SUBJECT: SITREP COVERING THE PERIOD 120600B JUN TO 121800B JUN 94

1. GEN SITUATION. There was exchange of arty, HMG and small arms fire at the Western and South-western suburbs of KIGALI during the period.

2. FACTIONAL ACTIVITIES

a. POLITICAL. NTR.

b. MILITARY. The warring factions exchange arty, HMG and rifle fire at KIMIHURURA, KIYOVU and KACYIRU suburbs of KIGALI during the period.

3. OWN MILITARY ACTIVITIES.

a. MILOB GP HQ. Organization, Planning and Coordination of MILOBs activities was carried out during the period.

b. RPF MILOB SECTOR. The Sector was relatively calm.

c. KIGALI MILOB SECTOR

(1) MILOB Teams provided escort for ICRC, MSF and one team was attached to (St Michel) during the period.

(2) Two MILOB teams escorted UNAMIR mil and civ pers to KAGITUMBA en route to NAIROBI. The teams reported that RPF tps searched UNAMIR pers and their luggage even after they had been told that they were all UNAMIR pers.

(3) Two MILOB teams escorted WFP officials to KAGITUMBA.

(4) Four teams escorted ICRC and PSF officials to destinations within KIGALI during the period.

6. LOGISTICS. 10 days' ration and water were distributed to MILOBs. MILOB teams faced the problem of refuelling after their missions.
