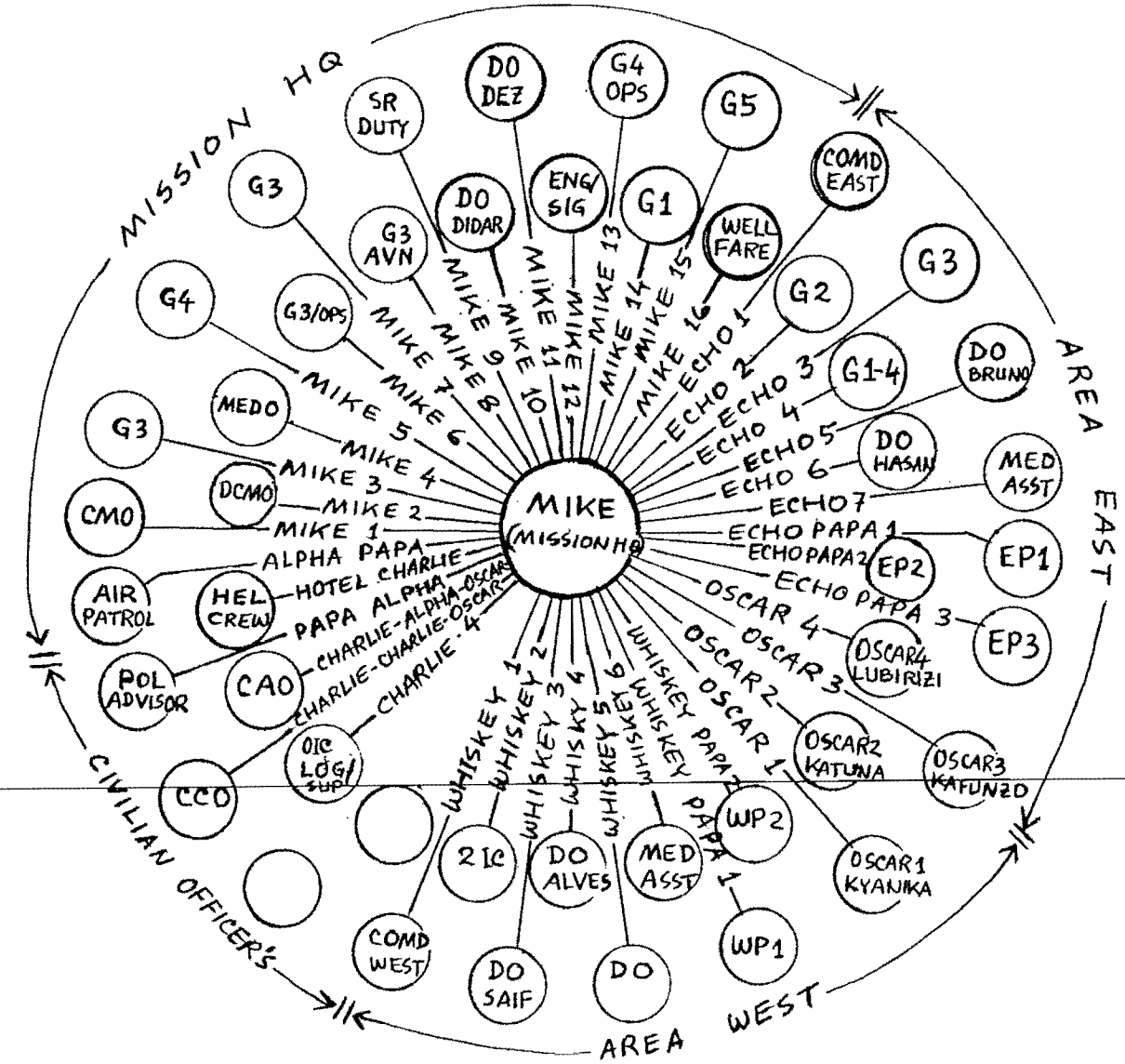

INSTRUCTION FOR HEL MISSION

1. Area HQs should send the names of UNMOs earmarked for Hel mission at least 72 hours before the mission.
2. UNMOs detailed for the mission should report to the HQ at least 24 hours before the mission for briefing.
3. UNMOs should report to this HQ at least 90 min before the mission for final briefing and further instructions, if any.
4. UNMOs should strictly follow the flight safety instructions.
5. No unauthorized persons will be allowed in Hel Pad/Hel.
6. Smoking during the mission (should be avoided.)
7. ^{IT IS NOT ALLOWED} It is prohibited to enter in the helipad putting on caps.
8. On board caps should be kept beside instead of putting it on.
