also informed that nobody was injured in the incident. At 1020hrs, we got in contact with the helicopter team (CH. YH) which made an aerial observation of the

situation.

At Kayove commune we met the bourgemestre who complained about the security situation in the commune. He also complained that world food programme has not supplied the refugees camp in the commune with food. The bourgemestre further reported that a pylon was destroyed by explosion in the night from 7/8 to 8/8/95 in the south of the commune. A lorry from Caritas was also destroyed by a mine in the same location.

The team patrolled to locate the sites of these incidents and passed the border of Kibuye Prefecture. In the south of Rutsiro Commune in Koiygonili Cellule we found the destroyed pylon about 200m on the right of the main road. The pylon was bombed out of a strong base of concrete and the electricity line in the direction of Kibuye has been cut as a result.

We patrolled to Mabanza Commune and found the Caritas lorry. On the rear double wheels was a crater in the road about a half meter deep. The rear axle and the wheels had been destroyed by a mine. But it is possible to pass the road because some local workers had already started repairs on the damaged road.

From Kayove Commune we were joined by two canadian armed patrols because there was another firing on 11.30 hrs in this area. The situation was very tense and the RPA has been nervous. Two vehicles of MSF and one from Human Rights (H.R.5A.4) also joined the convoy to Gisenyi.

2. Today, 17/8/95 the RPA liaison officer reported that searches were carried out by the RPA in Gishwati area as a result of continuous sabotage attacks by some militia in this area and three different types of mines were recovered in the process. The searches continue today in Gisenyi town, which has been cordoned and a house to house search conducted by the RPA.

- B) WITH THE RPA LIAISON OFFICER CPL MASTER CASSIAN WE CONTINUED THE INVESTIGATION IN CAUSE OF THE HAND-GRENADE EXPLOSION IN THE MUTURA COMMUNE (LOOK SITREP NO 101). WE COULD FIND OUT, THAT THE RPA SOLDIER BELONGED OBVIOUSLY TO THE RPA CAMP OF BIGOGWE. THE KILLED CONSEILLER WAS HIS UNCLE. THE SOLDIER WAS DRUNKEN.
