APPROXIMATELY 250 LOCALS. THE TEAM WHICH WAS DISPATCHED BY THE
NATIONAL DEMINING OFFICE BASED IN KIGALI, DISPLAYED VARIOUS TYPES
OF EXPLOSIVES AS FOLLOWS:

(A) ANTI PERSONAL MINE (METALIC, WOODEN AND PLASTI

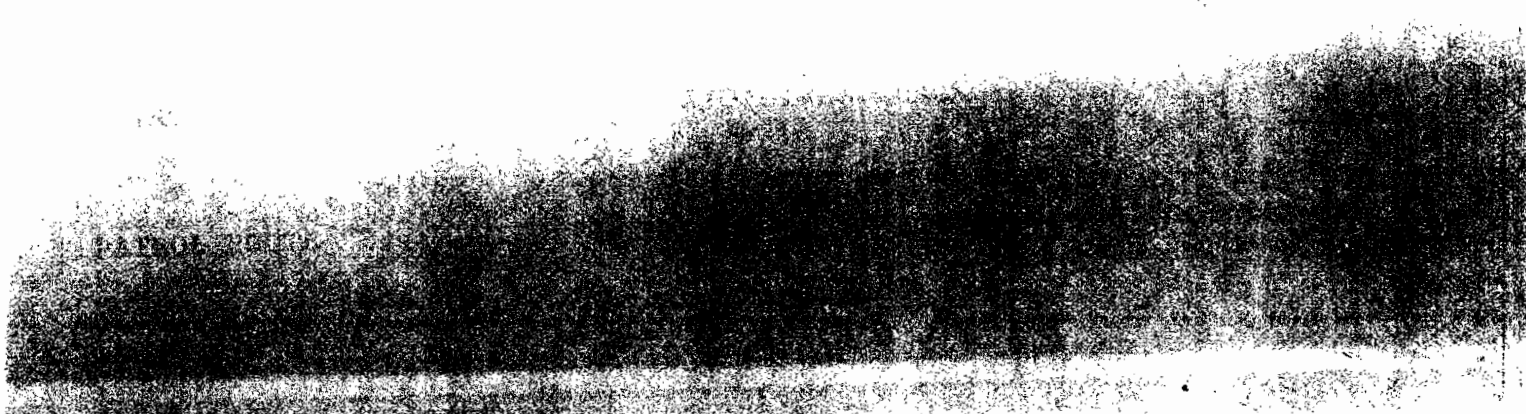
