Reference your 1329, repeated London 16123, Belgrade 3755.

This is present status here of Yugoslav Repatriation Liaison Officers and Red Cross workers for Austria. British zone Commander favors granting permission for Yugoslav Liaison Officers and some Red Cross workers to enter that zone and after receiving paragraph 1 your 1329, dispatched a communication to London recommending to that effect. British Commander here received simultaneously with your request a letter for political representative of Yugoslavia in Austria requesting permission to send 5 Liaison Officers into British zone formal reply of British element forthcoming when zone Commander receives advices from London. Deputy Commander of US zone has postponed command due to absence Commander that zone but reply of US zone expected within 72 hours. Reply of French Commander delayed by 3 day holiday
