IT HAS ALSO CARRIED OUT CERTAIN READJUSTMENT OF ITS OPERATIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES VIS A VIS UNAMIR TROOPS, BY REDEPLOYING IAW ETHIOBATT DEPLOYMENTS IN NYAMASHEKE. COS AND DCOS OPS WERE BRIEFED TODAY.

B. RGF. PREVIOUS REPORTS OF RGF IDENTIFIED AS RESPONSIBLE FOR CERTAIN INCIDENTS IS SLOWLY BEING REAFFIRMED WITH THE LOCAL POPULACE. THEY CONFIRM IN SOME CASES THAT THEIR IDENTITY IS KNOWN FROM BEFORE THE WAR, AND THAT AT THAT TIME THEY WERE TROOPS FOR THE RGF. IT SHOULD BE MAINTAINED THAT ALTHOUGH THEY WERE SOLDIERS FOR RGF BEFORE, IT IS POSSIBLE THEY ARE CURRENTLY ACTING IN AN INDEPENDENT OR OTHER CAPACITY, NOT NEC ON BEHALF OF RGF ITSELF.
