

Further to my Burtan 27 of 25 April, following analysis political situation Kivu may help.

1. Present provincial government not imposed by Stan on contrary mainly same cabinet as under Miruho but controlling positions favorable Kashamura wing rather than Wizenla. Division is not along party lines e.g. at least one provincial deputy of Cerea Kashamura party is refugee in Ruanda and president Omari refuses allow his return. Governments mainly comprises members of Cerea party which largely a Kivu party with MNC Lumumba as second largest group, but these two groups widely split on personality grounds unrelated to party lines.

2. Extremist wing comprises Kivu president Omari of Cerea, Minister Pub Works Shani of Cerea, Min. Justice Soumialot of MNC and minister interior Moushanda. Moderates pro-Miruho are Min Finance Rwiyereka, Min Health Kahindo, Min agriculture Paluku. Min mines who also vice president Kisangi between these groups but tends towards moderates.

3. Provincial assembly favors return Miruho by about three to two. But its voice ignored.

4. Clearly Stan authorities divided in their support of Kivu cabinet. Kashamura favors extremist wing, Bisukiro supports moderates, Rudahindwa moderate but supporting status quo, Gizenga and Gbenye positions unknown but latter hardly favors Kashamuras nominees.

5. Press and radio reports incorrect when treat Kivu government as mere puppet of Stan. Omari and Soumialot went to Stan largely to convert Stan to them and prevent Stan permit Miruho to return Bukavu. No doubt if Miruho returned prov assembly would make him president forthwith."

6. Pass to Tickner Stan by sure means.





1. You must realize that all ONUC staff including families are necessarily ONUC responsibility. In event difficulties ONUC must intervene. Therefore not correct to say come on Nicolas responsibility only.
2. Security is not repeat not only problem. Apart security it is wrong bring unnecessary persons to shortage area.
3. Nicolas family must be subject same disciplinary rules as ONUC staff eg. crossing to Ruanda, trips outside Bukavu etc. Please confirm this.
4. Europeans who obliged evacuate losing all their property will have no hesitation use advent Nicolas Family as additional anti ONUC propaganda. I consider family's coming here most inadvisable and tactless.
5. Note reply received in clear and quoting my reference, to my coded cable. Understand this contrary to instructions on code use.

PRIORITY

We conferred today with Nazaruddin CO MSF concerning situation North Katanga-Maniema. MSF has three companies in Kabalo of which two are due to move to Nyunzu 18 April, one company plus headquarters company in Kindu. Mazaruddin reports many armed cartel Balubakats in Maniema presumably refugees from Katanga. Monseigneur Fryns Catholic Bishop Kindu reports some armed cartel in Kindu. Currently Balubakats favourable ONUC since ONUC opposing Katanga Gendarmes. Nazaruddin fears that should Gendarmes penetrate Maniema, Balubakats will avenge themselves on remaining Europeans. Only Europeans known to us in Maniema south of Kindu comprise five of medical institute tropical research in Kibombo, three Catholic missionaries Moyo south of Panga, six American protestant missionaries Kama and one Belgian juvenile delinquent imprisoned for theft in Kasongo named Michel Eebreez whose parents cannot be traced. There may also be isolated planters in South Maniema. Nazaruddin inquires ONUC policy regarding: a. Balubakats in Maniema. b. Katanga Gendarmes crossing frontier into Kivu-Maniema. Please reply directly to Nazaruddin MSF Kabalo or Kindu with copy to me Bukavu which I shall transmit to Brig. Hymid MSF who visits Bukavu 18 April. If possible ensure reply before 181000Z.

Reur BU-231 with letter from Apostolic Delegate in Washington of 8 April. ^{cc} Following report on events in Kivu Maniema since 1 January prepared with Msgr. Van Steene Archbishop Bukavu, Msgr. Cleirf Bishop Kindu and Rector Jesuit College Bukavu.

- 1.. Kivu Maniema province comprises five catholic diocyses, Bukavu Goma and Beni in East, and Kindu and Kasongo in west of Province.
2. Events in Bukavu diocese. After arrest of Provincial President 25 December and arrival of Kashamura from Stan 4 January, anti religious propaganda began. On about 11 January Kashamura ordered arrest and expulsion of Nun in Bukavu Hospital and religious social worker. Some days later Congolese priest arrested and imprisoned for criticizing new authorities in private letter which was censored. Shortly afterwards two priests expelled. 16 February youth movement attacked missions Bukavu, murdered Farther Devos, wounded another priest and attempted murder others. Missions sacked and burnt and all missionaries taken under ANC protection and later lodged Jesuit college inside ONUC lines.
3. Events in Kasongo diocese. In July 1960 landing of Belgian Paratroops at Kasongo blamed on missionaries. All Missionaries evacuated (3 words garbled) never returned. Missionaries returned Kasongo after 2 weeks when ONUC forces in Kasongo. No further events until Lumumbas death announced 14 February. All Missionaries in Kasongo and neighbourhood arrested and brought to Kasongo prison. Badly beaten. One Nun fractured skull and another Nun age 75 broken arm. Several Nuns stripped naked by congolese soldiers. Priests also badly beaten. French priest from Wamaza brought Kasongo and badly beaten. All held in prison for several days then released and held in house arrest in mission. On 14 March Balubakat terrorists arrived Kasongo. Missionaries again beaten including

Vicar General Kasongo Msgr. Kalumbwa. After three days Missionaries permitted withdraw to Kindu under Onuc protection. Missionaries from Moyo brought Pangi 14 February and beaten. Superior collapsed in coma for long period. These missionaries later evacuated. Early March three nurses with religious vows molested in Kalole, and one was raped twice in Kalole catholic church. On 4 April brother Goffinet of Wamaza who took refuge in Kalole was ordered by Chef de Poste Wamaza to return his personal belongings or else be arrested.

4. Events in Kindu diocese. Farther Nibelle S J, on visit to his brother in Kampene near Kindu, badly beaten on 14 February ^{with} lay mining workers. Late February Nuns at Lubutu, North of Kindu, forced to dance naked and one sister raped.

5. These are principal anti Catholic events in Kivu Maniema. In almost all cases protests sent to local authorities by ONUC but without response.

6. Present position. A. Kasongo diocese. 5 missions abandoned, 2 with congolese Abbes only and seven in south Kivu around Fizi still occupied since no trouble in south Kivu. B. Bukavu diocese. Local population favourable to missionaries but present provincial Government and Stanleyville Government are anti religious. All missions occupied and only seven priests and 10 sisters evacuated from diocese leaving about 100 still there. C. Kindu diocese. Many priests and nuns evacuated but no definite figures available. D. Goma and Beni dioceses. No anti religious movement in these dioceses and problems there are lack of food and transport but not of security.

7. Future prospects. Kasongo and Kindu dioceses unsuitable for return of European sisters for indefinite period. Other three dioceses calm but situation in Bukavu depends upon attitude Kivu provincial Government which currently is strongly anti religious. End. ”

Re my Bule 316 of 23 March and 389 of 7 April concerning authorization for families come Bukavu, to which no reply ever received, am amazed to see WHO cable C553 of 13 April stating Nicolas family arrives 18 April.

a. What is ruling families in Congo. Other staff wish over one year contracts also want families to come. Are distinctions personnel being made?.

b. While Bukavu security situation incomparably better than before, no guarantee yet for future developments. UN forces will be responsible protection. Economic situation hardly encourages families. More important, in view arbitrary treatment many residents, frontier blockade for return of refugees, and bitter criticism of ONUC by Europeans and Congolese, I consider it most tactless permit families Bukavu until frontier passage normalized.

c. If my objections overruled by Leo, please at least ensure that ONUC identity card numbers and other details for Nicolas family are communicated well in advance of arrival Bukavu.
