

LETTER OF APPOINTMENT

Dear Mr. Fernández Amunátegui,

I am pleased to offer you an appointment as an Under-Secretary-General in the Secretariat of the United Nations. This will be a fixed-term appointment, in accordance with the terms and conditions specified below and subject to the provisions of the Staff Regulations and the Staff Rules, together with such amendments as may from time to time be made to such Staff Regulations and such Staff Rules.

Tenure of Appointment

This fixed-term appointment is for a period of one year from the effective date of appointment shown above. It therefore expires on the 17th day of June 2012.


This appointment is subject to extension of mandate and availability of funding.

This appointment may be terminated prior to its expiration date in accordance with staff regulation 9.3, in which case you will be given 30 days' written notice. This appointment is also subject to termination in the interest of the Organization, as determined by the Secretary-General, in which case you will be given three months' written notice. Should your appointment be terminated prior to its expiration date, the United Nations will pay such indemnity as may be provided for under the Staff Regulations and the Staff Rules. Please note that the normal expiration of the appointment at its term does not require the payment of any indemnity. This fixed-term appointment does not carry any expectancy of renewal or of conversion to any other type of appointment in the Secretariat of the United Nations.
