Dear Professor Borysiewicz,

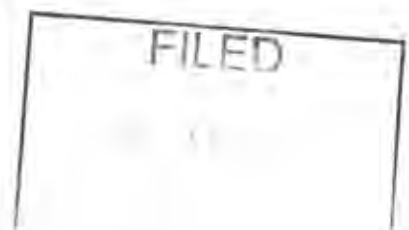

*Dear Secretary General*

We are delighted and honoured that you are considering visiting the University in early 2016, and on Friday, 5 February in particular. My original invitation was to deliver a lecture, but I would now like to offer an alternative and enhanced proposal. The University Council would be delighted if you would **accept nomination for admission to the Honorary Degree of Doctor of Law** during your visit.

The intention would be that you would be admitted to this Honorary Degree at a special Congregation in our Senate-House, at which the Chancellor of the University, Lord Sainsbury of Turville, would preside. Immediately after this, you would be invited to deliver a lecture on a subject of your choosing to the assembled members of the University Community and specially invited guests in the Senate-House. We would then hold a reception immediately afterwards, followed by a celebratory luncheon hosted by Lord Sainsbury in one of our Colleges.

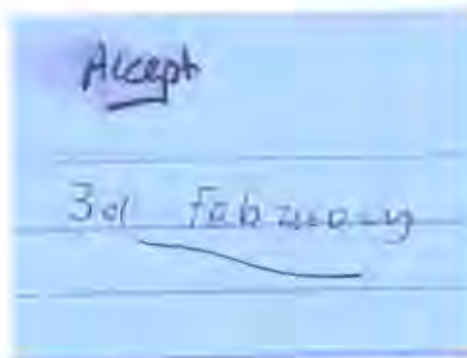
I use the term nomination because all proposals for degrees must be submitted for final approval by the Regent House, the University's Governing Body. This would be done by publication in the University Reporter, probably on Wednesday, 13 January, and we would ask you to keep the matter confidential until then.

If you are willing to accept nomination, as we very much hope you will, we would keep your office informed of when publication will be about to take place, but as the time-scale for our formal procedures is very tight, it would be most helpful to have an early indication from you if you are willing to accept nomination for the Honorary Degree.

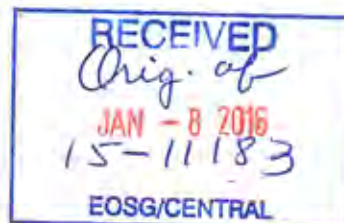
