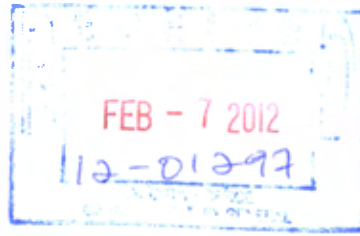

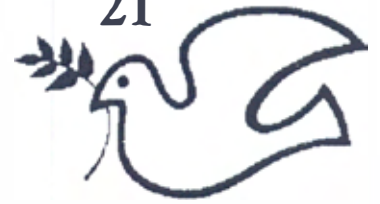

I am not seeking wealth, fame or glory, merely trying to help make lives better for as many people as he can.

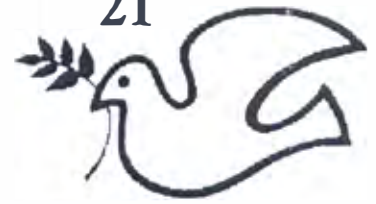

Purpose-

About the author-

Since the beginning of his career more than 60 years ago, Bert Williams* has been solving problems which other persons had been unable to solve. He worked in Gen. Douglas MacArthur’s headquarters during the Second World War and at McDonnell Aircraft Corporation on the renowned first manned space capsule, the Mercury. Later, he assisted analysts in the intelligence community learn how to use desktop computers for performing their daily tasks.

In many of these positions, Williams received privileged information and an insider’s perspective about the workings of the federal government, corporations, and political organizations. In addition, while working at the McDonnell Corporation he received the nickname “Answer Man” among corporation engineers who benefitted from his suggestions for finding novel and effective ways for solving their puzzling problems.

Williams retired in 1987 and has been working on solving his biggest collection of problems yet – the global human problems of the 21st century.

As a result of his career successes, intelligence and the praise he has received from others for his work, Williams gained significant confidence in himself and his beliefs. He has dedicated the last 20 years to following everything from politics to economics while trying to determine why humans have so many harmful situations and how officials can peacefully resolve and/or avoid them.

After going through periods of feeling angry and frustrated, he is now hopeful for a better tomorrow. In his self-published book, Williams has compiled what he believes to be friendly resolutions to the harmful situations which 21st century humans are enduring and will continue to experience unless officials substantially change their activities.

Williams believes that the contents of his book can substantially change the perspectives of important and powerful world officials who cooperatively can significantly reduce worldwide devastations and thereby create and maintain a more friendly and loving global society for all to enjoy.

About the book-

“21st Century Humans Must Replace All Government Officials With Global Resource Managers” is a unique and in-depth look at how nations and their residents have become mired in global miseries because of governments, economics, social and international difficulties and practices.

After years of professional experience and personal research, Williams has realized that all of the national and global issues occurring in the 21st century are natural consequences of the processes being used. The book describes through specific detail and explanations the different ways people need to begin looking at the world and to stop saying people are doing wrong but rather they are not doing the best they can.

He attributes the main problems to nationalism and its natural tendency to result in chaos for everyone involved. His solution is that we must behave “*better than natural*” and improve our lives while improving the lives of others.

Williams writes that the world is being developed and run by businesses, and as a result government has become irrelevant. Governments make decisions to benefit businesses rather than their citizens. He describes the primary interests of self-centered businessmen of the world and how those interests result in a “hell on earth” for the less fortunate.

In his book he explains how officials are representing too many people whom he calls “the haves” while ignoring the needs and wellbeing of “the have-nots” in the world. This behavior reflects the natural tendency of humans to be self-concerned and rather than realizing that they will fare best when all persons on earth are faring better.

He also relates how unemployment, national debt, oil, natural disasters, poverty, international involvement and military spending have become 21st century issues because of governmental and business practices.

Williams closes his pioneering book by explaining a global solution is necessary to resolve these problems. He believes there is need for a Global Transformational Cooperative Organization that consists of the permanent members of the United Nations Security Council and members of The Arab League. This council would then gradually transform the world through a series of tactics Williams has developed.
