- Ms. Debebe Teguest of DESA - who sustained injuries in the bombing and is ~~scared~~ for life.

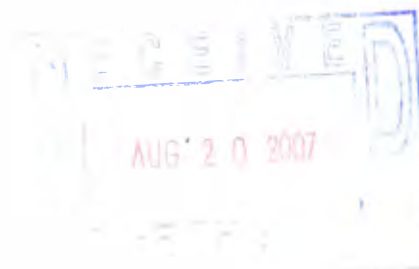

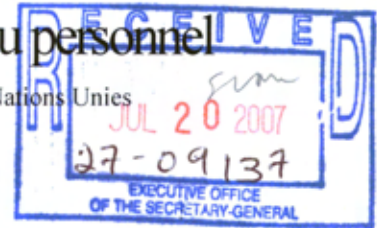
