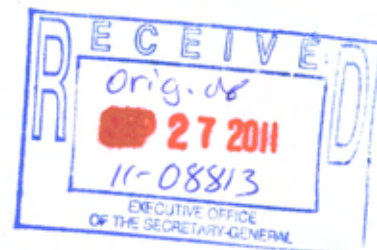

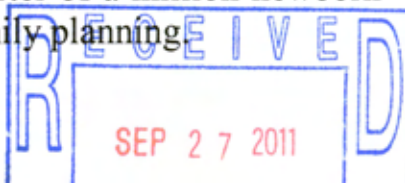

Thank you for your letters of 16 June and 12 July, inviting me to attend the High-level Meeting on Nuclear Safety and Security and the "Every Woman, Every Child" event at the General Assembly in September.

I am grateful for your leadership in these areas. Although I will not be able to attend the meetings in person because of conflicting commitments, I am committed to helping you achieve successful outcomes, and will ensure high level British participation. William Hague will represent me at the Nuclear Safety meeting and Andrew Mitchell at the "Every Woman, Every Child" event.

On nuclear issues, your High-Level Meeting will be an opportunity to learn lessons from Japan, to review our procedures and processes, and to take steps to enhance the international safety framework as necessary, following on from the successful IAEA Conference in June. Events at Fukushima underlined the need to implement the highest safety standards across the world as the use of civil nuclear power spreads, and Britain will support you to achieve an approach that is both robust and pragmatic.

On maternal and child health, Britain remains deeply committed to accelerating progress and we value your personal leadership through the Global Strategy. I was delighted that the GAVI pledging conference in London in June achieved commitments of \$4.3bn to immunise more than 250 million children. For our part, we will use UK aid over the next five years to save the lives of at least 50,000 women in pregnancy and childbirth and a quarter of a million newborn babies, and to enable access to modern methods of family planning.



I look forward to discussing these issues with you in New York, as well as the wider agenda for your second term

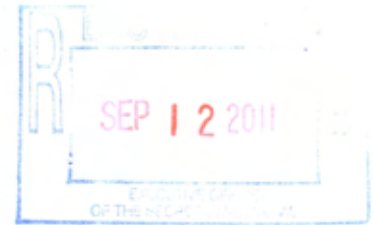
