

Reference your question concerning payment of BRSC employees at Cyangugu.

1. BRSC employs approximately 120 Local Nationals at Cyangugu. They have been employed for a period of two weeks and have earned their first pay which is due today. Mr. Beavers, the BRSC Sector Coordinator, is in sector ~~5~~₄ today paying our employees.
2. There are a number of Local Nationals who have been working for the UN Forces in Cyangugu for a period of approximately 3 months. These employees have not been paid by either the UN or the forces who they work for. These personnel were not employees of BRSC, however, BRSC has agreed to hire them and pay them for the time they worked for the UN. These employees will receive that pay today along with the two weeks pay they have earned as BRSC employees.
3. I hope the above answers your questions concerning pay of BRSC employees. If I can be of further assistance in this matter please let me know.
