MEMORANDUM.

SUBJECT:- Vehicle Repair and Maintenance Tools for Czechoslovakia.

1. Reference is made to letter from Mr Sorokin, Industrial Rehabilitation Specialist, Czech Mission, outlining shortage in "On Vehicle Tools and Accessories", for trucks being supplied to Czechoslovakia.
2. The list supplied bears no relationship to the U.S. Army vehicles being supplied by Paris SURPROP. Paris to Washington Cable 447, SURPROP 570 attached as Washington asks Paris to supply the necessary tool sets for U.S. Army vehicles.
3. This leaves your office to provide tools for British vehicles only.

Enclosed we are forwarding to you a list of tools needed for the maintenance and repair outfits of UNRRA origin vehicles.

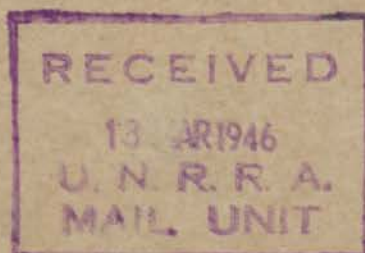
The list mentions only those tools, which are unobtainable in Czechoslovakia and at the same time urgently needed to insure the carrying out of all necessary maintenance and repair operations.
