SUBJECT: WEEKLY SITREP 7 - PERIOD 28 MAR TO 02 APR 94

1. GEN SIT & HIGHLIGHTS. THE SIT IN THE DMZ WITHIN THE WEEK WAS GENERALLY CALM EXCEPT THE FOL REPORTS:

a. REPORTS RECEIVED BY TEAM F AT 261900 HRS FROM COMD RGF 194 BN NEAR NYAGATARE INDICATES THAT ON 26 MAR 94, BETWEEN 0100 HRS AND 0200 HRS, UNIDENTIFIED PERSONS IN CIVIL CLOTHES AND RPF UNIFORMS ATTACKED VILLAGES AT GR B309473 AND GR 310476. INVESTIGATIONS REVEALED THAT THE ASSAILANTS FIRED RANDOMLY AND ENTERED HOUSES DEMANDING MONIES FROM INHABITANTS. ASSAILANTS WERE LAST OBSERVED AT GR B309473 MOVING EASTWARDS. RGF CLAIM TO HAVE ENGAGED IN FIREFIGHT WITH ASSAILANTS. RPF AT RUKOMO (B2546) DENIED ANY INVOLVEMENT WHEN CONTACTED. THERE WERE NO CAS. INVESTIGATIONS CONTINUED AND REPORTS TO BE SUBMITTED.

b. AT ABOUT 272000HRS, 130 ADULTS AND 152 CHILDREN WITH THEIR BELONGINGS ARRIVED AT BYUBAT PTL BASE AT KINIGI. THEY FLED FROM THEIR HOMES IN AND AROUND KABWENDE GR A5442 DUE TO ALLEGED HARRASSMENT AND SEIZURE OF FOOD IN MENTIONED AREA BY THE RPF. PTL BASE PROVIDED SY TO THE DISPLACED WHILST THE SIT WAS BEING INVESTIGATED.

c. BYUBAT B COY AT NGARAMA REPORTED THAT ONE MR NKERABIWI ATHANSE OF NYAGAHITA COMPLAINED THAT 2 SUSPECTED RPF PERSONS IN MUFTI ATTACKED HIM AT HIS RESIDENCE BUT THERE WERE NO CAS. THE COMPLAINANT HANDED OVER EMPTY CASES AND RDS OF AK RIFLE WHICH HE SAID WERE USED BY ATTACKERS. INVESTIGATIONS CONTINUES AND REPORT FOLLOWS.

d. BYUBAT C COY PTL BASE AT KINIGI REPORTED THAT 5 LOCALS WERE KIDNAPPED BY RPF AT BUTETE(A7145) AT 291200 HRS. A SEARCH PARTY DESP TO LOC DID NOT LOC WHEREABOUTS OF CAPTIVES. INVESTIGATIONS CONTINUE.

e. AT ABOUT 291840 HRS, BYUBAT CHP AT KIDAHO ARRESTED A LOCAL BY NAME MR MUTANGA GERALD AND SUSPECTED TO BE AN RPF SOLDIER, WITH AN EXPLOSIVE DEVICE AND ASSORTED DOCUS. MENTIONED PERSON WAS LATER ESCORTED TO RPF POSN AT SOJI(A751484) AT 2130 HRS WHERE HE CAME FROM. MENTIONED DEVICE IN THE CUSTODY OF BYUBAT.

f. AT ABOUT 292230 HRS ON, LOCALS OF BISATE 2 (A485418) HANDED OVER AN RPF SOLDIER BY NAME RUTERIMARA BOSCO FROM RPF B COY LOC AT GASEBEYA(A8144) TO BYUBAT KINIGI PTL BASE. MENTIONED SOLDIER ARRESTED BY FOREST GUARDS IN FOREST NEAR BISATE 2 WITH ONE AK 47 RIFLE AND 2 EMPTY MAGS BELONGING TO HIM WERE HANDED OVER TO PTL BASE. SOLDIER ESCORTED TO RPF CHP AT SOZI(A7584) AT 301740 HRS.

a. MILOB TEAMS

(1) TEAM A. CARRIED OUT PTLs TO NKUMBA-GATETE AND GAZIZA.

(2) TEAM B. CONDUCTED PTLs TO NKUMBA-RUHOMBO-KALINGOLERA-MUSEKERA-KIRAMBO AND TABA.

(3) TEAM C. WENT ON PTLs TO TUMBA-KINIHIRA-NYAKENKE AND RULINDO.

(4) TEAM D. CARRIED OUT PTLs FROM BYUMBA TO BWISIGE-NYARURAMA-BUKAMBA-RUKOMO-RUHENDA-BUHAMBE AND NGONDORÉ. LOCATED RGF CHPs AT KANWOGA, GR B111370 AND Y-JUNC GR B0834.

(5) TEAM E. CARRIED OUT PTLs IN NGARAMA.

(6) TEAM F. CONDUCTED PTLs IN AREAS NYAGATARE-MIHENGO-MUVUMBA-RUKOMO-B309473-RYABEGA AND GABIRO.

b. BYUBAT

(1) A, B AND C COYS CONDUCTED FOOT AND MOBILE PTLs WITHIN THEIR AORs.

(2) REF PARA 2.b. OF SITREP 86 DATED 28 MAR 94, INVESTIGATIONS BY COY PERS REVEALED AN RPF SOLDIER WENT TO LYANGO(A5142) ON 271700 HRS AND REQ TO LODGE WITH A COUPLE. AFTER GRANTING OF LODGEMENT, RPF SOLDIER FORCIBLY REQ FOR FOOD AND DRINK WHICH WAS PROVIDED. NOT SATISFIED, HE REQ TO BE SHOWN A ROUTE ALONG VOLCANIC MOUNTING TO ZAIRE WHICH COUPLE CLAIM DID NOT KNOW. PANIC WAS CREATED AND ALARM RAISED IN AREA RESULTING IN MASS FLEEING OF LOCALS TO KINIGI PTL BASE TO TAKE REFUGE. SIT HAS SINCE BEEN CALM AND LOCALS COMPLIED WITH CALL TO RETURN TO VILLAGE.

(3) REF PARA 2.b. OF SITREP 89 DATED 31 MAR 94, 1 X AK 47 RIFLE, 2 X EMPTY MAGS AND OTHER PERSONAL DOCUS BELONGING TO ARRESTED RPF SOLDIER HELD AT SECTOR HQ PENDING FURTHER INVESTIGATIONS.

(3) B COY CFM WDR OF RPF FROM AREA GR B1136 AND NOW LOC AT RUSHAKI(B1138) OUTSIDE DMZ. COY PTLs ALSO INTERACTED WITH CATHOLIC PRIEST AND LOCALS AT NYAGIHANGA(B2029).

(1) PROVIDED SY AT NGONDORRE WHILST REPAIR WORKS AND CONSTR OF DEF POSNS AND TRG CONTINUED.

(2) AT ABOUT 281530 HRS, AN RPF OFFR PROCEEDING TO MULINDI ARRIVED AT NGONDORRE CHP FROM KIGALI IN A JEEP UNACCOMPANIED BY UNAMIR ESCORT. HE WAS REFUSED ENTRY AND AS A RESULT RETURNED TO KIGALI. IDENTITY AND VEH PARTICULARS OF MENTIONED OFFR COULD NOT BE OBTAINED BY GUARDS LOC THERE.

b. FORCE ENGR COY GP RECEIVED 9 X MINE DETECTING SETS, 1 X AURAL INDICATOR AND 1 X WEST/CASE AN/PSS-11 FROM F/HQ ENGR SEC.

b. BYUBAT TPS AT KIDAHU PROVIDED BY TO ICRC TO DISTR FOOD IN AREA WHILST PTL BASE AT MIMULI ORG A CLEAN-UP CAMPAIGN AT MIMULI MARKET.

8. CIVIL AFFAIRS. BYUBAT PLATOON AT CYUNGO WITH ASSISTANCE FROM CIVIL AUTH HELD A FORUM TO EDUCATE POPULATION AT GITARE(A9323) AND MASOGWE(A9523) ON THE TASK OF UNAMIR TPS IN THE AREA.

a. AT ABOUT 0800 HRS, 4 OFFRS AND 70 OR OF FORCE ENGR COY DEPARTED BYUMBA FOR A RECREATIONAL TRIP TO GISENYI. TRIP WAS DISRUPTED WHEN ONE OF VEHs IN CONVOY BROKE DOWN 8KM AFTER RUHENGARI, RESULTING FROM A BURNT CLUTCH PLATE. A REPAIR AND RECOVERY TEAM WAS DESP TO MENTIONED SPOT TO EFFECT REPAIRS.



CYOYOHU AT SAME LOC STOPPED PRODUCTION ON 17 MAR 94. TPS
OBSERVED FARMERS PICKING AND THROWING AWAY TEA LEAVES.

OF SITREP 88 OF 30 MAR 94, INFO GIVEN BY HOUSE BOY OF MR NKERABIGWI ATHANASE INDICATES THAT AT 021400 B APR 94, 2 UNARMED MEN IN MUFTI SUSPECTED TO BE RPF PERS CAME TO RESIDENCE AND QUESTIONED WIFE OF MR NKERABEGWI IN RESPECT OF THE 4 AK 47 EMPTY CASES WHICH THE HUSBAND PICKED AND HANDED OVER AS MENTIONED IN ABOVE REF. THE RPF SUSPECTS LEFT THE SAID RESIDENCE AT 021430 HRS WITHOUT HARMING ANYONE. MEANWHILE MRS NKERABIGWI HAS LEFT HER RESIDENCE TO VISIT RELATIVES AT GIHEGELI(B2033).


