

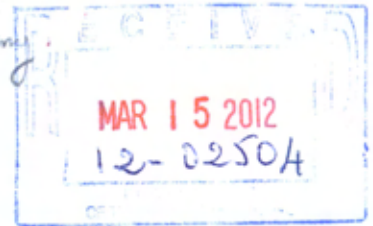

Dear Mr. Ki-Moon:
