MUGANZA CLINIC COVERS A POPULATION OF ABOUT 16,000 AND IS CURRENTLY BEING RUN BY NGOS-L.V.I.A. THE AVERAGE DAILY ATTENDANCE IS 80 PER DAY. LACK OF ENOUGH DRUGS AND PERSONNEL IS THE MAIN PROBLEM. IT IS ALSO REPORTED THAT L.V.I.A. WILL STOP RUNNING THE HOSPITAL IN JAN 1995

C. PATROLS WHICH WERE SENT TO GIKOLE (GR 7699) AND NDAGO (GR 5201) REPORTED THAT THE GENERAL SITUATION IN THE AREAS IS STILL CALM. 
